

# 911 Emergency Hotline now ready to serve - DILG

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) announced today that the Philippine Emergency Hotline 911 has resumed full operation after a hiatus after several of its Emergency Telecommunicators were infected with COVID-19.

DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año thanked the public for their kind understanding of the problems faced by the Emergency 911 Hotline. National Call Centers when five emergency telecommunicators (ETCs) tested positive for COVID-19. 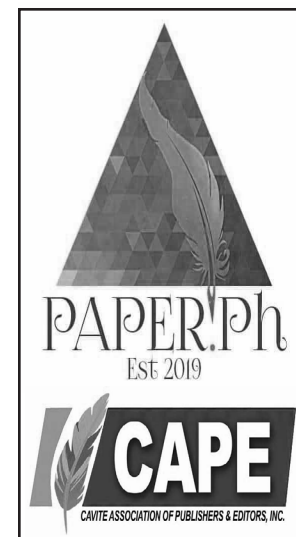

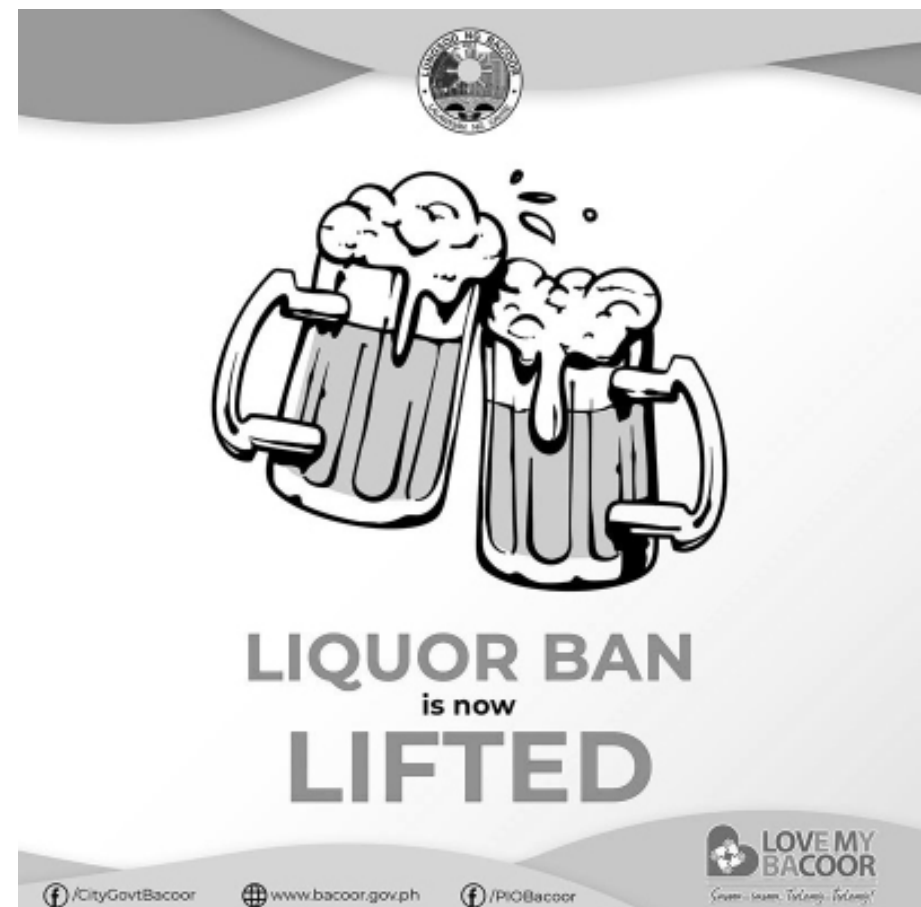

Un fortunately, Mars also contracted the virus--but found herself reaping the seeds of kindness she has sown in the community and made her realize that the bayanihan culture among Filipinos, even in a dire situation, is still truly alive.

Mars experienced symptoms early in July. When she had intense body pains, headaches, low fever, and a weak sense of taste, her family sought help from the local government unit (LGU) who advised her to get a swab test. Mars and her family took it upon themselves to begin isolation and intensify infection control protocol at home. They made sure that there are alcohol dispensers in different locations in their house. Aside from regular hand washing, they wore masks even at home.

causing further delay in the resumption of the regular operations.

E911 Executive Director Diosdado Valeroso said that the National Call Center had to be disinfected twice after the infection of some BFP telecommunicators.

He added that the 5 ETCs were all asymptomatic and have fully recovered after their 14-day quarantine while the BFP personnel are also back to work.

To keep the E911 operations going, he revealed that a Work from Home team dubbed as Team Mabini was formed and activated during the said period.

"We have currently four teams: Team Lapulapu, Team Rizal, Team Bonifacio, and Team Tandang Sora with 18 ETCs each who work round the clock on a 24-hour work shift due to transportation issues," Valeroso said.

He earlier said that in 2019 alone, E911 calls swelled from 18.482 million in 2016, a figure which even ballooned further since March this year with the DILG- Department of Health (DOH) partnership on COVID-related calls.

Some 20 ETCs from the DOH are now co-located at the DILG E911 Na-

tional Call Center with the Department's ETCs and the DILG ETCs handling the emergency calls.

Valeroso cited that the Department's ETCs also serve as an augmentation team with that of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council during calamities and disasters like typhoons.

"We get some positive remarks or comments mainly through the social media and of course from our friends who are also aware of what we at the DILG-911 are doing," the 911 executive director said. -DILG

Singh-Vergeire, the public er side helped in strengthening her immune system.

(From page 2) out to be negative. conditions for home quarantine. Mars herself was confined in the hospital, while two of her brothers had to stay in the LGU's quarantine facility while waiting for the results which fortunately turned

turn to their home. A friend with an extra room in their house took her in for the 14-day isolation period. According to Mars, there is no discrimination in their community, only helpful hands and kindness. When the news broke

that she and three members of their family were COVID-19 positive, there was an outpouring of people who offered them help--even distant relatives and acquaintances she rarely spoke out with reached out to see how they could assist them. There was never a chance for stigma and discrimination to thrive. Mars also recounted how even her fellow COVID-19 patients in the facility would support each other towards recovery. She witnessed in the elementary-school-turned-isolation-facility, that despite having individual battles with the novel sickness, the patients would still find the chance to offer each other food supplies or medicine, and check up on each other's condition.

"Kami-kami rin po yung nagpapalakas ng loob ng isa't isa," Mars recounted. "Mine-make sure namin na nandun kami para sa isa't isa." Witnessing bayanihan culture, alongside the jolly disposition of her family and the frontliners who took care of them, greatly helped Mars battle the mental turmoil brought about by the illness. Being a cup-half-full kind of person, Mars attested that always finding the silver lining in any situation contributed to her physiological recovery.

"Importante po na hindi kayo panghinaan ng loob," Mars said as she explained how staying optimistic also helped in her healing. The COVID-19 survivor also added that how she and her family chose to look at the bright-
