To synchronize “ORAS PINAS” in compliance to the Philippine Standard Time (PST). Previously dubbed as “Juan Time”, the ORAS PINAS (DOST) unveiled the new campaign aims to promote the PST nationwide and ‘sync’ timepieces with the PST, the new Filipino Time.

Every year, the DOST leads in the observance of the National Time Consciousness Week (NTCW) pursuant to Republic Act No. 10535 or The Philippine Standard Time (PST) Act of 2013.

The NTCW is being observed during the first week of January of every year to promote the value of time and the need to respect the time of others, so that the people may realize the imperative of synchronizing the official time.

With the theme “Synchronizing Filipino Time with ORAS PINAS”, the NTCW 2021 further aims to introduce ORAS PINAS as the new brand of the PST with the tagline, “One Nation, One Time: Pilipinas ON TIME”. Through the new brand, the campaign hopes to institutionalize the new Filipino culture of being always on time and having only one time as a nation.

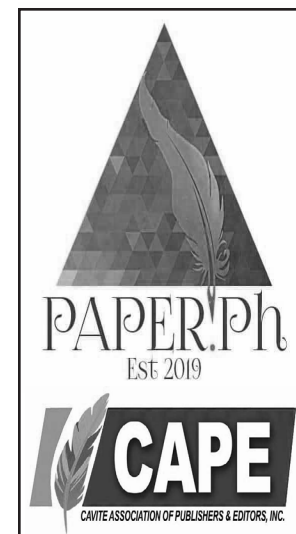

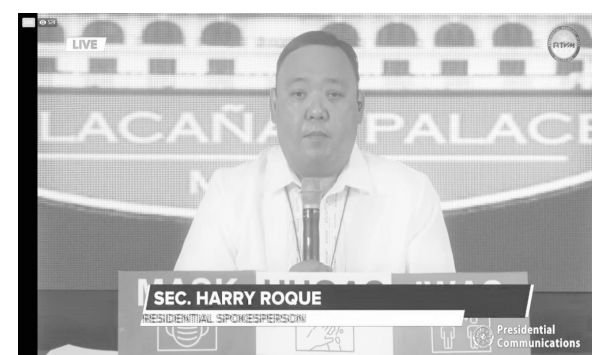

remarks that LGUs can choose their own vaccine as long as it passes through the screening of the national government as stated in the law.

In the same press briefing, Dr. Edsel Salvana, Director of the Institute of Molecular Biology and Biotechnology of the University of the Philippines – National Institutes of Health, explained that the World Health Organization has set the minimum efficacy for emergency use of vaccines at 50 percent.

Dr. Salvana, who is also a member of the Department of Health Technical Advisory Group, stressed that this does not mean that a vaccine is ineffective and will not be useful in preventing the severe form of disease.

Also in the same venue, Sec. Roque attended the “A Dose of Hope” Ceremonial Signing Wave 2 event, where the private sector and the LGUs have joined hands with the national government in a show of unity to fight COVID-19 through vaccine procurement.

# DILG submits more than .5 million signatures, LGU resolutions in support of lifting the restrictive economic provisions

(From page 2) Executive Director of the Inter-Agency Task Force on Constitutional Reform, said that the signatures were culled from off-line and on-line signature campaigns spearheaded by the DILG, CORE (Constitutional Reform) Movement, along with various civil society groups, private groups, and individuals.

“Those (physical) signatures were gathered during our provincial roadshows which started in 2019 up to 2020 before the pandemic hit and now online signature campaign where we brought people in an online platform,” 1,488-member strong League of Municipalities of the Philippines, and the 23 LGU resolutions from Regions VI, X, XI, and
