## DepEd chief, Spanish ambassador pushes for Safe Schools Declara- tion, language program

Education Secretary Leonor Magtolis Briones met Spanish Ambassador Jorge Moragas Sanchez to discuss the Safe Schools Declaration and the Spanish Language Program during a courtesy call at the Department of Education (DepEd)-Central Office last April 4.

The Education chief emphasized that the Department strongly supports the Safe Schools Declaration through DepEd issu-ances and campaign ma-terials: "As for the Safe

Schools Declaration, we fully support it. We have issued a number of publi-cations and circulars in our Department. We have cam-paigned for it, especially in Mindanao. We require

all our schools to carry the posters with messages, "This is a zone of peace, this is a safe school." As to the status of the Safe Schools Declaration that will be endorsed by the government, Briones said: "The Declaration is already at the Office of the Executive Secretary for further comments and clearance."

Sanchez, on the other hand, told Briones that the Spanish Minister of Education and Professional Training, Hon. Ma. Isabel Celaà Diéguez, requested him to transmit a formal invitation for her to be one of the main speakers at the Third International Conference on Safe Schools to be held in Palma de Mallorca on May 28 to 29. He noted that the Philippines was one of those selected among the countries in the United Nations to present

# DILG: Inclusion of PH in US State Dep't advisory questionable

Foreigners in the Philippines have no reason to be alarmed as kidnapping cases continue to decrease according to the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), questioning the US State Department list naming the Philippines one of the countries with high kidnapping risk.

"We do not know how they came up with the list but with the strong stance of President Rodrigo Duterte against criminality in general, we see no basis for including us in this list. We will request from the US Embassy what were the parameters used even Malaysia and Russia were included," he said. According to the data of the Philippine National Police (PNP), there were only 68 cases of kidnapping in the country in 2018, majority of which were in Mindanao, 11 cases lower than in 2017. As of this writing, there are only 10 cases of kidnapping in Cavite. PNP Spokesperson Col. Bernard Binacay said that as the figure

# President Duterte to veto 2019 Nat'l Budget if anomalous

President Rodrigo Duterte said the national budget was just recently submitted. He would not hesitate to veto the 2019 national budget if he finds irregularities in it.

In a speech during the Partido Demokratiko Pilipino-Lakas ng Bayan (PDP-Laban) campaign rally here, President Duterte said the national budget was just recently submitted. "I have to sign it pagdating ko. Pagbalik ko pa. Pinag-aralan pa. Galing Budget to the Office of the President. The Office of the President is not the tiko-Lakas ng Bayan Budget. So ang legal ko magbasa uli," he said. "Ngayon, pagka ta-

lagang tagilid 'yan, I will outright veto the entire budget. Kaya hindi magkasundo ang Congress pati Senado eh. And 'yung mga insertions diyan, titingnan ko. Pagka tagilid talaga, I will not hesitate to veto the entire budget. Eh 'di pasensya tayong lahat," the President explained.

Lawmakers wrangled over alleged insertions in the national budget, stalling deliberations in Congress.

The government has been operating on a reenacted 2018 budget since the start of the year after lawmakers failed to agree on the 2019 national budget.

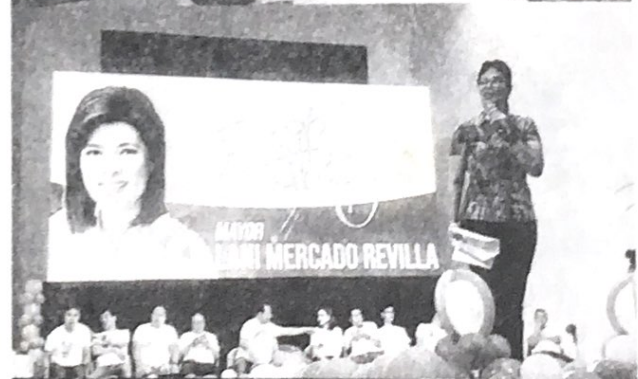
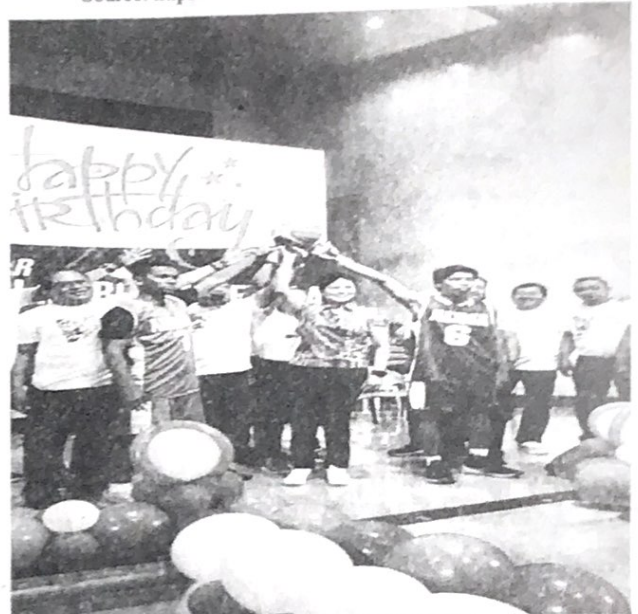
## Lungsod ng Bacoor, Cavite
