Aside from the preliminary treatment and storage facility, the solid waste management program budget for 2022 will include support for the establishment of trash traps, collection and disposal services for garbage patches, provision of solid waste management equipment such shredders, composters, and plastic recycling equipment for LGUs nationwide, and hauling services for solid waste collected in Boracay.

In April 2020, the DENR-led National Solid Waste Management Commission issued Resolution 1364 entitled "Adopting the Interim Guidelines on the Management of COVID-19 Related Health Care Waste" directing LGUs to develop a COVID-19 waste management plan that will adopt the guidelines on segregation and storage at source, collection and transport. and treatment and disposal.
