

DepEd inaugurates 399 newly constructed schools

The Department of Education (DepEd) inaugurated 399 newly constructed school buildings and 98 restored Gabaldon Schoolhouses nationwide this week ahead of the opening of School Year 2021-2022. "Although the conduct of face-to-face classes is not yet allowed, these newly-installed classrooms will be instrumental in our mission to address classroom shortage in the long run," Secretary Leonor Magtolis Briones said.

The Department installed 339 newly completed school building projects equivalent to 2,040 classrooms and restored 98 Gabaldon School Buildings in various regions, including seven newly-constructed division offices. DepEd also repaired and

improved five existing Division offices in Regions 6, 8, 10, and 11 as part of the Department's School Building Program, in partnership with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH).

"Sana makita ninyo ang malaking pagbabagong ito sa school houses. Ang iba ay nasa siyudad, ang iba ay nasa malalayong lugar, ang iba ay nasa probinsiya— iisa ang design, resistant to the strong winds, malinis at kaaya-aya," Secretary Briones said. The simultaneous

ceremonial turnover of school buildings were conducted at Kalinga, Apayao, and Baguio, Benguet in Cordillera Administrative Region, Naval and Biliran in Biliran, Dipolog, Zamboanga Del Norte, and Ormoc City, Leyte on

Wednesday.

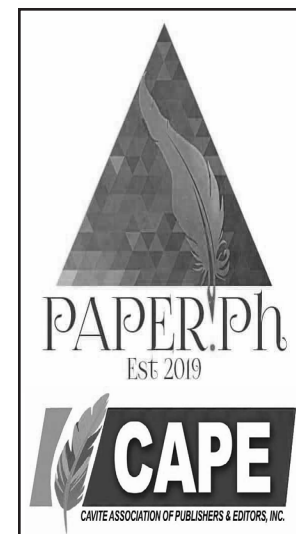
Furthermore, DepEd launched the Last Mile Schools Development Program (LMSP) as the Department recognizes the need to prioritize the development of schools in Geographically Isolated, Disadvantaged and Conflict-Affected areas (GID-CA).

"The Last Mile Schools Development Program primarily seeks to bridge the gap in schools that have not reached the allocation criteria for education inputs. These schools also lack electrical connections, school furniture, and learning materials which hamper the optimum learning experience of the students," Undersecretary for Administration Alain Del Pascua shared.

In line with this, a Ceremonial Groundbreaking Ceremony was conducted at Sitog National High School, one of the Last Mile Schools located at Dabiak, Katipunan, Zamboanga Del Norte, where they received two units of one-story, two classroom buildings. Other beneficiaries of LMSP are Leyte, Surigao Del Sur, Samar, Tabuk, Abra, Biliran, Southern Leyte, Quezon Province, and Kalinga. "For 2020-2021, different Bureaus, Services, and Schools Divisions are working together in directing various programs, projects, and activities to address the needs of these disadvantaged public schools and learners," Pascua shared. 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National Anti-Corruption program lauded by Cimat

Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Secretary Roy A. Cimat has hailed the launch of a new anti-corruption program that is expected to provide a big boost to the DENR's campaign against environmental crimes.

Last Sept. 3, the Presidential Anti-Corruption Commission and the DENR led the launch of the "Project Kasangga: Aksyon Kontra Korapsyon," creating an anti-corruption coordinating councils (ACCC) within government offices and one at a national level chaired by President Rodrigo Duterte.

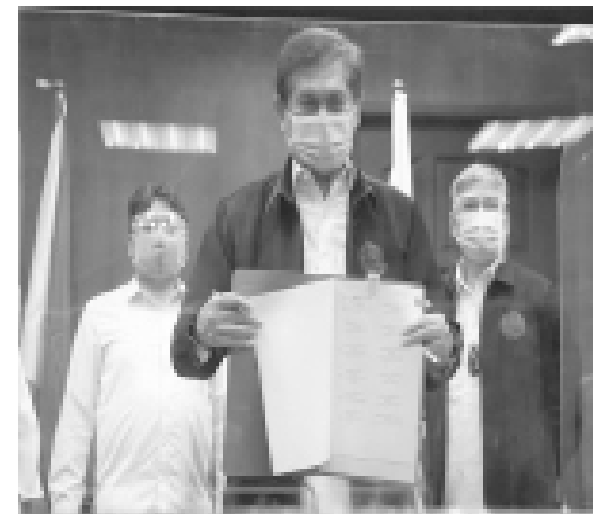

The program is a holistic way of stamping out corruption in all levels of government and complements a task force led by the Department of Justice, according to the PACC.

The ACCCs will act as department-level committees to validate corruption reports and forward them to the national ACCC.

NCR PLUS barangays responsible for 80% of new COVID-19 cases

The Department of Health (DOH) on Wednesday reported that, based on its spatio-temporal analysis of data in NCR Plus Areas and select highly urbanized cities in NCR, 80% of new cases in the recent two weeks came from 11%-30% of barangays.

The DOH added that the analysis supports the move to focus on imposing granular lockdowns on selected areas rather than wide scale lockdowns of entire provinces, highly urbanized cities, and independent component cities, which heavily impact the livelihood of Filipinos.

Additionally, wide scale lockdowns might no longer be effective since data shows that the majority of Filipinos in NCR are no longer effective. (Turn to page 2)

(From page 1) NCR were mobile during quarantine on August 10 than the previous ECQ last April 2021 as more essential activities and workers were allowed," said DOH Spokesperson Undersecretary Maria Rosario Vergeire.

The DOH and FASSSTER find that based on a set of assumptions, total active cases in NCR by September 30 may range from 152,000 to 330,000 cases.

This is not cast in stone since lower case projections are achieved when we improve adherence to the minimum public health standards, reduce case detection to isolation time, and increase vaccination coverage even at lower or less restrictive community quarantines," added Usec. Vergeire.

The DOH said that the country is moving towards more targeted and recalibrated actions towards high-risk activities, imposing these localized or granular lockdowns at the household and barangay level and implementing targeted response strategies to prevent transmission and reduce strain on the livelihood of Filipinos.

The DOH urged LGUs to conduct active case finding, reduce the time for case detection to isolation, and improve vaccine coverage to lower COVID-19 cases.

Moreover, the public is called on to continue to adhere to the minimum public health standards, immediately isolate when symptoms manifest, and seek consultation to help cut the transmission of COVID-19. Source: DOH

(From page 1) Cimatu said the initiative is especially vital in its mandate to combat environmental crimes as "corruption at the DENR unmistakably results in environmental crimes whose detrimental consequences can last for generations in terms of individual health, public safety and economy."

"I prefer standing trees to apprehended illegally-cut ones which is why my marching order is to strengthen prevention of environmental crimes like illegal logging," Cimatu pointed out.

"While our emphasis is on prevention, enforcement and detection approach should likewise play an important role through the creation of the Environmental Protection and Enforcement Bureau (EPEB) which will spearhead government's efforts to bolster certainty of punishment," he added.

The proposed EPEB consolidates all enforcement functions and will institutionalize enforcement systems and strategies based on best practices and using the most advanced and reliable technologies. "Project Kasangga has further highlighted the role of environmental law enforcers as key actors in fighting corruption," Cimatu said, noting that the project underscores the urgency for the establishment of the EPEB as its passage into law is being sponsored both in the House of Representatives and the Senate.

Two bills creating the EPEB have been filed at the Senate. These are Senate Bill Numbers 1878 and 1959 filed by Senators Nancy Binay and Ramon "Bong" Revilla Jr., respectively. At the House of Representatives, House Committee on Government Reorganization

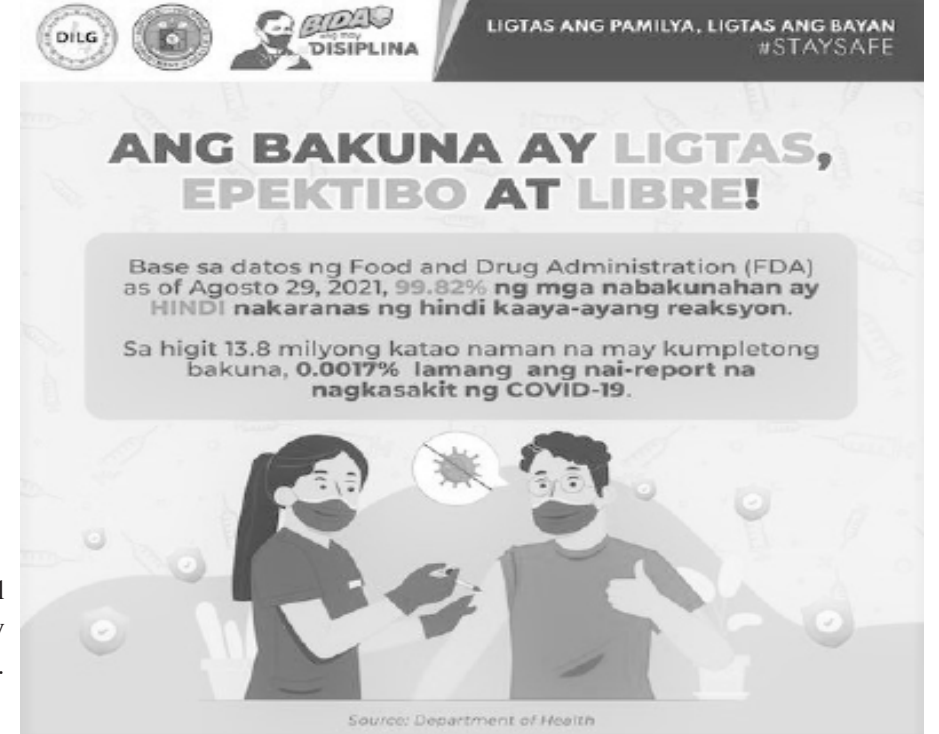

cation and utilization rate during President’s Duterte term to carry out key education reforms.

“The gains in education were made possible because of the very high level of support and commitment that your administration has given to education right from the beginning,” the education chief reported, noting that the Department posed a 96% budget utilization rate for 2020, a significant improvement compared to the 88% utilization rate in 2015.

Given these developments, the Department has gained momentum to review and update the K to 12 curriculum, invest in improving the learning environment, overhaul the in-service professional development system, form broader partnerships with stakeholders for consultation and collaboration.

“We have continually addressed the challenge of quality in basic education. We are now concentrating on quality since we were successful in increasing enrollment alone but quality as well,” Briones emphasized.

In addition, the Department constructed 150,149 new classrooms and 12,786 technical and

vocational laboratories and workshops while repairing and rehabilitating 103,548 classrooms in the last five years.

Briones also highlighted that the Alternative Learning System (ALS) Act helped more out-of-school youth and adults.

The average number of Out-of-School Youth and Adults (OSYAs) enrollees from 2016-2021 is 57% higher compared to past administrations.

Meanwhile, from 2016 to 2021, around 2 million learner beneficiaries were fed under the School-based Feeding Program, a marked improvement from the annual average of 296,239 from 2010 to 2016.

The Department also hired 205,850 teachers or 96% of the 213,736 teaching positions created from 2016 to 2020, which resulted in the improvement of our teacher-learner ratio from 1:32 in 2016 to 1:28 in 2020 for the elementary level.

Briones also mentioned the establishment of the Education Futures Programme, the inauguration of the National Academy of Sports, and the proposal to establish new teaching positions to promote career growth among teachers as key gains of the Department in the last five years. Source: DepEd
