## VOLCANOPH APP TO RAISE PUBLIC AWARENESS ON VOLCANO HAZARDS FOR BETTER PREPAREDNESS

VolcanoPh app provides Android users with important real-time volcano alerts and notifications.

Last year, Taal volcano literally started the year with a bang. It resulted in the suspension of school classes and work and suspended local flights in the area above as the Department of Science and Technology - Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (DOST-PHIVOLCS) issued Alert Level 4 on the afternoon of 12 January 2020. The scenario indicated "possible hazardous explosive eruption within hours to days."

After 42 years of silence, Taal volcano showed renewed activities that fateful day, spewing ash that affected residents and tourists in Batangas, Cavite, Laguna and even in Metro Manila and other neighboring cities.

Fortunately, the recent disaster has prompted scientists from DOST-PHIVOLCS to develop VolcanoPH, a volcano advisory application that will help the public understand better similar geohazard warnings in the future so



they can be better prepared. This innovation is a real-time volcano advisory application, initially for Android devices, that provides infographic information on the latest updates of Philippine active volcanoes monitored by DOST-PHIVOLCS.

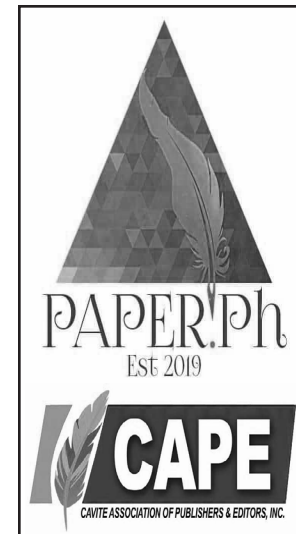
The alerts and information are written both in English and Filipino languages and infographs for ease of use.

This app will help users understand the pres-

ent volcano status along with its alert level warnings through the 24-hour real-time observation data gathered from the Volcano Monitoring Network records and actual field survey data analyzed by experts from DOST-PHIVOLCS.

The push notification feature will inform the users of the latest volcano advisory before the updates are posted on social media platforms. "The system will enable the user to see the updates first on the app after we have posted it to the DOST-PHIVOLCS website and have disseminated the

App users can also select and click from a list of active volcanoes with alert levels on its homepage and be provided with the 24-hour summary containing its alert level warning status, monitoring parameters, and recommendations in Filipino language. (Turn to page 5)

The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) on Wednesday reported that out of 8.4 million doses of COVID-19 vaccines administered, as of June 20, only 0.6% reported reactions and no hospitalization and deaths due to COVID 19 were observed after more than 14 days of getting the second dose.

# Internet services in PH to improve with economic reforms

Opening the economy to foreign investments through constitutional reforms would yield better internet services, improve investment schemes in telecommunications, and enable the transfer of technology and management skills to Filipinos.

Benjamin Azada, chief strategy officer of Converge ICT Solutions Inc. said that opening the country's telecommunications sector would further give access to advance technology and create more competition on digital infrastructures.

"Opening up to foreign direct investments (FDI) will unlock the digital infrastructure in the Philippines as well as upgrade technical and management skills of Filipinos and bring in training and

technology transfer especially in businesses," Azada said during an online forum on the importance of constitutional reforms in the economy to boost telecommunications sponsored by the Department of the Interior and Local Government.

Azada is the chief strategy officer of Converge ICT Solutions, Inc., a telecommunication service provider in the Philippines that operates fiber-optic broadband networks, cable television (marketed as Air

Cable), and cable internet (marketed as Air Internet) in the country with 1.18 million FiberX subscribers as of March 2021.

According to Azada, economic liberalization would enhance export growth and increase em-

ployment essential to the country's rapid economic

growth and competitive- ness. In his presentation, Azada showed the FDI regulatory restrictive index which measures statutory restrictions on FDI across 22 economic sectors in the year 2019.

Azada said ASEAN data level per sector showed the Philippines

has the most restrictive and the most number of sectors identified by the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD). "Such entrenched barriers to FDI prevent us from realizing higher economic growth, more competition, hinders (Turn to page 4)

# Batch application of PNPKI proposed by DepEd

The PNPKI digital signature is a new requirement of the Commission of Elections (COMELEC) for all public school teachers who will serve as Electoral Board Members.

It is a virtual 'key' that subscribers use to secure files sent over an otherwise unsecured 'public' network like the Internet. In a letter from DepEd to the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), the Department requested to streamline the applica-

tion process by waiving the requirement for individual application forms, including physically filling out the forms.

In previous discussions with the DICT, the requirements for individual interviews and supporting IDs have been waived. However, DepEd is further requesting the waiving of the requirement for individual application forms as this may be cumbersome to check individually for errors.

This rigorous process for teachers will entail the downloading of these forms, physically filling them out, and uploading the same where-in checking for accuracy

is an altogether different tedious task.

This proposal will guarantee that our teachers will not be burdened by rigorous steps and requirements anymore," Undersecretary for Administration Alain Del B. Pascua pointed out in the letter.

DepEd also proposed the use of available secure and reliable technologies and the submission of documents for bulk processing in place of the PNPKI application forms.

Documents proposed to be submitted to DICT include a spreadsheet file containing DepEd employees' verified data certified by Human Resources, and an institutional application from DepEd in place of in-

tries that vaccines prevent hospitalization and deaths. Health experts locally and abroad have reiterated the importance of getting vaccinated as an additional layer of protection against COVID-19.

Additionally, FDA reported that common reactions after vaccination included increased blood pressure, pain in the injection site, headache, fever, dizziness, rashes, and respiratory symptoms. Moreover, no local events of blood clotting and myo-

carditis were reported. "To date, the evidence gathered from all causality assessments has concluded that all serious reactions reported were unrelated to the COVID-19 vaccine. We reiterate that vaccines with emergency use authorization are safe and effective against COVID-19 and the benefits of using them outweigh the risks," said Director General Eric Domingo.

Further, the DOH and FDA emphasized the importance of completing the required two (2) doses, as maximum protection sets in two (2) weeks after getting the second dose. (From page 1) technology transfer, generation, and of course, consumer choice," he said. He said Converge supports measures that will boost the competitiveness and unlock the full potentials of the telecommunications industry, including the fixed broadband market.

Meanwhile, Iloilo Rep. Lorenz Defensor, the vice-chairperson of the House Committee on Constitutional Amendments, said the House has transmitted RBH2 to the Senate on June 2 for its consideration.

"Given the bicameral nature of our congress, we have to respect that the Senate also has the obligation to act on the proposed amendments before it can be submitted to the Filipinos by way of a plebiscite," Defensor said.

For his part, Gary

Olivar, a resource person of the CORE Movement and director of the Center for Strategy, Enterprise, and Intelligence (CenSEI), said he was optimistic that RBH2 would be discussed and passed by the Senators in no time.

"We have no option to fail. I tend to be more optimistic that we can gather and lobby votes from the Senate especially with the help of our Congressmen," Olivar said.

The DILG webinar sessions with partners support the Resolution of Both Houses No. 2 (RBH 2), authored by Speaker Lord Allan Velasco, which was approved on the third and final reading on June 1. The resolution is now pending in the Senate for approval.

The measure seeks to include the phrase "unless otherwise provided by law" to empower Congress

to pass laws lifting current educational institutions, restrictions on foreign investments of public utilities, media, and advertising companies. Source: DILG

# Violence and Injury prevention campaign launched by DOH and Consuelo Foundation

ties and at-risk individuals on the ground, and empowering and capacitating community members," added Atty. Andal-Castro.
