be fully aware of the above-words that it stays committed towards advancing different safety programs in the city. One of these is the continued provision of additional police equipment and facilities to the city

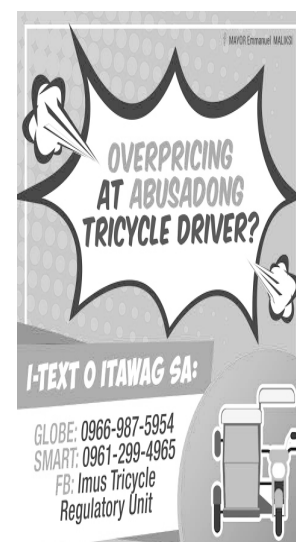
law enforcers.

The newly-purchased mobile outposts add to the first four (4) outposts which were already operational. Each of these outposts comes with technologically advanced features. Sitting on a thirteen (13) square meter area with a dimension of 5.2 meters by 2.5 meters, they are furnished with a built-in LED wall, and an LED

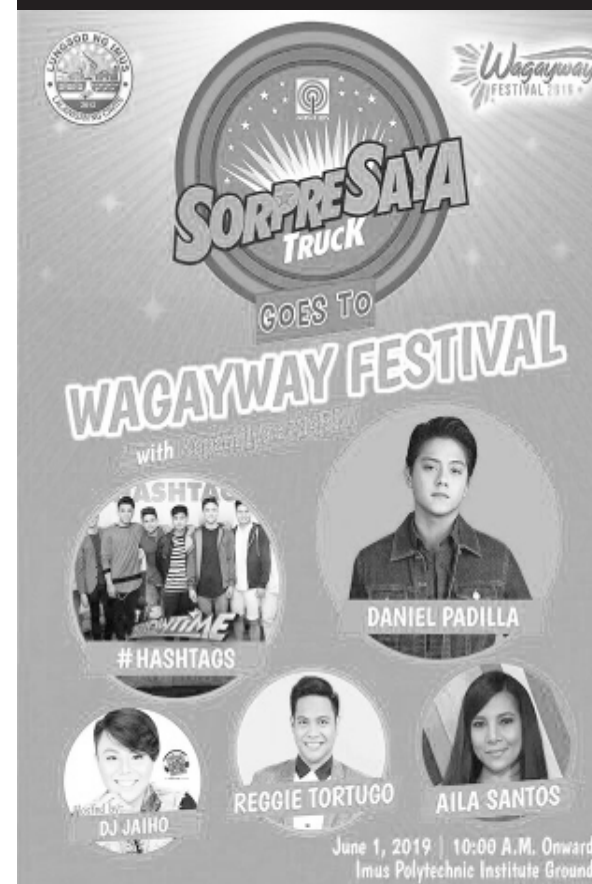
# Empowering farmers through Go Negosyo mentor on wheels at SM Dasmariñas City, Cavite

**Salceda seeks SC TRO vs. MMDA prov'l bus ban**

Albay Rep. Joey Salceda is on the warpath and has sought a Temporary Restraining Order (TRO) from the Supreme Court against the Metro Manila Development Authority's (MMDA) provincial buses along EDSA and transfer their stations some 39 kms away to Santa Rosa, Laguna and Valenzuela City for

(From page 3) EDSA. MMDA he noted will enforce its EDSA Ban on 6,000 provincial buses on June 1 and the LTRFB will cancel their franchises to enter EDSA, but will license at least 14,000 new black painted Premium Taxis (whose owner remains unknown) with a P70 flag down rate ferry more than 50,000 passengers daily from the "super terminals" in Sta. Rosa and Valenzuela, and at least 2,000 new P2P buses and thousands of UV Express vans at both stop-off points to enter EDSA.

"How then will they reduce traffic when they will add an assortment of close to 20,000 new vehicles just so they can evict 6,000 provincial buses from EDSA? Add more the Grab vehicles riders will page from both stop-off points towards EDSA and what do we have?" he asked.

Salceda pointed out that "there are 2.8 million cars in the National Capital Region, most of them plying EDSA, versus only 6,000 provincial buses. He stressed that "worldwide, public transport has priority over private vehicles, which is common sense. Even in New York City or in Tokyo, the provincial bus stations are in the heart of the city because public transport has priority over private vehicles." "Why he pick on our 'pobrang probinsyanos' to solve Metro Manila traffic? While each bus can carry 50, each car carries only five at most. MMDA should have managed the 800,000 utility vehicles, 400,000 cars, 120,000 trucks and 1.4 million tricycles fighting for every available space in the streets of Metro Manila," he pointed out. "In the absence of the North-South Commuter Rail, I can't imagine myself taking another ride to Sta. Rosa from my Shaw residence, on my way home to Daraha, Albay. Elderly 'probinsyanos' will find that even more punishing," he lamented, adding the ban is clearly "anti-poor, since most provincial commuter takes buses only that chage less than P1,000 since they cannot afford expensive plane fares. For sure, "it cannot be the number of provincial buses but drivers' behavior in Metro Manila that causes traffic chaos, since provincial buses pick up and drop passengers only in their own terminal," he said.

The transfer and opening of provincial terminals to the outskirts of Metro Manila had attempted several times but were postponed for various reasons. END

(From page 6) the Philippines with other countries of the region," she said.

Zhou also noted that in November last year, the NRTA and the PCOO signed a memorandum of agreement on Sino-Philippine Broadcasting and Television Cooperation.

"China is willing to continue to strengthen cooperation with the Philippines in the fields of news exchange, program production, technology R&D, industrial development and human resources construction, to achieve win-win and common development," she added. Meanwhile, Liu Ying, vice president of NRTA's Research and Training Institute, said since the diplomatic ties between China and the Philippines began in June 1975, the two nations have put the concept of "harmony" in working together to push for mutual development. "The workshop will build an extensive communication platform for media professionals in China and the Philippines, actively promote the in-depth media convergence and promote the common development of the industry of the two countries," she said. The Philippine delegation, led by PCOO Director Vinci Beltran, consists of media practitioners from the PCOO and its attached agencies -- the Philippine News Agency, Radio Television Malacañang, Philippine Information Agency, People's Television Network, Inc. and the Bureau of Communication Services.

Completing the 30-man delegation are journalists from Sun Star (Cebu), iOrbitNews (Pampanga), Manila Times (Bulacan) and Pulso ng Makabagong Caviteño. The 2019 Seminar for Media Reporters of the Philippines is a 14-day seminar set in Beijing and Shenzhen, China. Organized by RTI-NRTA, it aims to build cooperation and understanding between the media industries in the two countries. (PNA)

The acquisition of these outposts are expected to render policing service in the City more effective.
