### NAST PHL conducts Science Information Forum on African Swine Fever

Galardo The National Academy of Science and Technology Philippines (NAST-PHL), as part of its efforts to formulate science-based policies is preventing deadly health-related outbreaks of African Swine Fever (ASF) conducted a round table discussion on ASF June 11, 2019 at Max Restaurant, Circle, Quezon City.

The event is part of NAST PHL's initiative to prevent the entry of ASF and create measures to mitigate an outbreak, in case the deadly disease enters the Philippines.

Since the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) underscores that ASF is a fatal animal disease affecting pigs and wild boars with up to 100 percent mortality, outbreak control strategies must be in place.

This can effectively be addressed through close communication and coordination with local experts in the swine industry, including veterinarians and other government and private organizations.

In line with this, a Science Information Forum was conducted to determine the status of the deadly ASF and identify the measures taken by the government, academe, and private sectors to prevent its entry in the Philippines. Ultimately, the activity seeks to collate inputs that will provide useful information in crafting a policy paper. Such output aims to complement with the efforts made by the government and other sectors in preventing the entry of

ASF in the country. Representatives from public and private organizations, academic institutions, research and development institutions, swine breeders' associations, and other attached agencies, of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) attended the forum.

Among the topics presented were the history of ASF, economic implications of this disease, and lectures highlighting the different initiatives made by the government, academe and private sectors to ensure that an outbreak in the Philippines will be prevented, these were discussed by Dr. Maria Glofiezita Lagayan, Focal person for communication, African Swine Forum Task

9); and "Spore Bank Establishment, Propagation, and Conservation" of the Central Mindanao University (CMU).

The CLSU study aims to address dairy goat's feed availability through its Indigofera-based pellets, which they coined "Sure Feed for Goats" or "SFEED." On the other hand, the DA-RFO 9 study seeks to provide quality planting materials of rubber using the root trainer technology. The technology speeds up the growth of seedlings in 5-6 months compared with the conventional method

of sowing one whorl of rubber seeds in budded polybags, which takes 8-10 months. Lastly, the CMU technology aims to address the decline of ferns biodiversity in the country by populating the spore bank in the university. The spore bank already contains 770 collections of spores from 120 species of ferns.

On the other hand, Participatory Action Research (CPAR), wherein place in the development category are "CPAR on Integrated rice-based farming system management: Approach towards Community-driven Agricultural Development in Ilocos Norte" of the DA-RFO

1; "Technology Demonstration and Promotion of Mechanized Rice Farming in the Lowland Irrigated Areas in Region 2" by DA-RFO 2; and "Enhancing Mungbean Production in Bicol Region" of the DA-RFO 5.

The DA-RFO 1 study details the results of its Community-based Participatory Action Research (CPAR), wherein an increased cropping pattern from 20 hectares (ha) to 60.4 ha and a high net return amounting to P33,727.91/ha (444.51% increase) in rainfed areas and P66,394.07/ha (164%

increase) in irrigated areas. Meanwhile, the DA-RFO 2 study aims to increase the level of rice production through the use of machines such as the Mechanical Direct Seeder and Transplanter. Lastly, the

DA-RFO 5 study employs the strategy of crop diversification to maximize land use and increase income and productivity. Organized by DOST-PCAARRD, the NSAARRD recognizes the

### Goat feed made from Indigofera increases goat milk production

According to the National Dairy Authority (NDA), Philippines milk import in 2018 totaled 531.47 million kilograms (kg), worth P52 billion. Local milk production, on the other hand, only contributed 23.69 M kg.

Of the total local milk production, only 3% came from dairy goats. Local milk production, which averages 1.17 liters/day per animal, was hampered by the scarcity of feeds and poor genetics, which are cited as some of the challenges of the industry.

To increase the production of goat milk, a study by the Central Luzon State University (CLSU) of CLSU, Nueva Ecija, titled, "Enhancing Milk

Production of Dairy Goats through Indigofera zollingeriana Supplementation," explored the use of a shrub, Indigofera zollingeriana as feed for dairy goats. The potential of the shrub was initially observed by the late Rene Alameda, a farmer from Alaminos, Laguna. His herd's milk production increased exponentially when he in-

duced Indigofera to the goats. CLSU then, after this observation and after Alameda challenged research institutions to investigate the science behind Indigofera's potential, studied the shrub's nutritional composition and degradation characteristics. They also studied Indigofera's potential in increasing milk yield as well as its financial benefit for goat raisers.

The offshoot of the CLSU study is the product now registered with the Intellectual Property Office (IPO) as Sure Feed for Goats or "SFEED" - pelletized Indigofera that is cheap, nutritionally-balanced, and highly digestible for goats.

The study noted a 195.86 liters (L) milk yield in 110-day lactation when the lactating Saanen does were fed with Indigofera and napier. This milk yield was 23.61% higher than milk yield from goats fed with Leucaena-based diet (Leucaena-based pellets and napier), which only recorded 149.6 L. The difference in milk yield was valued at P6,936.

In terms of cost, lactating does

with SFEED together with napier in 110 days only costs P1,011.37 or an additional cost of only P5.45 compared with Leucaena-based diet.

According to the study, feed intake is an important factor to boost milk production. Intake of Indigofera with napier reached 1,425 g per day or 0.8% higher than the recommended 3% consumption by body weight. With the increased feed intake, the study observed higher milk production especially from early to peak of lactation.

Investing in SFEED for 115 metric ton production, which include the pelletizing machine, labor, and operational expenses, will cost P1,536,689. According to the investment analysis, the internal rate of return (IRR) is at 15%.

Meanwhile, the study also provided an investment plan for a 25-doe dairy goat production, wherein total investment for Anglo-Nubian goats was at P2,090,742 and P2,129,457 for Saanen goats. The projected average return of investment (ROI) was at 69.49% and 121.88% for Anglo-Nu-
