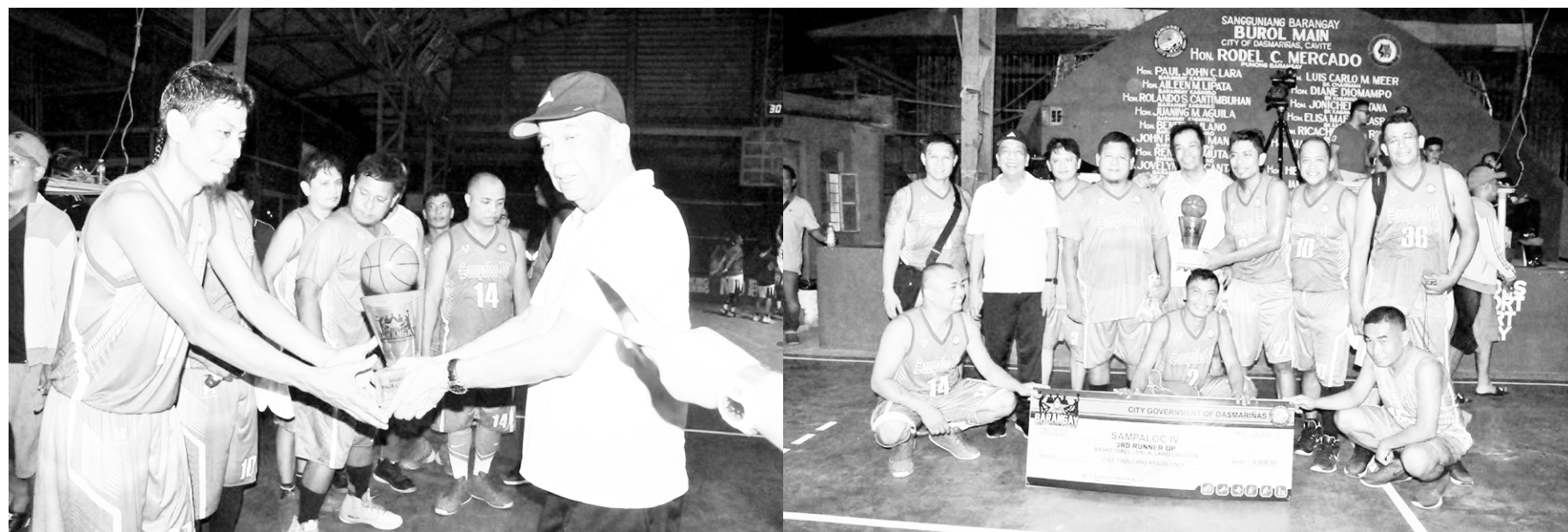

PCAARRD presents AANR tech commercialization initiatives at the BCAARRD Agri-FIESTA through TTPD

Galardo The Philippine Council for Agriculture, Aquatic and Natural Resources Research and Development of the Department of Science and Technology through its Technology Transfer and Promotion Division (TTPD), presented the Council's technology commercialization initiatives in the agricultural resources (AANR) sector. This presentation was made during the second day of the Farms and Industry Encoun-

ment of Agriculture in Region 3. So far, the project which started in July 2018, has updated topographic base maps of onion and garlic in Nueva Ecija. The project that is expected to be completed in September 2020 has generated maps of leaf miner infestation in onion in Nueva Ecija from December 2018 to January 2019.

The is being conducted through the leadership of CLSU's Dr. Ronaldo T. Alberto. Reports submitted to PCAARRD show that all municipalities are affected except for Lupao. The highest leaf miner infestation was recorded in Rizal with an area of 185.45 hectares or 14.31% of the 1,295.87 hectares total area planted recorded in the municipalities of Aliaga, Talavera, and Pantabangan.

All the generated map series of leaf miner and anthracnose-twister incidence as of January 2019 were turned over to and discussed with officials of Municipal Agriculture Offices of Nueva Ecija, Regional Crop Protection Center, and other stakeholders. Early detection and mapping of the disease-

ters through the Science and Technology Agenda (FIESTA) of the Bicol Consortium for Agriculture, Aquatic and Natural Resources Research and Development (BCAARRD) on March 8, 2019 at the Albay Farmers Bounty Village in Camalig, Albay. Ms. Abigail Gue-

co, on behalf of TTPD and development institutes (RDIs) in securing Intellectual Property (IP) protection and pursuing IP commercialization. It also aims to provide alternative solutions and assistance in case of shortfall in the RDIs' performance in protecting, utilizing, and commercializing the IP.

To fast-track technology commercialization, the Council established the DOST-PCAARRD Innovation and Technology Center (DPITC) in Los Baños, Laguna.

Seventy-six projects and other services are now offered through the DPITC. These projects are focused on IP management, business development, capacity building, and policy development which are considered as new PCAARRD investment initiatives.

The projects fall within the following major areas: technology assessment; prior art search; IP protection; freedom to operate review; technology valuation; business plan; and fairness opinion review.

Ms. Gueco stressed that the life cycle of a technology does not end once it is invented; it is only the start of its journey towards innovation. Bridging inventions to innovations requires new sets of commercialization initiatives and collaboration among the actors of the innovation ecosystem. This is to move technologies from the laboratories to local and eventually, the global market.

T o d a y , D O S T - P C A A R R D through the DPITC platform supports 26 Intellectual Property and Technology Business Management (IP-TBM) Offices, 14 Agri-Aqua Technology Business Incubators (AT-BIs), and 4 Science for the Convergence of Agriculture and Tourism (SciCAT) sites across the country. Gueco ended with the presentation of commercialized technologies and the Council's aim to continue bridging inventions to innovations through TTPD. (Philippine Press Club, Inc. (PPCI)).

With the theme "Science and technology for the People", the BCAARRD Agri-FIESTA highlighted technologies on coconut, queen pineapple, and sweet potato. The presentation covered the Research and Development Results Utilization (RDRU) framework of DOST-PCAARRD as well as the technology commercialization initiatives of the Council being one of its priority concerns.

Ms. Gueco stated that DOST-PCAARRD, as a government funding agency (GFA), advocates for technology commercialization in accordance with the Philippine Technology Transfer Act of 2009 (R.A. No. 10055). The law mandates GFAs to monitor efforts and effectiveness of the research

Pitching session and exhibits

The technologies supported by the three DOST Councils were pitched to potential investors and adopters to cater to their intended beneficiaries.

The pitching session was divided into groups, namely: agricultural productivity; disaster resilience; information technology development; micro, small, and medium enterprise (MSME) competitiveness; and quality healthcare.

Pitched by their respective speakers were eight PCAARRD-supported technologies which were featured under agricultural productivity as listed below:

- Protein-Enriched Copra Meal (PECM) as Feeds (Mr. Nico G. Dumanan, University of the Philippines Los Baños or UPLB)
- SFEED (Sure Feed for Goats) Pellet Feeds for Goats (Dr. Edgar A. Orden, Central Luzon State University or CLSU)
- Juan Algae Microalgal Paste as Aqua-feeds (Engr. John Lorenz R. Belanio, University of the Philippines Visayas or UPV)
- Andali™ RT-LAMP Kit for PED Virus Detection in Swine (Dr. Clarissa Yvonne J. Domingo, CLSU)
- JAmP® Alert Diagnostic Kit for Shrimp (Dr. Mary Beth B. Maningas, University of Santo Tomas or UST)

pesticide for Cavendish Banana (Dir. Glenn N. Bat-icados, UPLB)

• MicroMix Biostimulant for Plants (Dr. Man-nix S. Pedro, UPLB)

• Rice Production Mechanization Technologies: Rice Seeder, Rice Transplanter, Rice Combine Harvester, and Far-Infrared Grain Dryer (Ms. Chona Mae Suner-Narvadez, Philippine Rice Research Institute or Phil-Rice)

Other technologies were also displayed at the exhibit area. These included the Abaca Bunchy Top Virus (ABTV) Diagnostic Kit, Coffee Greenhouse Solar Dryer, Chevron Products from Slaughtered

Goats, Automatic Milk-fish Fry Counter, Native Chicken Production, and Biosensor Kit for Shrimp, among others.

The exhibit area also served as a venue for technology generators or representatives to negotiate and discuss collaborations, adoption strategies, and/or exchange of information.

It also served as a venue for the signing of term sheets between the technology generators and interested parties to fast-track the transfer of technologies.

DOST officials observed and participated under the pillars and/or sub-pillars of an innovation ecosystem. He said that as of 2018, out of 126

Development (R&D) Rowena Cristina L. Guevara discussed Technology Readiness Level (TRL) and Investment Readiness Level (IRL) as a means of assessing the maturity of technologies.

She also encouraged the cooperation of everyone in bringing the technologies to their "fully commercial" level at level 9.

Meanwhile, DOST Secretary de la Peña highlighted that the technologies featured in the second national Technology Transfer Day were directly under the pillars and/or sub-pillars of an innovation ecosystem. He said that as of 2018, out of 126

countries, the Philippines ranked 73rd in Global Innovation Index (GII).

De la Peña also said that based from the observations in the data provided in the GII, DOST is currently looking into the following factors at play in the innovation ecosystem: commercialization, diversity of the technologies, research and development (R&D), entrepreneurship and administrative challenges.

He added that while not all of these are directly rated in the GII, they play a crucial role in the country's innovation ecosystem and in effect, the country's global standing. In pursuit of its mandate, DOST has

been adopting strategies and approaches to address these.

Secretary de la Peña, along with the Director General of the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOP), Atty. Josephine Rima-Santiago, led the ceremonial signing of the amendments to the implementing rules and regulations of Republic Act No. 10055 during the event.

The first national Technology Transfer Day was held on April 27, 2016 at the Sofitel Philippine Plaza Hotel, Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) Complex, Pasay City (Philippine Press Club, Inc. (PPCI))
