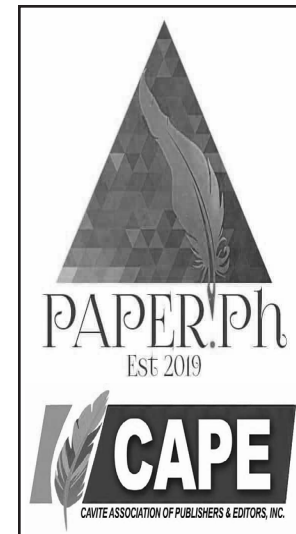

DILG files charges against 2 more mayors for failing road clearing directive

(From page 4) the corresponding answers by the mayors,” he vowed. President Duterte, in his last State of the Nation Address, ordered the DILG to take the lead in the road clearing operations and suspend non-compliant LCEs. Heeding the Presidential directive, the DILG released Memorandum Circular 2019-121 ordering LCEs to use all their powers under the law to reclaim public roads being used for private ends.

Año urged the Ombudsman to immediately act on the cases filed by the DILG to prove to the public that government means the business when it ordered the clearing of all roads for the use of motorists and pedestrians.

“More cases will be filed as soon as our lawyers have finished reviewing the validation reports and

barangay captains in keeping their roads obstruction-free. Kaya kailangang kumilos at magsipag na rin ang ating mga barangay,” he said.

Road Clearing 2.0, which commenced on February 17, 2020 mandates the Punong Barangays to also be at the helm of clearing local and barangay roads and minor public-use streets within their area of jurisdiction including the maintenance of other local roads turned over by the city or municipal government.

Road obstructions such as vehicles parked in prohibited places specified in RA 4136 or the Land Transportation and Traffic Code, or in sidewalks, paths, or alleys; vehicular terminals except in areas allowed by the LGU; vending sites of any kind of items; house encroachments that obstruct the road right-of-way, protruding gates, tents, among others; and store encroach-

ments and indiscriminate clearings by the barangay, he added. He likewise explained that obstructing trees may be pruned or removed in coordination with the local office of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources while posts, meters, instrumentation boxes and the like that causes road obstruction must be coordinated to the utility company and the LGU for possible relocation. (From page 4) Organization (WHO) reported that the COVID-19 has spread in 37 countries outside of China, but has observed a decline in the number of additional cases globally.

WHO Director-General Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus particularly noted that nine countries, including the Philippines, reported no new cases of COVID-19 for more than two weeks.

“While the DOH welcomes this positive development, we cannot be complacent. We must remain steadfast in watching out for the health of the Filipino people, particularly our repatriates in NCC,” Duque concluded. Source: doh.gov.ph

(From page 1) information that there are two more repatriates who were brought to a referral health facility because of sore throat. Their specimens were collected and sent for testing at the Research Institute for Tropical Medicine.

“While we are still waiting for the other test results, we assure the public that our referral hospitals are well-equipped and prepared to handle COVID-19 cases once they arise. Our health response team at the quarantine facility is being extra cautious to prevent further health risks,” Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque explained.

Updates on PUIs DOH reported that as of 12:00 NN, there are now only 30 patients under investigation (PUIs) admitted in various health facilities. A total of 585 patients have already been discharged. To date, 531 PUIs have tested negative for the 2019 novel coronavirus, and 40 cases with pending test results.

“We are observing a steady decrease in the number of PUIs admitted in our health facilities and DOH is bent on sustaining this downward trend. While there is a looming prospect of positive COVID-19 cases among our repatriated kababayans, we call on everyone to continue to be vigilant partners of DOH in keeping the threat of COVID-19 at bay,” Duque said.

Global Situation DOH also reported that as of February 27, there are a total of 85 confirmed COVID-19 cases (Turn to page 5)

**DILG files charges against 2 more mayors for failing road clearing directive**

Two more municipal mayors are facing administrative charges for violating President Rodrigo Duterte’s order to clear roads of illegal obstructions and return the use of major roads and highways to the public, according to the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG).

“We meant it when we said that cases will be filed against negligent local execs. Unless local chief executives get their acts together and take the President’s instructions to clear roads seriously, they will be held accountable and face charges,” said DILG Secretary Sec. Eduardo M. Año.

Año said that this is the second batch of cases filed before the Office of the Ombudsman after the two local chief executives (LCEs) failed to satisfactorily respond to the show cause orders issued by the Department and were among those who obtained the lowest scores in the validation and assessment conducted by the Department.

He identified the mayors of Boliney in Abra and Motiong in Samar as the 2 local chief executives who are now facing administrative cases for gross neglect of duty and grave misconduct were filed with the Office of the Ombudsman in January against the municipal mayors of Baco, Oriental Mindoro; Pili, Camarines Sur; Ginatilan, Cebu; Pagsanghan, Samar; Aurora and Lapuyan, Zamboanga Del Sur; Sagay and Guinsiliban, Camiguin; Manticao, Misamis Oriental; and Caraga, Davao Oriental.

The DILG Chief said all local government units

On the other hand, the validating team found out that the municipality of Boliney failed to present an inventory of the provincial, municipal and barangay roads in their area. An identified provincial road was also found with extended canopies as obstructions.

Both LGUs also failed to come up with any rehabilitation and sustainability plans nor set up a grievance and feedback mechanism on clearing of road obstructions.

“The Municipalities of Motiong and Boliney obtained a total score of not more than 50 points in the indicators set by the DILG. Such score translated to their glaring failure to follow the rule of law that public streets are for public use,” said Año.

In October last year, the DILG issued show cause orders to 97 LGUs across the country demanding their explanation for their non-compliance with the DILG’s directive based on the assessment and validation conducted by the Department.

After the validation, the first batch of administrative cases for gross neglect of duty and grave misconduct were filed with the Office of the Ombudsman in January against the municipal mayors of Baco, Oriental Mindoro; Pili, Camarines Sur; Ginatilan, Cebu; Pagsanghan, Samar; Aurora and Lapuyan, Zamboanga Del Sur; Sagay and Guinsiliban, Camiguin; Manticao, Misamis Oriental; and Caraga, Davao Oriental.
