

DepEd looks toward improving teacher's welfare

Recognizing teaching quality in the country. In her Basic Education Report 2023, Vice President and Secretary of Education Sara Z. Duterte recognized the zeal and

passion of Filipino teachers, vowing to champion their welfare and professional development as part of her MATATAG: Bangsang Makabata, Batang Makabansa agenda.

“Teachers are critical to the success of education. When they are supported, education quality improves,” Vice President and Secretary Duterte said.

Duterte emphasized that the agency will remove the administrative task of teachers and will continuously advocate for additional benefits and address issues affecting their net-take-home pay.

“We will remove non-teaching tasks and provide administrative officers in schools. We will provide adequate man-


power complement in schools, manage teachers' workload, and compensate teachers for unique school challenges,” VP-Sec. Duterte said.

“We will continuously advocate for additional benefits for our teachers. We will work towards addressing issues affecting the net-take-home pay of teachers,” she added.

The Education chief also said that the agency would implement a policy on the distribution of workload and payment for teaching overload.

DepEd will also request the Department of Budget and Management the expansion of the coverage of Special Hardship Allowances, and closely

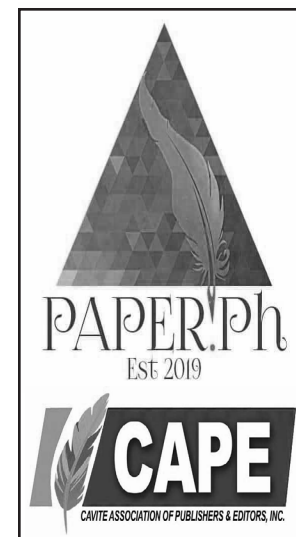

Vice President and Secretary of Education Sara Z. Duterte calls for unity and urgency in addressing learning gaps and education equality in her message during the opening of the Southeast Asian Education Ministers for the 52nd SEAMEO Council Conference (SEAMEC).

“We need to act now. We cannot afford to waste more time. As education leaders, we cannot allow a single child to miss out on the opportunity and benefits of learning and use it positively,” VP Sec-

retary Sara Z. Duterte said before the SEAMEC delegations in attendance.

“As education leaders, we have a huge responsibility. The decisions we make today will determine the quality of life in our countries and the entire ASEAN Region, and the ripple effect in these decisions can reverberate for generations to come,” she added.

The Education Chief made the call for all ASEAN leaders to embrace ‘bayanihan’, urging the members of the council



Every action counts to achieve zero waste

DSWD provides assistance to NKTi via AICS

Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Secretary Rex Gatchalian joined President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. as he visited the patients of the National Kidney and Transplant Institute (NKTi) on Monday, February 6, during the Institute's 40th year Foundation Anniversary.

During the visit, Secretary Gatchalian provided assistance to the indigent patients of the NKTi through the Assistance to

Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS). Some 160 eligible patients admitted to the hospital received Php10,000 cash assistance each.

The patients can use their financial assistance for their medical expenses as well as for their basic daily expenses while in the hospital.

The AICS program serves as a social safety net or a stop-gap mechanism to support the recovery of

individuals and families from unexpected crises such as illness or death of a family member, natural and man-made disasters, and other crisis situation.

Aside from cash assistance, families and individuals who are in crisis situation may avail of medical, burial, transportation, and educational assistance through the AICS.

In 2022, a total of 5,336,381 individuals in crisis situation were provided with outright cash

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR)—through its Environmental Management Bureau (EMB)—is urging everyone to step up to the plate and be part of the solution to the growing waste management problem after the country observed last month the National Zero Waste Month.

Believing that every action counts when it comes to solid waste management, the EMB said it is high time people take responsibility and do their best to properly dispose waste with zero waste living—reuse, reduce, recycle—on top of everyone's

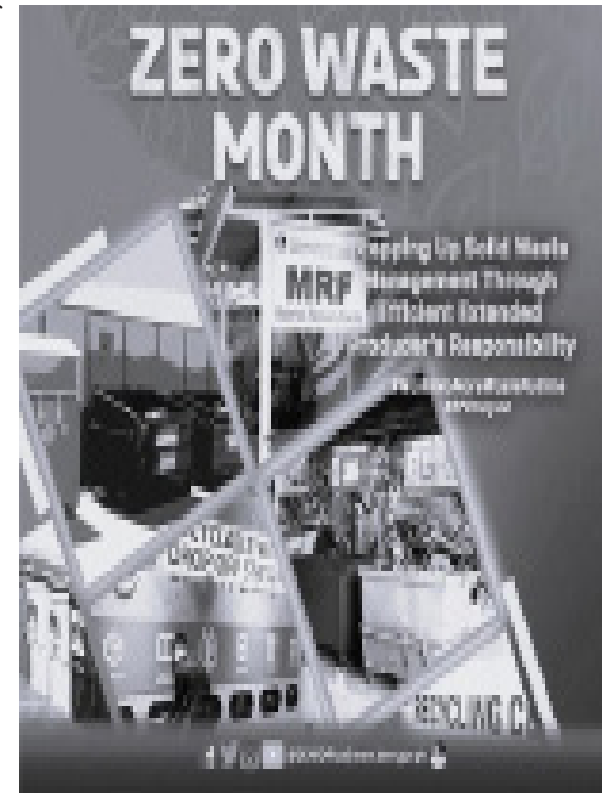
mindset.

According to the EMB, each person's action matters as the country already suffers from garbage overload, lack of land to serve as sanitary landfills, and even the mismanagement of these solid waste disposal systems.

The EMB said it is vital that households and communities have zero waste strategies in place, especially since Republic Act 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 has been in effect for 22 years now.

Among these strategies are composting organic wastes, switching to reusable containers and bags instead of using single-use plastics, segregating wastes, and retrieving recyclable materials.

The EMB expressed confidence the newly enacted Extended Producers Responsibility (EPR) Act of 2022 or RA 11898 would remarkably aid in addressing the country's solid waste and plastic pollution problems.



ment units (LGUs), and the private sector.

On February 9-10, the EMB will host a conference of various stakeholders for sharing of initiatives toward an efficient EPR and a ceremonial commitment of the industry sector to EPR compliance and submission to the EPR program.

In collaboration with the Department of the Interior and Local Government, the DENR gathered on January 10 and 11 the LGUs nationwide to facilitate the submission and endorsement of the remaining 10-year solid waste management plans (SWMPs) to the National Solid Waste Management Commission, which aims to achieve 100 percent approval of SWMPs this year.

The observance of National Zero Waste Month during January of every year is pursuant to Proclamation No. 760 signed in 2014 by then President Benigno S. Aquino Jr. Source: DENR

Furthermore, DepEd commits to elevating teaching approaches and standards by following the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST) and capacitating them in utilizing and maximizing the benefits of digital and remote learning.

“We will continuously provide professional development programs, including graduate degree scholarship programs to teachers focusing on their learning area specialization

and graduate certificate programs for nonmajors,” VP-Sec. Duterte noted. The Department will likewise fast-track the career progression policy and strictly implement the Merit Selection Policy to avoid any intervention in appointing personnel to vacant positions.

PH-Japan cooperation sought for further advancements in manufacturing

Trade and Industry Secretary Fred Pascual joined President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. in a roundtable meeting with Japanese companies with export-oriented investments in the Philippines, particularly those in the Semiconductor, Electronics, and Wiring Harnesses industries. The meeting was a crucial part of the Presidential Visit to affirm and strengthen the robust economic partnerships between the Philippines and Japan.

In his opening statement, Secretary Pascual said, "With the demand expected to grow in the global market, we would like to explore how we can encourage you to expand and upgrade your operations in the Philippines."

The manufacturing of semiconductors, electronics, and wiring harnesses is considered as one of the top contributors to the country's economic growth. In 2021, the Philippines was the 4th largest exporter of wiring harness in the world after Mexico, China, & Romania. Global market share of wiring harness exports is 7% (USD2.3 billion annual sales). Further, the Philippines is also one of the lowest cost producers of wiring harness in the world based on export value and quantity.
