

Equip and Empower: A Joint Livelihood Program of TESDA and the City Government of Dasmariñas



Last July 06, 2019, the City Government stepped up its initiatives for Out-of-School Youth, unemployed adults, displaced workers, repatriated Overseas Filipino Workers (OFWs), solo parents, Persons with Disability (PWDs), and drug sur-renderees. In partnership with the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) Provincial Training Center (PTC)-Paliparan, it launched an orientation event on various TESDA scholarship programs and courses at Phase 2 Covered Court, Barangay Paliparan III. To make this orientation citywide, the City

Government clustered the seventy-five (75) barangays and scheduled them into four (4) Saturdays. Present in these orientation events were Cong. Pidi Barzaga, Mayor Jeny Austria-Barzaga, Vice Mayor Raul Rex Mangubat, City Councilors, and Barangay Captains. During the orientation event, attendees were informed of the seven (7) courses that TESDA offers for free. These are welding, refrigeration and air conditioning, electronics, dressmaking, massage, hairdressing and beauty care. The orientation program includes demonstration of actual performance of

the courses offered. The covered court was customized into cubicles where corresponding equipment of various courses were set up. Free haircut, massage, manicure and pedicure were also offered at the event.

Attendees of the first orientation event were from Barangay Paliparan I, II, and III. Five hundred eighty (580) of our constituents from these barangays participated. On the other hand, the second Reyes wave of orientation on July 13, 2019 was conducted at Fatima I Covered Court. Participating barangays were:

Dengue control and prevention in Cavite

With more than 6,000 dengue cases in the entire province of Cavite, the Provincial Health Office in partnership with BASF Philippines, Inc. conducted mosquito misting at the Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital compound in Trece Martires City on August 3, 2019. Personnel from BASF Philippines, Inc. started mosquito misting around the vicinity of GEAMH early in the morning, an initiative which is part of their corporate social responsibility. On behalf of the Provincial Health Office, Ms. Annabelle Dilig, OIC-Administrative Office for Public Health and Mr. Wilfredo Atas, Construction and Maintenance Foreman of GEAMH received 200 pieces of Interceptor Mosquito Nets and some larval and insect control products from BASF Philippines, Inc headed by Mr. Ronaldo Mercado, President and Managing Director together with Mr. Manolo Sambrano, Head-Agricultural Solutions, Mr. Randall Evangelista, Sales Manager-Agricultural Solutions and Ms. Paola Norial, Accounts Development Officer. DOH Caraga Inutile vs Dengue, One Died caused by Deworming

Dengue cases in Caraga region increases said the Department of Health – Caraga, it intensified the 4S campaign in the different provinces of the region. Data released by DOH-Caraga as of July 22, 2019 shows more than 6,000 dengue cases recorded in the region, higher compared to last year's figure of only 2,300 which very alarming already.

This is very high compared to last year's cases of 2,300, but questionably, with the new graph, DOH still considered it below the alert level," said Regional Director Dr. Jose Llacuna Jr. Computation shows a 260.86% increase of Dengue cases in Caraga, yet, DOH Caraga was not yet alarmed.

The health department also reminded the different barangays to continuously perform the 4S campaign to prevent the spread of dengue disease. These are: search and destroy; self-protection measures; seek early consultation; and say no to indiscriminate fogging.

The DOH Caraga also recognized the effort of the local government units in the region for their constant implementation of the health programs to the public.

The public asked why fogging is not the first line of defense of killing mosquitoes and ultimately stopped Dengue when it should be the best. Fogging should be an act of

DOH DECLARES NATIONAL DENGUE EPIDEMIC

The Department of Health (DOH) today requested the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and Chair Secretary Delfin N. Lorenzana to convene a full council meeting and declared a national dengue epidemic in the wake of the 146,062 cases recorded since January up to July 20 this year, 98% higher than the same period in 2018. There were 622 deaths. Based on the DOH Dengue Surveillance Report, Region VI (Western Visayas) had the most number of cases at 23,330, followed by Region IV-A (CALABARZON) with 16,515, Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula) with 12,317, Region X (Northern Mindanao) with 11,455, and Region XII (SOCCSKSARGEN) with 11,083 cases.

Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque III stressed. Meanwhile, seven (7) out of these seventeen (17) regions have exceeded the epidemic threshold of dengue in their regions for the past three consecutive weeks. These regions are: Region IV-A (CALABARZON) with 16,515 cases; MIMAROPA – 4,254; V (Bicol) with 3,470; VI (Western Visayas) with 23,330; VIII (Eastern Visayas) with 7,199; IX (Zamboanga Peninsula) with 12,317; and X (Northern Mindanao) with 11,455 cases.

Other regions exceeded the alert threshold level, such as Region I (Ilocos) with 4,396 cases; VII (Central Visayas) with 10,728; and BARM (Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao) with 2,301. The total number of cases nationwide for the 29th Morbidity Week alone (July 14-20) is 10,502. This is 71% higher compared to the same period in 2018 (6,128 cases). Starting today, the Department of Health together with other government agencies, LGUs, schools, offices, and communities will conduct the Sabayang 4-O'clock Habit para Deng-Get Out, focusing on search and destroy of mosquito breeding sites. This is one of the primary interventions to prevent and control dengue. "Kaya sabaysabaytayong mag-search and destroy tuwing 4 o'clock para deng-get-out!", Duque urged the public.
