

Vaccine confidence advocated by DOH and Philippine Nurses Association

The Department of Health (DOH), together with the Philippine Information Agency, today held a town hall meeting with the Philippine Nurses Association (PNA) to advocate vaccination, and increase vaccine confidence as the government prepares for COVID-19 vaccination program roll out in February.

Recognizing nurses as important partners in the COVID-19 immunization program, the meeting shed light on the vaccine selection process and the national vaccination deployment plan. It also addressed issues on vaccine acceptance and its primary barriers, and how healthcare workers can lend a hand in effective risk communication and demand generation for vaccines.

During the town hall, health social scientist

Prof. Nina Castillo-Carandang of the University of the Philippines Manila College of Medicine addressed issues on vaccine hesitancy and the crucial role that health workers play in increasing vaccine confidence. On the other hand, Dr. Marion Kwek of the Philippine Society for Microbiology and Infectious Diseases also discussed the current vaccines on the pipeline. Also present were DOH Undersecretary Myrna Cabotaje, Food and Drug Administration Dir. Gen. Eric Domingo, Department of Science and Technology (DOST) - Vaccine Expert Panel Head Dr. Nina Gloriani, and DOST Philippine Council for Health Research and Development Executive Dir. Jaime Montoya who provided a technical overview of the vaccine selection from clinical

trial and emergency use authorization applications to deployment. Aside from the presentations, the DOH and the members of the town hall panel also called for support to help dismiss misinformation and disinformation against COVID-19 vaccines. "Lahat kami sa DOH at sa buong Vaccine Cluster ay nananawagan sa lahat ng naririto na mag-ing kampeon para sa ating mga bakuna. Nakasalalay sa tagumpay ng bakuna ng COVID-19 ang tiwala ng ating mamamayan sa halaga ng bakuna bilang instrumento ng pagpapantili ng magandang antas ng pampublikong kalusugan," Health Secretary Francisco T. Duque III said as he rallied support from the members of PNA.

Meanwhile, Vaccine Czar Carlito Galvez Jr. pointed out that there are too many noises surrounding vaccines and assured that the country will only procure proven safe and efficacious vaccines and that the procurement process will be corruption-free, saying "Kaya ang Philippine Nurses Association ay hinihikayat po namin na tulungan po kami para i-bring forth ang level of confidence ng public uptake on our nationwide vaccination. Please help us by being our champions in your household and in your community." The vaccine czar further assured that frontliners will be prioritized in the immunization program and that they will only receive vaccines that passed the scientific evaluation and regulatory processes.

Part of the objective of the meeting is to also provide a venue for the

participants to raise concerns and seek clarifications on the government's immunization plan. "It is important that healthcare workers will have a full understanding of COVID-19. It is important to have the necessary information of these vaccines for our healthcare workers to help them help our citizens." (Turn to page 5)

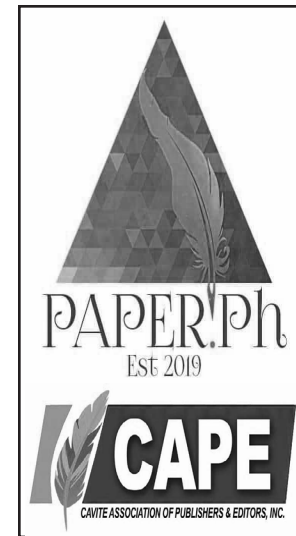

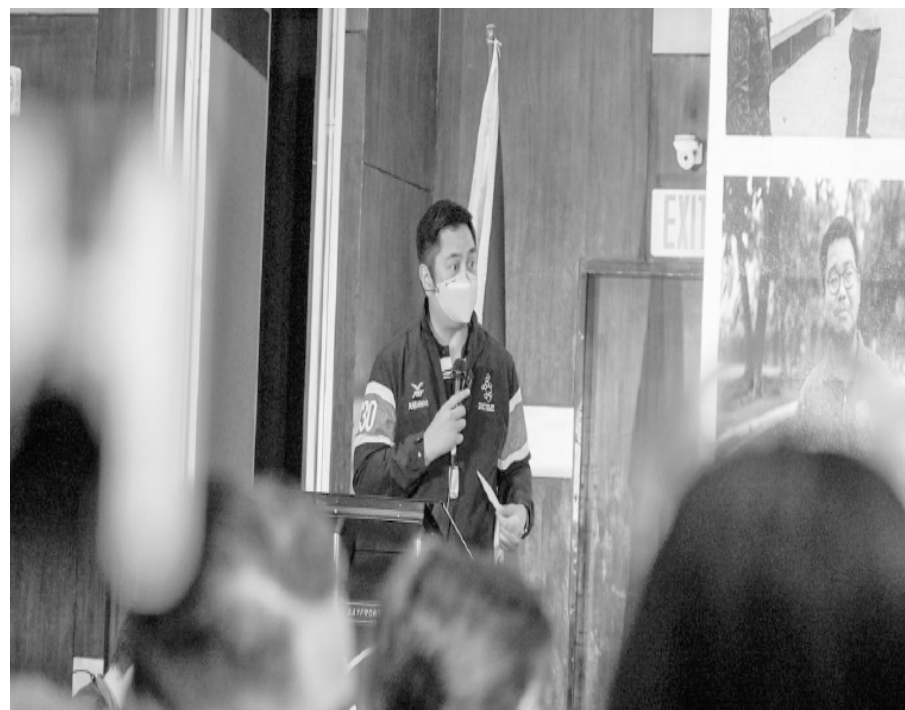

Secretary Martin Andanar joined the Explain, Explain, Explain town hall meeting with the local government units of Cebu City and Mandaue City on Tuesday, January 19, 2021, which aimed at informing the Filipino people about the government's COVID-19 immunization program.

(From page 1) munications arm of the government, the PCOO continues to operate its Laging Handa Information and Communications Campaign to assure the public that the Duterte administration is on top of the COVID-19 situation in the country," he said.

"This includes our strides to disseminate and reiterate the need to observe health protocols and precautionary measures, to dispel false information, and to advocate for preparedness and vigilance and harnessing solidarity through participatory governance," he added.

The PCOO Chief assured that the vaccine roadmap of the country is taking careful execution of the stages that the National Task Force against COVID-19 has outlined, to ensure that the allocat-

ed budget will not go to waste.

"The road ahead of the COVID-19 roadmap will not be easy. As we have seen in reports from other countries, difficulties will always be present.

There were shortcomings in policies implemented and we should learn from these," he said, as he cited some countries that have struggled to manage the implementation of their own vaccine program.

He stressed that the government cannot afford to be greatly blindsided when there are already real lessons to learn from other countries.

"All of us here are part of the government that will solve this problem and the COVID-19 vaccine is our hope. But if we cannot manage it well, it can also be our pitfall," he said.

"For example, legis-

tically the US is having a problem. Some of its states do not have the right facilities to store their vaccines.

If you cannot store the vaccines properly, then there's spoilage.

Now, we cannot afford to spoil the vaccines because it will cost a lot of money," he added.

He also bared that the metropolitan areas of Manila, Cebu, and Davao will be among the first to receive the vaccines, since they are identified as COVID-19 high-risk areas.

The series of engagements that the PCOO will be undertaking together with its attached agencies is founded on saving lives, reviving hope, and shaping the future.

There will also be separate town hall meetings in Siquijor and Dumaguete this week.

DILG re-hires total of 15,000 COVID-19 contact tracers

(From page 1) nationwide for at least six months, following the approval by the Department of Budget and Management of a total of P1.9-billion for the hiring of CTs in 2021.

"While the country's COVID-19 response is significantly improving, we should sustain our contact tracing efforts especially

the reported entry of the new UK variant into the country. Hence, we are pleased that we have been given the funds to re-hire some 15,000 CTs this year who will continue to help us track down, monitor coronavirus cases, and cut transmission in the community," said DILG Undersecretary and Spokesperson Jonathan Malaya.

Malaya said that the available budget allotted to the Department. Hence, only 15,000 CTs will be re-hired under a six-month contract in the meantime while we wait for the release of additional funds," he said.

"Much as we would like to continue the services of all the 50,000 CTs hired in 2020, we need to have a more rational number of CTs and work within

Bayanihan to Recover as One Act. This will supplement the P500-million that has been allocated for the hiring of CTs in the 2021 General Appropriations Act.

"Therefore, DILG field offices and the LGUs are directed to conduct an immediate assessment of the performance of the contact tracers and proceed with the selection of those who have effectively and efficiently performed their assigned tasks," said Malaya.

In a memorandum signed by DILG Officer-in-Charge Bernardo Florece, Jr., DILG regional directors were asked to advise all DILG-hired contact tracers in their respective regions to wind up their activities, process their clearances and return their identification cards to their respective local government unit (LGU) of deployment following the termination of contracts last December 31, 2020.

Florece also asked the Regional Offices to prioritize the re-hiring of contact tracers in the LGUs who have active cases and have rising active cases. More CTs to be re-hired in NCR, Regions III, VII

Malaya said that the National Capital Region (2,381), Region III (1,504) and Region VII (1,417) top the list of regions which will rehire the most number of CTs this year based on the prorated quota for 2021 hiring of contact tracers.

The quota is based on the number of active cases in a particular region.

He added that the Department also plans to rehire 1,264 CTs in CALABARZON; 1,052 in Region IX; 974 in Region VI; 813 in Region XI; 856 in Region V; 634 in Region X, 510 CTs in BARMM; and 501 CTs in Region I.

Another 451 CTs will be hired in MIMAROPA; 433 in Region VIII; 352 in Region II; and 267 Cordillera Administrative Region.

Malaya, however, said that the rehiring of 15,000 CTs will only be effective only upon the availability of funds or receipt of the SARO/NCA for the purpose from the DBM. Source DILG
