2019 Day Care Graduation: Taking the Big Step in Dasmariñas, Cavite

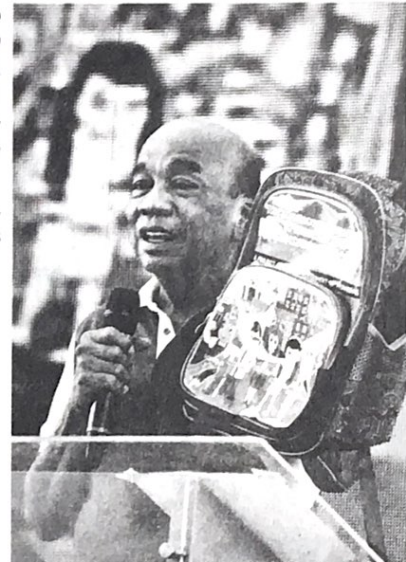

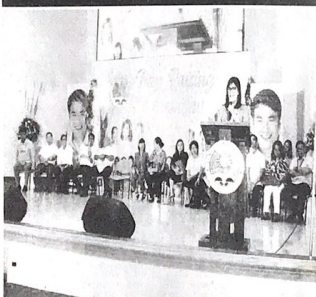

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH INTRODUCES THE JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS (JE) VACCINE IN REGIONS MOST AFFECTED BY THE JE DISEASE

The Department of Health (DOH) introduced the Japanese Encephalitis (JE) vaccine in the Philippines. One in every 250 of those infected with the JE virus will succumb to severe illness, with an onset characterized by flu-like symptoms (sudden onset of high fever, chills, headache, and tiredness). Disease may rapidly progress to severe viral disease and encephalitis (infection of the brain) in Asia. Children most at risk of JE are those who live in rural areas and are exposed to mosquito bites. The disease is a leading cause of viral encephalitis in the Philippines. It is endemic in every region in the country. The DOH gives to more than 400 million children with an excellent safety record.

JE transmission, only two countries have not introduced the vaccine in their immunization program, and one of these is the Philippines. Now, the Japanese encephalitis vaccine is available in the Philippines. This vaccine is WHO-prequalified and Philippine FDA approved. It is safe and effective. It has been used for over 30 years in 12 countries and in the country. The DOH gives to more than 400 million children with an excellent safety record.

JE is a mosquito-borne viral disease and encephalitis (infection of the brain). At this stage, symptoms like mental disturbances and progressive decline in consciousness occur in >75% of paediatric patients. Three out of 10 JE cases that progress to severe illness will die. Among those who survive, more than half will show serious residual neurological, psychosocial, intellectual and/or physical disabilities such as paralysis, recurrent seizures, or inability to speak.

JE disease activity in the Philippines, JE disease activity peaks at the start of the rainy season, hence the campaign is scheduled before this period.

WHO recommends that JE vaccination should be integrated into the national immunization schedules in all areas where JE is recognized as a public health priority. The most effective immunization strategy in JE endemic settings is a one-time campaign followed by incorporation of JE vaccine into the routine childhood immunization programme.

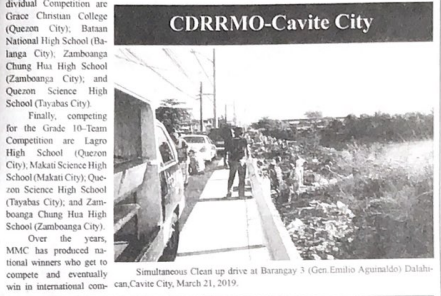

Ilocos RDC recommends PORTASOL dryer use

The Ilocos Regional Development Council (RDC 1) has noted the very encouraging feedback they have gathered from Ilocos farmers and many others from various regions, on how the Portable Solar Dryer (Portasol) has benefited them since RDC 1 recommended and endorsed the technology in 2018, following its introduction to them the previous year. In their 2018 resolution, the RDC 1 Board urged "all government instrumentalities" and concerned groups to promote the Portasol technology among farmers and users of drying facilities after it found the equipment to be highly effective and efficient in drying not only palay but also other high-value crops including corn and tobacco and even fish. National Economic Development Authority (NEDA) Ilocos regional director and RDC 1 vice chair Nestor Rillon said it is necessary to address the inefficiency of post-harvest facilities in the region that "aggravates the practice of drying palay on national roads and highways, while causing tremendous losses worth billions of pesos." Rillon noted that for decades, no significant investment has been made to address the country's post-harvest problems. The DPWH has banned palay drying along highways but the ban is hardly noticed. "The Portasol drier is both timely and crucial in achieving what the country needs now," he stressed. A study by the Bureau of Postharvest Research and Extension indicates that the country suffers tremendous losses worth billions of pesos from wasteful drying practices. The lack of post-harvest facilities complicates the problem further because farmers are compelled to sell their fresh palay to dealers at low prices" and rice dealers use the highways to dry them. The Portasol is a Filipino invention. It was developed by Francisco "Popoy" Pagayon, president of the Filipino Inventors Society (FIS) and the FIS Producers' Cooperative (FISPC) who said he designed it for drying palay and other high-value crops, including fish, save grains losses, help address risks to farmers and commuters' lives along highways, and help spare motorists from being held hostage by workers of big-time rice dealers who even install physical barriers so vehicles will not run over the grass they dry. To discourage big rice dealers from using the highways to dry their grains, Pagayon said the government may consider imposing "fines" on a per-square-meter basis of the paved road space they occupy (Win Basillar).

DILG files cases vs 45 mayors for failing to organize local anti-drug abuse councils

Forty-five mayors (45) are facing cases before the Office of the Ombudsman for their alleged failure or refusal to create their respective Anti-Illegal Drugs Abuse Council (ADAC) in their localities, according to the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG).

Of the 45 mayors, 15 are in Bicol Region, particularly in Albay, Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Masbate, and Sorsogon provinces.

Seven are in Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM), specifically in Basilan, Tawi-Tawi, and Lanao del Sur provinces.

Five are in Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR), exactly in Abra and Ifugao provinces. There are also five in Mindanao, all from Palawan province.

In Central Visayas, four mayors are all in Cebu province. In CARAGA, all three mayors are in Agusan del Norte province. There are also three in Calabarzon, precisely in Laguna and Quezon provinces.

Moreover, there are two from Cagayan Valley – one in Cagayan province and one in Nueva Vizcaya. There is also one in Eastern Visayas, from Eastern Samar province.

The DILG and the DDB issued Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2018-01 on May 21, 2018, mandating all local government units (LGUs) to activate, strengthen and ensure the functionality of their local ADACs; approve a comprehensive local anti-drug plan of action to eliminate drug affectation; and appropriate a substantial amount of funds for anti-illegal drugs related programs, activities and operations.

This was followed by numerous DILG directives and DDB regulations which have been cascaded to LGUs to remind and direct local chief executives to organize their respective ADACs.

“For their refusal or neglect to organize their local ADAC, the 45 mayors have committed grave misconduct in office and gross dereliction of duty,” he says.

Misconduct is a transgression of some established and definite rule of action, more particularly, unlawful behaviour or gross negligence by a public officer, a forbidden act, a dereliction of duty, wilful in character, and implies wrongful intent and not mere error in judgment.
