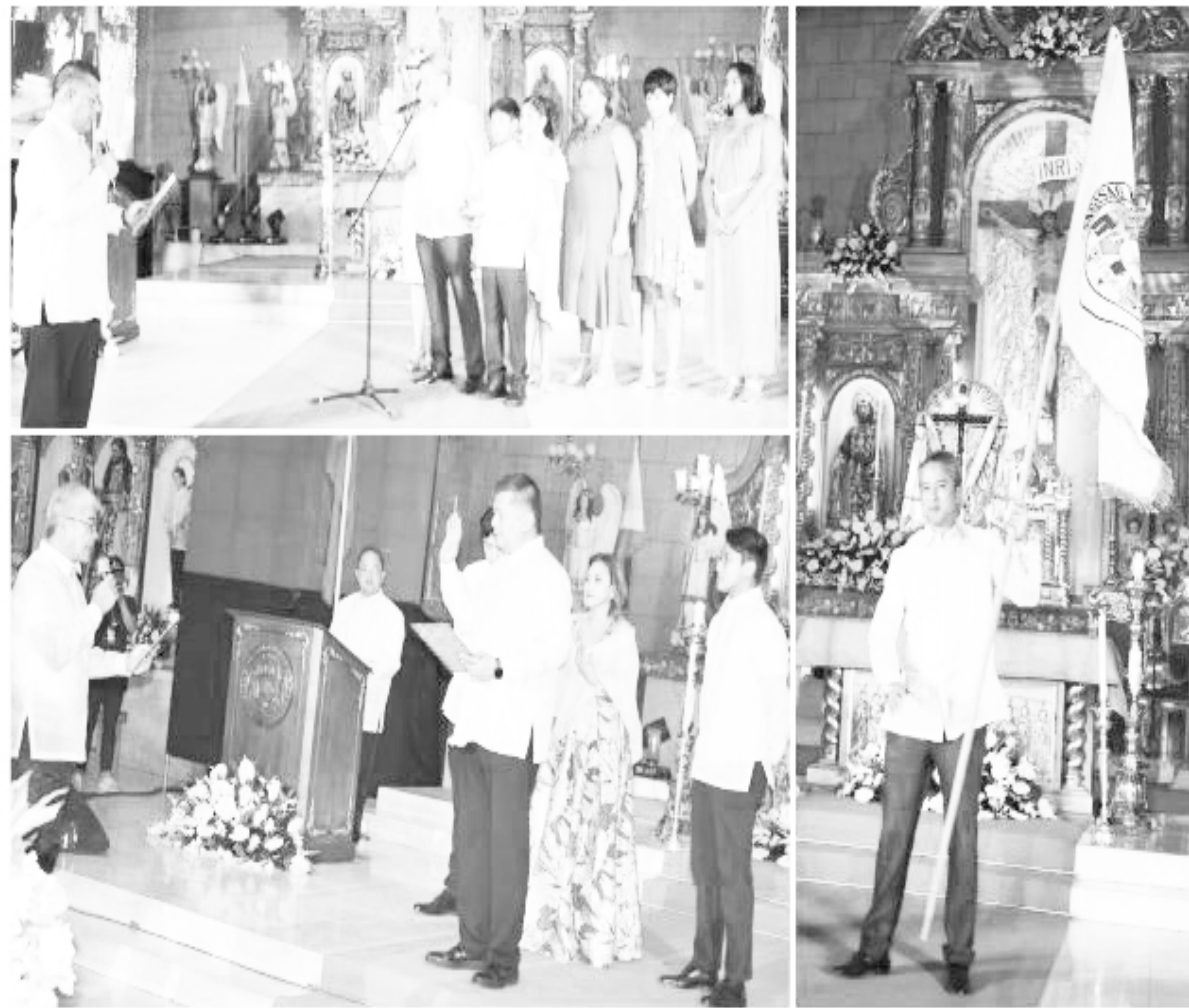


# Oath-taking of Cavite elected officials

Governor Jonvic Remulla took oath of office on June 25, 2019 at the diocesan shrine of Saint Augustine, popularly known as the Santa Cruz Parish in Tanza. Outgoing Cavite Governor Boying Remulla led the simple oath-taking rites of the new governor and other elected officials in the province including Vice Governor Jolo Revilla, board members of the eight districts of the province as well as the elected officials of Tanza. Governor Boying Remulla also sworn to his duties as the 7th District Representative before Tanza Mayor Yuri Pacumio at the altar of the 200-year-old cross of the historic church where Gen. Emilio F. Aguinaldo took his oath of office as the president of the revolutionary government on March 23, 1897. ## Mechanized rice farming helps reduce production cost, improves yield and income

In Region 2, mechanized rice farming resulted in lower production cost due to savings in labor. This was reported by Engr.

Generoso M. Oli, Chief of the Field Operations Division of the Department of Agriculture- Regional Field Office 02 (DA-RFO-2) Tuguegarao City, Cagayan.

It showcased and promoted mechanized seeds and seedling preparation, crop establishment, and harvesting to farmers' organization. The technologies reduced production cost and man-day labor requirement. It addressed the problem of labor scarcity in the region during peak season.

In a report presented to PCAARRD, Project Leader Engr. Oli and his team introduced rice production using mechanized crop establishment machinery such as mechani-

## Spore Bank established for conservation and propagation of ferns

To address the decline in fern populations specially the endangered and economically important ferns are being conserved and propagated through a project titled, "Spore Bank Establishment, Propagation and Conservation of Economically Important Ferns."

The project aims to address the decline in fern populations by maintaining spore availability and viability throughout the year. It was achieved through the establishment of a spore bank for long-term conservation; development of propagation protocols for spore germination as well as gametophyte and sporophyte development; and propagation of endangered and economically important ferns through in vitro culture.
