

# Work plan vs Trafficking in Persons intensified

To further intensify and sustain regional efforts against trafficking in persons (TIP), key representatives from ASEAN Sectoral Bodies from all ASEAN Member States (AMS), including the Philippines, are now working on the development of a new ASEAN cross-sectoral TIP work plan that will build on the gains and lessons of the Bohol TIP Work Plan (BWP).

As voluntary lead shepherd on TIP, DILG Undersecretary Bernardo C. Florece Jr., who is also the Senior Officials Meeting on Transnational Crime (SOMTC) Leader-Philippines and SOMTC Chair of the Working Group on TIP, said that since the BWP wrapped up in 2020, ASEAN cross sectoral bodies recognized the need to embark on the possible development of a Successor Cross Sectoral Work Plan to further counter the menace of TIP.

“Given the complexities and nature of TIP as transborder crime, it is a battle that no single country can fight alone on its own. But the power of the international community could, together, if it intends to,” Florece said during his welcome address at the recently concluded ASEAN Cross-Sectoral Validation Meeting on the Bohol TIP Work Plan in the New Clark City in Pampanga which the SOMTC-Philippines organized.

He said the TIP is a battle that “no single country can fight alone on its own” as he stressed the importance of interdependence and harmony among ASEAN members and the ASEAN Community and the crafting of a successor work plan to solidify efforts and up the ante against TIP.

During the validation meeting, Florece said the ASEAN cross-sectoral delegates saw the value of the Bohol TIP work plan in creating a streamlined, holistic, and inclusive regional approach to address the complex issues and concerns of TIP. He said that during the review of the BWP, ASEAN delegates

noted the significant accomplishments in the campaign against TIP through the BWP such as increased levels of awareness among members of the public and in key communities of TIP, increased reporting of suspected TIP cases to law enforcement officials; more rapid provision of assistance and support ser-

vices to TIP victims; and improved conduct of repatriation procedures for victims of TIP.

“Through the BWP, TIP cases were also reduced and there were high conviction rates in TIP-related prosecutions. There was also increased collaboration and better coordination among national

agencies, international organizations and other stakeholders on TIP-related issues,” he said.

On the other hand, he said the activity also allowed the delegates to take note of the enhancements on the BWP, particularly in institutionalizing a more structured and effective

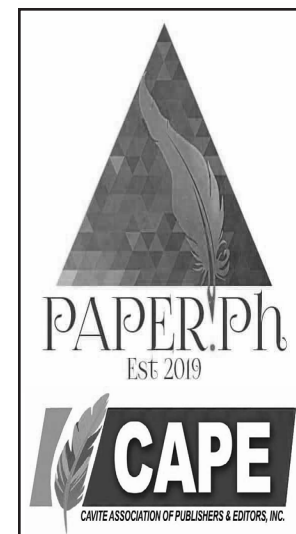

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# Webinar series improves numeracy and literacy teaching

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learning and Delivery (BLD), in partnership with the US Embassy – Regional English Language Office (RELO), has launched a webinar series on Integrated Language Learning in Early Childhood: Focus on Literacy and Numeracy.

“It is good to have partners who believe in the efforts of the Department to strengthen the capacity of teachers in improving their numeracy and literacy teaching skills. This event will surely equip them in developing the culture of reading and love for mathematics among our learners,” Secretary

Leonor Magtolis Briones said.

Spearheaded by BLD, the webinar series contains six modules for teachers and school heads that will run from March 21 to April 27, 2022, with different schedules for participants according to their respective regions.

“This course is de-

signed to provide teachers and school heads with an overview of Content Integrated Language Learning, Early Literacy, and Bilingual Education. They can also learn specific strategies and tasks which can be implemented in the classroom and community to improve K-3 students’ literacy skills,” Undersec-

retary for Curriculum and Instruction Diosdado San Antonio noted.

Different topics on teaching literacy and numeracy will be tackled throughout the series including content and attitude goals in the classroom, developing literacy skills, and activities and assessment in teaching in English, among others.

Each session will run for 2 hours in a lecture-demo approach to include the question and answer and completion of activities. A total of 3,000 participants all over the country are expected to attend.

National reps for ACTIP As a way forward, Florece said ASEAN is now moving for the establishment of ACTIP (ASEAN Convention Against Trafficking in Persons, Especially Women and Children) national representatives for an effective and efficient channel to facilitate linkages, coordination, and complementarity between regional and national activities to implement ACTIP. The National ACTIP Representatives shall have the following roles and responsibilities, among others: reporting

of National-level ACTIP migration Departments implementation progress, lessons learned, replicable processes, progress reporting and evolution of government efforts to counter TIP; and coordination, collaboration and consultation with relevant ASEAN Sectoral Bodies at the national level on countering TIP efforts. Each National ACTIP Representative will report to the SOMTC Leader and Focal Points of their respective country, assist and support the SOMTC Leader to undertake ACTIP-related functions at national level, and perform other roles and responsibilities based on demands of their countries as requested by their respective SOMTC Leaders.

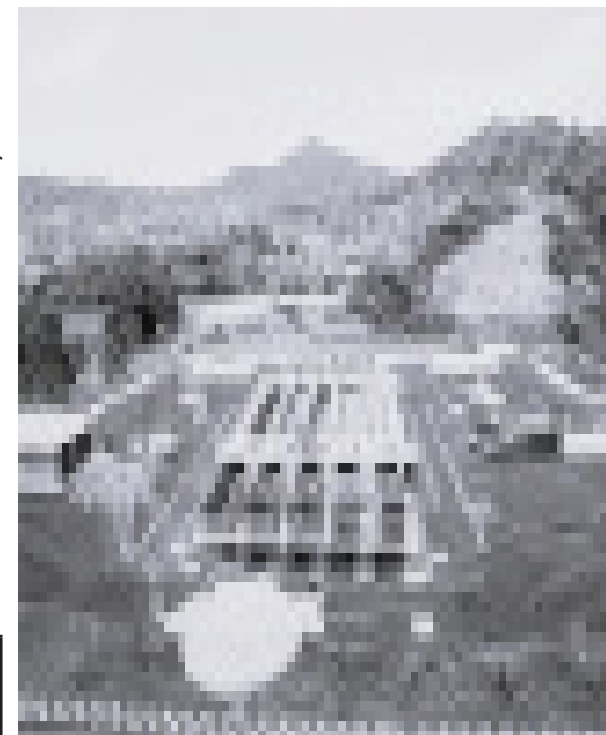

Inaugural PH- Japan Foreign and Defense Ministerial Talks
in Tokyo a Milestone in Decade-long Strategic Partnership

In a significant mile- stone in their decade-old Strategic Partnership, the Philippines and Japan held their first Foreign and De- fense Ministerial Meeting on 9 April 2022 in Tokyo, Japan.

The Philippine dele- gation was co-led by Sec- retary of Foreign Affairs Teodoro L. Locsin, Jr., and Secretary of Defense Del- fin N. Lorenzana. Japanese Minister for Foreign Af- fairs HAYASHI Yoshima-

sa and Minister of Defense KISHI Nobuo led the Jap- anese side.

The ministers hailed the establishment of the 2+2 talks as a key aspect in deepening security and defense cooperation between the two coun- tries. They also issued a Joint Statement reflecting the discussions that took place and the points of consensus they reached. They also noted the Terms of Reference on the 2+2
