## New Bilibid Prison's persons deprived of liberty earn basic education diploma through ALS

A total of 139 persons deprived of liberty (PDL) who passed the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test attended their recognition and graduation ceremony at the Maximum Security Compound (MaxSeCom) of the New Bilibid Prison (NBP).

The Department of Education's (DepEd) ALS is a second-chance education program for out-of-school youth and adults including PDL who cannot read or write and those who would like to continue their studies while serving their sentence.

This is also part of the Reformation Program

of the Bureau of Corrections (BuCor) to facilitate the education of PDL.

The 2018 batch achieved a 96.52% passing rate after taking the A&E test—43 PDL passed the elementary level with a passing rate of 91.48%, while 96 passed the Junior High School level with a

# Duterte, Año to all mayors, govns: Intensify war against drugs, corruption, communist terrorism

A day right after his fourth State of the Nation Address (SONA), President Rodrigo Roa Duterte met personally with all local chief executives (LCEs) of the country and emphasized his directive for them to intensify the war against illegal drugs, corruption, and Communist terrorism.

Seventy-four governors and 1,538 city and municipal mayors heard it straight from the President in a meeting organized by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) in Manila on Tuesday.

"I task each of you to protect your constituents and safety of the community by avoiding involvement in illegal drugs. I will not allow any community to be swallowed by drugs. Among laban ng mga ordinaryong mga tao kung mismong mga mayor at gobernador ang naglalaro (involved in drugs)?" he said to the LCEs.

He reminded the local government officials to resist corruption as it destroys the society's 'moral fiber.' "Let us clean the government. Workers of government we are, so we do it right."

He reiterated his directive to DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año to file administrative cases against LCEs who do not comply with the processing time prescribed under the Ease of Doing Business Act.

"Irelease na agad clearance or permit. Wag pabalik-balikin. I am directing Secretary Año to file an administrative case or recommend his/her suspension. I will affirm it," the President said.

Meanwhile, he prodded the LCEs to help the government fight communist terrorism in their areas of jurisdictions. "Do not support the NPA (New People's Army). Do not give money to the NPA or any of their front organizations. Kung gusto mo tawagan mo ako, ako ang pupunta doon sa kanila," he said.

Duterte said that he is raising the bounty for the capture of the terrorists behind the brutal murder of four police officers in Ayungon, Negros Oriental last Thursday by members of the New People's Army (NPA).

The slain cops, Cpl. Relebert Beronio, Pat. Raffy Callo, Pat. Roel Cabellon and Pat. Marquino de Leon, were intelligence personnel from the 704th Mobile Force Company, Regional Mobile Force Battalion of the Philippine National Police (PNP) in Central Visayas.

"Today I'm offering P2-million for the capture of culprits behind the Negros incident. You (rebels) do not torture a person na 'di makalaban," he said.

He also warned against violent extremism. "Talagang madugo ito. I will order the Armed Forces to invade Basilan, Tawi Tawi, Sulu, if needed."

The President also assured all local officials that his aim is to develop the whole of the country. "I will be fair in budget allocation. Basta ako fair lang. It's not my money. It's people's money. I want you to be my friends. I will not ask anything from you. Politically, I will not be your enemy. I can no longer

run. Let us all be friends. I assure you have this administration beside you as you pursue meaningful and dignified lives for your constituents."
