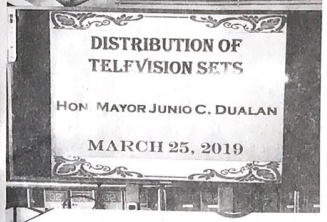

The Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) lauds the support to President Duterte given by local and national government units (LGUs) that have declared the Communist Party of the Philippines-National Democratic Front (CPP-NPA-NDF) as persona non grata during the modern election process because this means that the NPA would not be able to intimidate voters in these areas to vote for their preferred candidates.

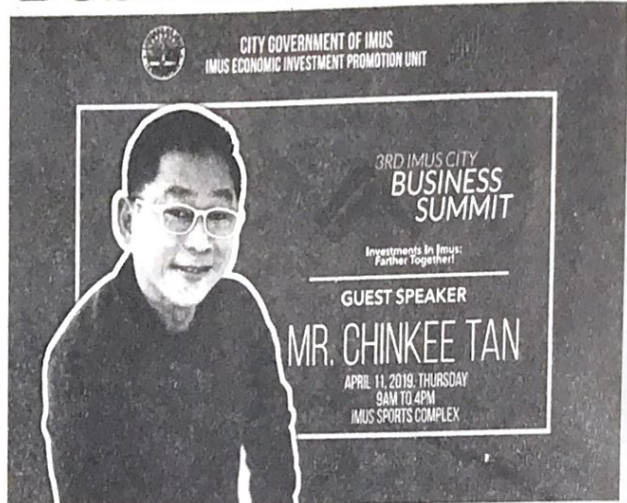
also reported that Luis Ferrer Jr. Senior High School has posted 633 NC passers for 2017-2018 and 729 for 2018-2019.

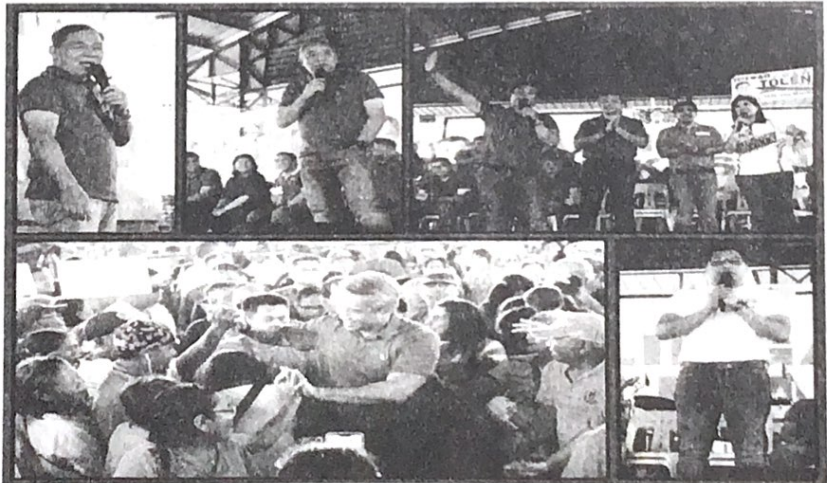
