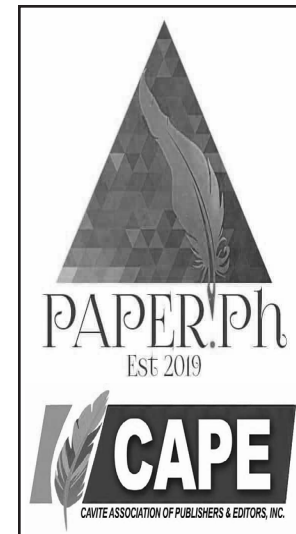

Five learners from two public elementary schools in Quezon City won bronze medals in the World Robot Olympiad (WRO) held in Dortmund, Germany. The robotics team of Betty Go-Belmonte Elementary School (BGBES)—composed of Angelina Phoebe Castañeda, Mikaella Jannielle Sevilla, and Joem Fugaban—secured a bronze score ranking in the Robo Mission category, wherein contestants design, construct, and program an autonomous robot that can solve specific challenges on the field.

DENR-ERDB sees stronger regional partnerships after R&D confab on urban parks, green cities

The Ecosystems Research and Development Bureau (ERDB) of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) is looking forward to a more sustainable development and management of urban parks and green cities across Southeast Asia with the recently concluded regional research and development (R&D) conference.

The ERDB-hosted "R&D Conference on Urban Parks and Green Cities: A Sustainable Future in Southeast Asia," which was held from October 11 to 13 in Manila, brought

together R&D specialists from the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) to discuss the future of urban parks and green cities in the region amid the threats of climate change and other environmental issues.

The research papers presented bared that due to rapid urbanization, metropolitan parks and green spaces are declining and are victims of mismanagement and overexploitation thereby placing environmental challenges and liveability risks.

ERDB Director

Maria Lourdes G. Ferrer expressed hope the conference was able to stimulate new and stronger partnerships among ASEAN member countries for improved strategies, measures and policies to address environmental challenges faced by urban parks and green spaces.

"Through this scientific gathering, we have now started our partnership in our effort to help mitigate the effects not only of climate change but also of other environmental issues and concerns to the urban ecosystem in particular," Ferrer said.

Ferrer said the conference was in line with DENR Secretary Maria Antonia Yulo Loyzaga's directives to adopt science-based adaptation strategies in combating national and local effects of climate change.

Seventy-five research works written by local and international experts were presented which focused on Green and Resilient Urban Communities, Urban Biodiversity, Ecosystem and Economics, Management and Impact of Urban Parks, and Urban Governance and Policies of Greener Cities.

"We have shared a wealth of scientific information in this conference, and it is part of our responsibility as researchers and scientists to communicate these to those who could join hands with us in creating lasting change. These may be the national government policymakers, the local government units, even the communities," Ferrer said.

Among the research works presented were studies from different urban parks and cities in Southeast Asia on the evaluation



of ecosystem services, risk reduction planning and management, and public value and roles of urban parks.

Presentations also include the sustainability of water and sanitation, assessment of flora and fauna in urban areas, landscape restoration in urban parks, and policy review, formulation and institutional arrangement.

Conference participants were introduced to new research methodologies from each other's works, stirring inspiration

to replicate the studies and adapt them locally in their countries.

Ferrer said the ERDB aims to gather the

SCIENTISTS ASSURE THE PUBLIC ON TECH AVAILABILITY TO MANAGE NUCLEAR WASTE

Management Facility in the Philippines to ensure proper management of radioactive waste. The said facility is authorized to treat, condition, and store radioactive waste.

Meanwhile, in her presentation, Kristine Marie Romallosa-Dean, head of DOST-PNRI's Radiation Protection Services, said that the Institute has different services that can ensure the safety of the workers. It includes calibration, personal monitoring, radiation control services, and dose registry.

To the question if we are safe from the use of nuclear technology, Dean believes that we are all safe if we have proper radiation control and we have effective radiation protection services.

"The main principle of radiation protection is that if we only pursue certain activities even if it has radiation, does the benefit offset the risk? Now, of course there is a risk of having a nuclear power program. Tama naman ang history, may accidents in the past. However, if you want to convince these people, focus tayo sa benefits. If you look at the energy profile of the Philippines, we really need to add energy sources," explained Dean.

She added that nuclear energy can be one of the best solutions in terms of energy supply security as well as the economic benefits. She hopes that we can highlight its benefits and manage the risks.

"One of the most important aspects of nuclear technology is legislative and regulatory infrastructure because those regulations and laws, doon nakalagay lahat ng security and safety requirements," Dean further explained.

She said that nuclear energy has been in operation in many countries for 60 years. It means that regulatory oversight has also matured and not only the technology. Dean suggested that we should always learn from regulators in other countries like Japan, United States, and South Korea on how they kept these nuclear power plants safe.

"Finland is the first country that is almost finished constructing its repository or nuclear waste disposal for high-level waste and it is a success story. It highlighted the social acceptance as they overcome the barriers and the reason for that is trust in our institution or operators," said Dean.

In finding solution to the radioactive waste problem, Engr. Piquero answered, "Ang nuclear power technology is a matured technology. 60 years ago, mayroon ng nuclear power plant in operation sa buong mundo about 10% ng electricity ay galing sa nuclear power so lahat ng technology ay available, lahat ng knowledge is available para makagawa ng final disposal facility," explained Engr. Piquero.

He added that all the nuclear waste ever produced in the United States

can fit in 50-foot stacks on a single football field.

Engr. Piquero also dispelled the idea that nuclear waste is hazardous for thousands of years and poses threat to future generations.

"Radioactive waste naturally decays unlike other toxic waste that remains hazardous indefinitely. Most radioactive waste is only hazardous for a few tens of years as only high-level waste (3% volume) requires isolation for thousands of years," explained Engr. Piquero.

Regarding the site disposal facility, he said that once we decide where we would put the nuclear power plant, then that is the time, as well, that we can decide where we would put the nuclear waste disposal facility.

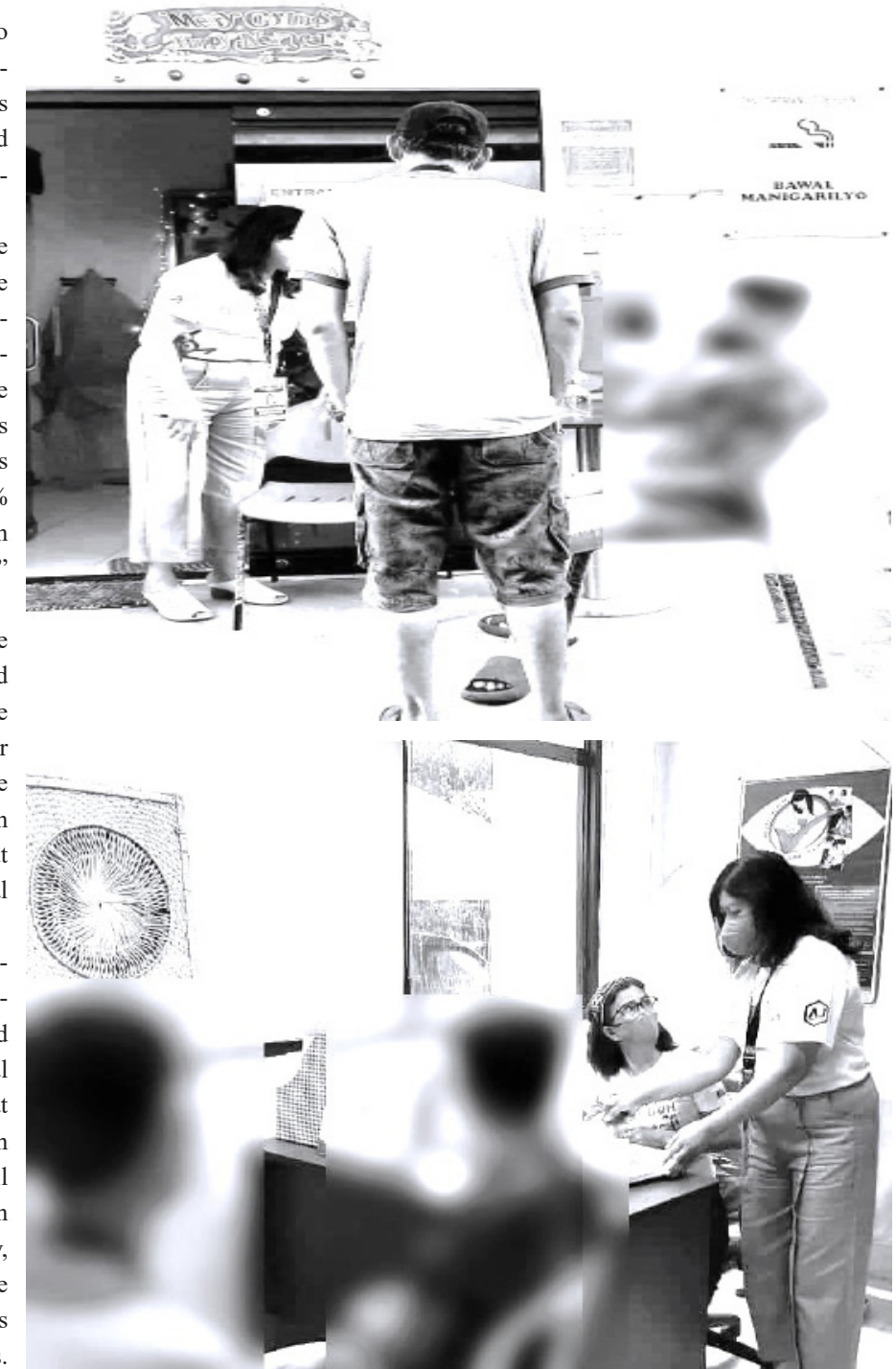
In his video message, DOST-PNRI Director Carlo A. Arcilla said that they have technical divisions and experts that can look out for radiation protection services as well as the materials that can potentially harm society, nuclear materials, and the disposal of waste products of radioactive activities.

"Our experts will tell you how we dispose of these materials safely and what are the possibilities for protection that are afforded to the public," said Dir. Arcilla.

He added that nuclear material radiation is not visible, and that is why it is important that the public be protected. (By Allan Mauro V. Marfal, DOST-STII)

Abalos, Jr. said there would be no letup in anti-illegal drug raids and operations by law enforcement units under the new BIDA program aside from giving focus on demand reduction and rehabilitation of drug users.

(From page 1) ing HIV case with a 237% increase in annual new HIV infections from 2010-2021. In the same period, AIDS-related deaths have increased by 315%. Currently, the latest DOH HIV, AIDS and ART Registry of the Philippines reported that there were 107,177 cases since January 1984. Moreover, as of October 2022 , there were 1,383 newly-diagnosed cases and 65 newly-reported deaths in the country. Majority (96%) of new cases were male. Age of reported cases ranged from 2-75 years old. Sexual contact remained as the predominant mode of transmission (97%). According to experts, if the current efforts in HIV response are maintained, the estimated PLHIV in the Philippines could reach 364,000 by 2030, which is a two-fold increase from estimated PLHIV by the end of 2022.

To realize the vision of zero new infection, zero discrimination, and zero AIDS-related death, the DOH emphasized that all stakeholders and partners, including community and civil society organizations, must act holistically—not just looking at health but also addressing its determinants—to end the HIV epidemic. "We must all work together not just to implement our strategies and interventions, but to ensure that those who need it most—especially our PLHIVs and other key populations—are able to access our HIV services without difficulty or stigma. Beyond this, we must also harness our individual expertise and join our efforts to address the systemic and socioeconomic barriers that prevent our fellow Filipinos from leading healthy, productive lives free from the impacts of HIV. Only through collective action will we be able to end the HIV epidemic in the country," Health OIC Singh-Vergeire expressed. "On an individual level, marami rin tayong mga pansariling hakbang na maaring gawin upang mapigilan ang pagkalat ng HIV. Let us always practice safe sex, regularly undergo HIV testing, and encourage all our friends and peers to do the same," added OIC Singh-Vergeire. Source: DOH

BIDA program is a nationwide anti-illegal drugs program that focuses on demand reduction and rehabilitation using a more intensified and holistic approach involving the national government agencies, local government units, and other key sectors down to the grassroots level within the framework of the law, with respect for human rights, complemented by socioeconomic development.

The DILG Secretary said the country's anti-illegal drugs drive has, in fact, been gaining ground as some 24,159 drug personalities have been arrested from July 1 to November 24, 2022 alone under the administration of President (Turn to page 5)
