# DUQUE: PHILHEALTH TO FAST-TRACK ANTI-FRAUD IT REFORMS

## City Government of Imus

Department of Health Secretary and ex-officio Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) Board Chairman Francisco T. Duque III pledged Tuesday to fast-track the completion of the corporation's ongoing information technology (IT) reforms to safeguard against fraudulent claims and other forms of cybercrime.

"Information technology reforms are critical in our fight to crack down on fraudulent claims and to ensure that Philhealth data is kept secure. Philhealth is committed to shoring up its IT capabilities as we prepare to implement the Duterte administration's Universal Health Care program as efficiently and transparently as possible," Duque said.

A 2018 report submitted by the Information Technology Audit Office of the Commission on Audit outlined several recommendations to improve Philhealth's IT systems, including the alignment of existing IT systems to Philhealth's Enterprise Architecture and implementation of an information security management system (ISMS). Duque said that while Philhealth has already been working on implementing the recommended reforms, the impending implementation of the Duterte administration's P257 billion Universal Health Care (UHC) program brings with it a greater sense of urgency to complete the reforms as soon as possible.

"Philhealth is the lynchpin that ties together the vision of universal access to health care for all Filipinos. We will do everything in our power to ensure that Philhealth is ready to play its pivotal role in bringing President Duterte's signature Universal Health Care program to life," Duque said.

(From page 4) The Education Secretary also mentioned the teachers who won global awards in recognition of their teaching innovations. This, she added, "is what we want our learners to absorb to be able to innovate and be relevant to the changing time."

Teaching and innovation Pointing out that the quality of learners is largely shaped by the quality of teachers, Briones — a teacher and a Sillimanian herself — underscored the crucial role of teachers as guides, managers, and listeners, among many others.

"We are interested in the teachers, in the curriculum that produce the teachers who teach our learners. The challenge to all of us, especially our teachers, is to change the way we teach our learners to continually adapt to global trends such as FIRE and the rise of AI," she shared.

"Reprieving our humanity" The Secretary of Education further argued that even with FIRE and AI on the rise, "we have to reprieve our humanity." She likewise emphasized the need to train people in jobs and skills that only humans possess. "Social caring — that can only happen from human teachers," Briones cited as an example.

IRR and the Uniform

"Hopefully, the joint
committee will be able to
make the necessary adjust-
ments to the IRR, if need-
ed, so that we do not have
to go to Congress or to the
Judiciary," he said.

He said that the joint
review must be done to de-
termine if there are incon-
sistencies between the law
and the IRR and the 10-
day suspension will give
the joint DILG and DOJ
team ample time to revis-
it its provisions and make
the necessary adjustments
in the IRR or recommend
amendments to Congress,
if necessary.

The Joint Committee
will submit its report and
draft revised IRR, uniform
policy and guidelines on
the computation of time
credits and allowances un-
der RA No. 10592 to the
Secretary of Justice and
Secretary of the Interior
and Local Government
within 10 working days
from the issuance of the
Order.

The Joint Committee
will be chaired by the DOJ
and co-chaired by DILG.
The Bureau of Corrections
is under the DOJ while the
Bureau of Jail Manage-
ment and Penology which
runs all district and city
jails is under the DILG.
