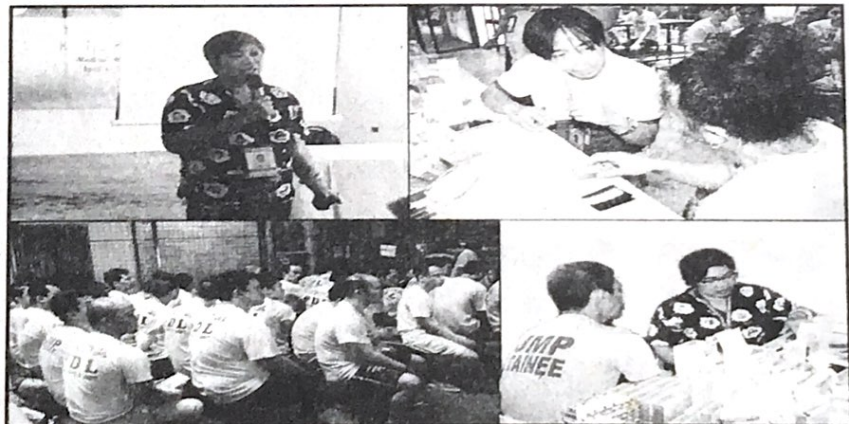

(From page 1) Director, Mr. Henry John were blessed and distributed to chosen unfortunate members of different Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) as the City. The NegoKart Four (4) major recipient organizations were Pasigang Pantayang Pilipino Program (4P), Persons with Disabilities (PWD), Green Ladies and the Kababaihan ng Dasmariñas from the National Government which amounts to Two Million Eight Hundred Thousand Pesos (P2,800,000.00). Overall, the entire project costs Four Million Twenty-two (2) Six Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-Five Pesos and Ninety Centavos (P4,665,735.90). Each NegoKart is complete with accessories and livelihood tools designed to sell the most in-demand street foods such as fishball, kikiam, umam, and burgers. Part of this project are free training on food processing and food handling, as well as free loans on business and financial management. This is to ensure that beneficiaries of the program are equipped with the proper knowledge needed to ensure viability of the business. Aside from skills training, recipients will also be issued business permit to operate in designated areas.

(From page 1) discussed during a modern review conducted on February 6, 2019 at PCAARRD, facilitated by Socio-Economics Research Division (SERD) under the leadership of Dr. Ernesto Brown. Headed by Carolyn C. Garcia of the Forestry and Natural Resources and Development Institute (DOF-FNRDI), the project aims to provide recommendations for improvement as the supply chain towards efficient and effective production and marketing of forest vices in the Philippines. The project, which will end on November 2019, is expected to complete the supply chain analysis, including the identification of activities and processes along the chain, analysis in the product information and

Forest vices are largely abundant in the Philippines. In fact, the country is the second largest world producer of handicrafts. Vices, specifically, are being bottled water to keep you hydrated, and well-packed foods that do not easily spoil, and umbrellas to protect you from the scorching rays as you visit churches. Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque III reminded the public: "He added that by doing these simple tips, one can avoid diseases common during summer, avoid bringing small children or babies in crowded places to prevent them from contracting diseases, as they have weaker resistance against infections compared to adults. Impact of the Filippinovation Coral Rehabilitation Program reviewed

By Estrella Z. Gallo January 2019. The project assessed the impacts of the coral transplantation technology using acroporally reproduced coral fragments on previously degraded coral reef ecosystems in selected sites in the Palang Pambansa (PPA) project.

The review was facilitated by PCAARRD's Socio-Economics Research Division (SERD) under the leadership of Dr. Ernesto Beros, Asst. Dir. De Anong and Dr. Narda, other project members - Ms. Ma Cristina Canale, Ms. Anshya Gion Balatosa and Ms. Mia Angela Saldaña of UPLB - were also present.

It was done to evaluate whether the project was able to achieve its objectives and expected outputs after two years and three months of implementation (November 2016 to

She also asserted the call for action on the rampant measles cases in the province which reached more than 1,000 and 17 deaths on the new MELLPI guidelines and elaborated some issues concerning the present practices in their locality. The different phases of the MELLPI were clarified during the assembly.
