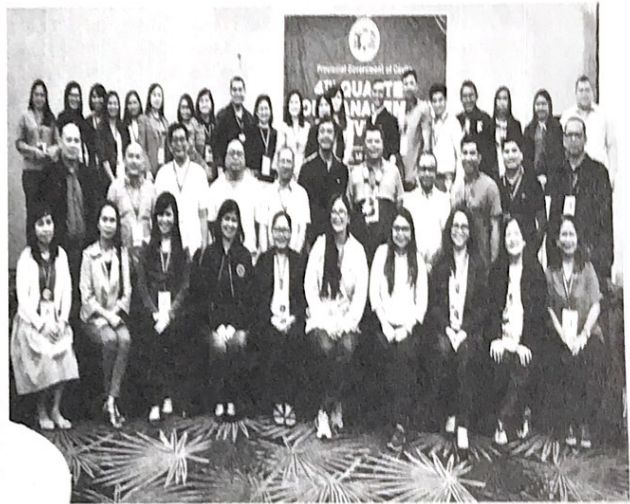

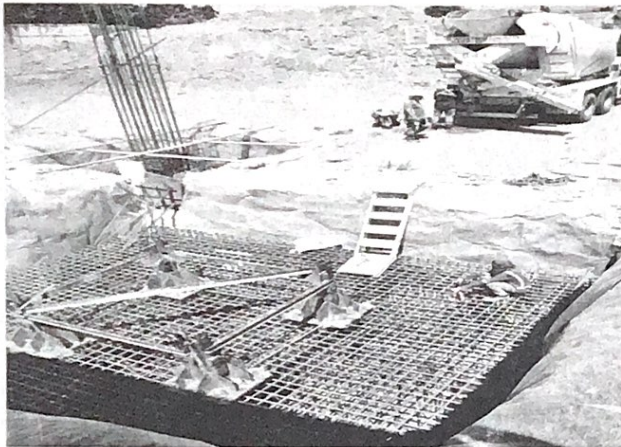

# The Birth of Another Hope: The First Concrete Pouring Ceremony of a Public University in the City of Dasmariñas

In an effort of the City Government to make education more inclusive, the plan to build a public university was conceived. Last Friday, on the 22nd day of February, 2019, the plan was made more concrete!

The City Mayor, Atty. Elpidio F. Barzaga, Jr. led the first concrete pouring ceremony of the soon-to-be public university in the City. Joining the ceremony were Congresswoman-

an Jennifer Austria-Barzaga; Vice Mayor Raul Rex D. Mangubat; Board Member Rudy Lara; City Councilors; Kababaihan ng Dasmariñas sa Bagong Milenyong (KDBM); Green Ladies; and Barangay Captains.

Together with the public university, a grandstand, sports arena and track and field oval are to be built at Brgy. Burol Main. The General Contractor for the project is Monolith Construction and Development Corp. while the architectural service shall be provided by the JSLA

Architects. The winning bid for construction of the public university amounts to P366,000,000.00. Accordingly, the construction commenced last 21st day of September, 2018 and the target date of project completion is on the 21st day of March, 2020.

This public university shall be known as the Pamantasan ng Dasmariñas and it shall be opened to the class of S.Y. 2020-2021.

This project is expected to benefit thousands of youth in the City who will be afforded free tuition fees. Also, because of the location of the university, it will save their parents expensive transportation fee, as well as from worries of being far from their children.

Truly, as what Congresswoman Jenny said, "Ito ang sagot sa pangarap ng mga Dasmariñeño." The City Government of Dasmariñas is really dedicated in investing for the future of its youth. After all, the future belongs to them and it is on their hands that the advancement of the City rests.
