

DILG: 91% or P21.06-billion ayuda distributed to NCR Plus beneficiaries

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) today said that the Ayuda distribution has reached 91 percent or P21.06-billion given to low-income earners in the National Capital Region (NCR) Plus area by May 15, the deadline set the national government. Moreover, 37 local government units (LGUs) reached 100 percent completion rate.

DILG Secretary Eduardo M. Año said that amid all the challenges, LGUs delivered their end of the bargain on the distribution of ayuda to mil-

ions of beneficiaries with most registering 90 percent completion rate as of May 15.

He said that the 91 percent distribution rate is a testament to the LGUs commitment to extend the most help they can give to their constituents.

“Alam ninyo po isang malaking hamon po talaga itong pamamahagi ng ayuda sa panahon ng pandemia at nakakatuwa na we saw the commitment of the LGUs. And now billions of pesos of financial assistance have reached our kababayans.

The 91 percent or P21.06 billion ayuda distributed to qualified beneficiaries is a victory for the LGUs and the national government,” Año said.

He explained that the remaining 9% represents the unclaimed Ayuda and they have granted the LGUs with unclaimed funds the authority to prepare a new payroll and distribute these to other affected individuals in their respective communities within 10 days.

“Despite diligent efforts by the LGUs, some of the beneficiaries did not

claim their Ayuda because they have moved to the provinces or are no longer residing in their LGUs. Many of them were also delisted because they were found to be duplicates in the Social Amelioration Program list.

The LGUs have started to prepare a new payroll in order to distribute these unclaimed funds,” he said.

On May 15, Año said that Bulacan tallied the highest completion rate of 96.85 percent corresponding to P2.87-billion worth of financial assistance with

12 LGUs namely Balagtas; Baliwag; Bocaue; Calumpit; Doña Remedios Trinidad; Guiguinto; Norzagaray; Pandi; Paombong; Plaridel; San Miguel; and, San Rafael finishing their ayuda distribution.

Laguna tallied 19 LGUs which have completed ayuda dissemination, the most among the whole NCR Plus bubble while garnering a high completion rate of 96.50 percent corresponding to P2.62-billion worth of financial aid distributed.

Among the LGUs which have completed distribution of ayuda in Laguna are: City of Biñan; City of Cabuyao; City of San Pedro; City of Santa Rosa; Alaminos; Calauan; Famy; Kalayaan; Lumbac; Mabitac; Magdalena; Nagcarlan; Paete; Pagsanjan; DILG

Pakil; Pila; Rizal; City of Santa Cruz; and, Siniloan.

Meanwhile, Rizal followed with 93.34 percent; NCR with 90.99 percent; and Cavite with 86.04 percent with five LGUs including City of Tagaytay; Amadeo; Mendez; Naic; and, Noveleta completing the ayuda distribution.

NCR tallies 90.99 percent

DILG Undersecretary and Spokesperson Jonathan E. Malaya said that Metro Manila LGUs have tallied 90.99 percent completion rate amounting to P10.17-billion worth of ayuda distributed to qualified families within the region. “We commend Metro Manila LGUs for stepping up and committing their resources for the effective distribution of ayuda,” he said. Six (6) airport scenario settings are installed in the simulator program, that can be used for air

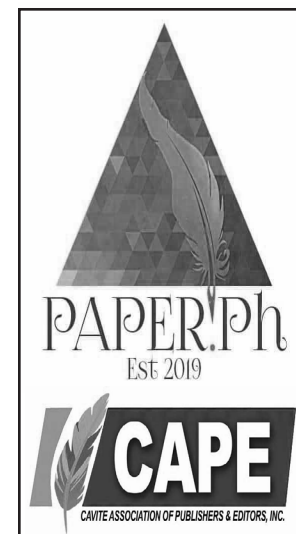

cy in the airport domain of Manila, Clark, Mactan, Plaridel, Davao, as well as a generic single runway airport.

With the state-of-the-art simulator, control tower environment is artificially recreated for air traffic controller training, design and other purposes. It also helps to eliminate primary training methods applied in the aerodrome laboratory training module of the Civil Aviation Training Center (CATC)—resulting to a much-improved and modern aviation safety training for aviation personnel.

With this, full-fledged ATC and ATC trainees can now experience an aerodrome control tower environment, which will provide them a platform to further improve their skills and capabilities without any risk to property or lives, and at lower costs.

With these developments for the future of aviation training, Secretary Tugade underscored, "Ang madadatnan nila ngayon, everything will be new, everything will be world-class, everything will be in line with our attainment of our objectives of safety and security."

Apart from this, as he introduced the project, CAAP Deputy Director General for Operations Donald Mendoza announced the various enhancements on training program further await the aviation personnel and trainees in the future.

"Within the next five years, an Air Traffic Service (ATS) program for recurrence training of tower ATCs in key aerodromes in the Philippines will also be developed," CAAP DDG Mendoza said.

During the ceremony, as Sec. Tugade expressed how proud he is for the successful implementation of the project, he commended DG Sydiongco, and the whole CAAP, for a "JOB WELL DONE."

the boat carrying them capsize after hitting a partly submerged concrete post.

"We cannot afford to waste any COVID-19 vaccine, given how precious these are, so I am counting on our PNP and BFP personnel to assist our LGUs in the safe and fast delivery of vaccines in various parts of the country," he said.

In DILG Memorandum Circular (MC)

No. 2021-052, LGUs are urged to comply with specific temperature ranges of COVID-19 vaccine refrigeration and ensure effective cold chain management. This entails temperature maintenance for transport and storage and administration of the vaccines. The MC also directs LGUs to report on the transport mechanism for the vaccines to monitor if said modes of transporta-

tion are compliant with the requisite safe-handling of the vaccines to avoid spoilage or wastage.

He also reminded LGUs to develop a firm workflow for particular vaccine requirements from storage to transport and administration to ensure the smooth management of COVID-19 vaccines.

"In our goal to achieve herd immunity by the end of this year, we

must ensure that every step in the vaccination process is properly executed," he said. As of May 17, 2021, 7,149,020 out of 7,779,050 COVID-19 vaccine doses were already deployed to vaccination centers nationwide. Of these, 3,001,875 vaccine doses have been administered; 2,282,273 were given as a first dose while 719,602 doses were used for the second dose. Source:DILG

Unhampered delivery of HIV services despite Covid19 pandemic assured by DOH

and strengthen our efforts to control and eventually reverse the HIV epidemic," Sec. Duque added.

The COVID-19 pandemic challenged the uptake of HIV services. According to DOH data as of December 2020, HIV testing decreased by 61% and treatment initiation was reduced by 28% in 2020. Moreover, only 70% of the estimated 111,400 Filipinos who are living with HIV in 2020 are aware of their status, while only 61% are on life-saving antiretroviral therapy. A total of 4,574 deaths have been reported since 1984 up to 2020.

With the pandemic being a major deterrent to accessibility, the DOH and partners from local government units through its Social Hygiene Clinics, public and private HIV treatment facilities, community-based organizations (CBOs), and advocacy groups are working

together to ensure continuous provision of HIV prevention, testing, treatment, care and support services for key populations with primary focus on ensuring continued support for people living with HIV.

In line with ensuring continuous provision of HIV services, the DOH encouraged key populations and all interested individuals to get tested and know their status, emphasizing that HIV testing is free in Social Hygiene Clinics or Reproductive Health and Wellness Centers and CBO-run community centers.

The Department further called on people living with HIV (PLHIV) to access free HIV treatment and other services and adhere to the treatment regimen. "HIV is not a death sentence. With access to the right information and life-saving treatment, HIV can be managed and those afflicted with the disease can lead happy, healthy,

and normal lives. To our PLHIV, help is always available. We urge you to access our free services and we assure you that support will continue even amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

You do not have to go through this alone; do not hesitate to contact your health care providers for any concern, especially in these trying times," Sec. Duque said.

As part of the priority group A3, DOH also encourages PLHIV to seek medical clearance prior to vaccination and get vaccinated once cleared by their attending physician.

4 million jabs by the end of June. "I've directed the PNP to secure these vaccines every step of the way and to ensure its fast delivery," he said.

"In NCR, we strive to reach 120,000 jabs a day. This May our target is 2M vaccinations. This June, our target is 4M vaccinations, so we really need not only to ramp up the vaccination efforts in LGUs, but also to ensure that more vaccines reach more provinces to meet our overall target," he said.
