EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 38-SERIES 2020

AN ORDER PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF LICENSED COCKPITS AND THE CONDUCT OF COCKFIGHTING ACTIVITIES IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE PENDING THE ISSUANCE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF THE RELEVANT GUIDELINES FOR THE SAME

This is without prejudice to such other restrictions as the Province may impose.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.

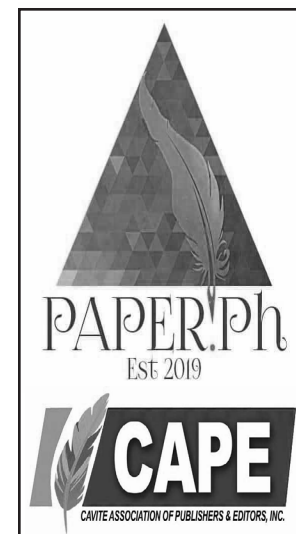

Global handwashing day 2020 celebrates by DepEd, DOH, UNICEF

(From page 1) in the public's health behavior.

"We have participated in the global partnership led by the WHO [and UNICEF] which is a call to action for all of [the] society to achieve universal access to hand hygiene to combat COVID-19, and to prevent a whole range of other diseases," Education Secretary Leonor Magtolis Briones said in a recorded message.

Secretary Briones added that DepEd continues to mobilize resources in creating, maintaining, and sustaining a culture of hand hygiene in schools and offices through the

Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) program.

The Education chief also pointed out that handwashing has been integrated into the Department's Basic Education-Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP), which was developed to ensure the health and safety of learners, teachers, and personnel while ensuring the access to learning opportunities.

Meanwhile, DepEd School Health Division (SHD) chief Dr. Maria Corazon Dumlao emphasized that the hygiene change in an institutional setting needs an enabling environment that mobilizes a systems approach to hygiene promotion. "[The] key to sustaining the handwashing initiatives and creating a culture of handwashing is establishing the expectation to practice hand hygiene in all settings," she said. According to Dr. Dumlao, there is an urgent need for standards, evidence, data, inclusive and participatory implementation strategy, tools and techniques, performance measurement, and an incentive mechanism. DOH Secretary Francisco Duque III, meanwhile, emphasized that hand hygiene should not only be a per-

Mandated under Re-
public Act 11055 enacted
in 2018, the National ID
program aims to replace
over 46 different govern-
ment IDs and provide con-
venience to the transacting
public. Over time, the gov-
ernment sees the National
ID as a tool to open bank
accounts and to digitally

transact as a cashless pay-
ment system.

For the government,
the ID and the information
it holds can cut bureaucrat-
ic red tape encountered on
programs like cash transac-
tions where the goal is to
make it easier to track and
distribute aid to beneficia-
ries.

Malaya said that
while 119 LGUs have
signed the MOA, another
216 have completed coor-
dination with the PSA and
are set to sign the MOAs
this week in compliance
with a DILG Memorandum
on the Philippine Identifi-
cation System (PhilSys).

"It's imperative to
have the backing of LGUs
to provide the necessary
preparations and adherence
to the minimum health
protocols as teams from
the PSA conduct their data
collection from the identi-
fied low-income household
heads within their respec-
tive jurisdictions," he said.

Under MOAs with
the PSA, the LGUs are

expected to coordinate mu-
nicipal and barangay-level
meetings for briefings and
discussions on PhilSys op-
erations, identify locations
for the registration centers,
waiting areas, and tempo-
rary storage facilities,
among others.

LGUs are also re-
sponsible for mobilizing
all required resources for
the pre-registration and
registration activities such
as registration area, electri-
cal supply, storage areas of
the registration kits, phys-
ical security, and crowd
control, if necessary.

LGUs will also pro-
vide logistical support to
the registration process

such as lending of back-up
vehicles, as well as issu-
ance of a clearance/certifi-
cation to PhilSys registra-
tion teams to allow them
access to all barangays.

DILG Secretary
Eduardo M. Año has di-
rected concerned PNP unit
commanders and Chiefs of
Police to coordinate with
the PSA and the priority
LGUs to facilitate and se-
cure the safe conduct of the
pre-registration.

"The PNP has been
directed to ensure the safe-
ty of both the PSA person-
nel and the residents they
would interview amidst
the continuing threat of
COVID-19 and to ensure
that minimum health stan-
dards are complied with,"
said Malaya.
