Three technologies from the Department of Science and Technology-Industrial Technology Development Institute (DOST-ITDI) were handed over to the Maranao People Development Center, Inc. (MARADECA, Inc.) for the livelihood and development of the Marawi siege victims on April 10-11, 2019 at the Provincial Capitol, Marawi City.

One of the technologies was the Essential Oil Extractor which extracts essential oils from Citronella Grass and other plant materials that are abundant in Marawi City.

Essential oils are the aroma-giving constituents of aromatic plants. These oils are water-insoluble organic liquids or solids.

The second was the Charcoal Briquetting Equipment which was made up of ITDI Modified Drum Carbonizer, Crusher, Mixer, and Manual Briquettor.

Briquetting is a process of molding or compacting materials such as charcoal fines of biomass or coal, with or without binder under pressure.

The other technology was the Tea Bag Processing Equipment. The participants were trained on herbal processing from the collection of plant materials to Herbal Tea and Herbal Capsule production.

(From page 1) 23% smoking prevalence reported in the September 2018 survey, and close to the 22.7% current tobacco smokers recorded in the 2015 Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS). Looking at the smoking prevalence data from different systematically conducted and nationally representative surveys such as the GATS, National Nutrition Survey, Social Weather Stations, and Pulse Asia Ulat ng Bayan, the data shows that the smoking prevalence has already plateaued at around 23-24%. Moreover, they are floored with artificial grass mats to decrease the risk of play injuries. Also, these parks are lighted with double-arm lampposts. Aside from this, two (2) security guards are on-duty during the park operating hours. The San Lorenzo Ruiz I park opens from 4am to 9am and from 4pm to 10pm every Mondays to Sundays. On the other hand, the Emmanuel Bergado park opens from 5pm to 8pm from Mondays to Sundays. These playgrounds add to the other nine (9) children's parks in the city. Last month, the young constituents of San Lorenzo Ruiz II jubilated when a new children's park was inaugurated in their barangay. Other playgrounds are at Barangay San Simon, Barangay Pali-

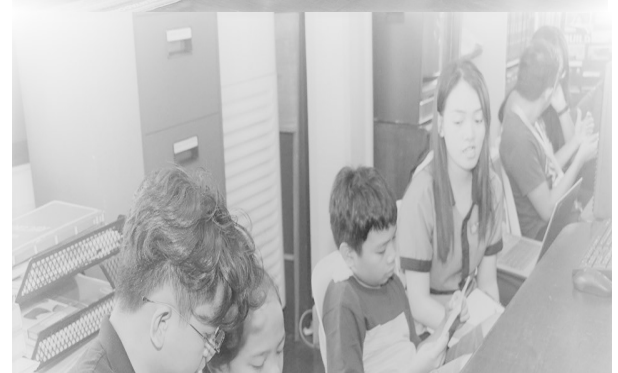

### DILG to LGUs: Don't issue business permit to establishments without STP or septic tank system

To prevent the further degradation of the country's waterways just like what happened to Manila Bay and its tributaries, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) is urging local government units (LGUs) not to issue building permits to establishments unless their design of the hygienic septic tank or wastewater treatment facility conforms with existing environmental laws and policies.

"Let us learn from the lessons of Manila Bay which became a 'gigantic septic tank' and Boracay which was described as 'a virtual cesspool'. Local governments should already put their foot down by not issuing business permits to non-compliant establishments," says DILG Secretary Eduardo

M. Año says. Año also says that "no new business permit should be issued unless business owners have obtained the necessary environmental clearances and permits such as discharge permits and environmental sanitation certificates prescribed by laws or required by the Department of Health, Laguna Lake Development Authority, Department of Health and its instrumentalities." In memorandum circular 2019-62, the DILG Secretary stresses that LGUs should ensure that all residential, private and public establishments in their areas must have proper sewage treatment and septage management system.

"Local governments should compel all residential, commercial, industrial, institutional, and government establishments in their jurisdiction to have their own hygienic septic tanks or wastewater treatment facility," he says. Año also says that LGUs must also see to it that all septic tanks are accessible and that no wastewater shall be discharged to waterways without any proper treatment. For establishments with inaccessible or non-compliant septic tanks, the DILG Chief says they may opt to remodel or restructure it, connect to existing sewer lines of water utilities, or construct communal or shared septic tank. Food establishments discharging wastes are also encouraged to have a working and properly maintained oil and grease trap installed in their respective areas. In the same directive, Año mentions the importance of having regular desludging of septic tanks at least once every five years to be performed only by the water utility or a private desludging company.
