

# DSWD distributes donations to Sulu Zamboanga victims



Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) Secretary Rex Gatchalian hands over on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, the financial assistance donated by the People's Republic of China (PRC) and the Government of Hungary, along with the family food packs and hygiene kits from the Department, to the victims of the 2019 Sulu (left) and Zamboanga City (right) bombing incidents.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) distributed financial assistance amounting to P35,850,000.00 and P1,672,691.00 from the Government of Hungary, on Wednesday, March 22, to the victims of the 2019 Sulu and Zamboanga City bombing incidents.

DSWD Secretary Rex Gatchalian received the donations from the PRC amounting to P245,000.00 each, and the four wounded individuals received P245,000.00 each from the PRC.

The respective families of the two slain civilians during the Zamboanga City bombing received P350,000.00 each, and the four wounded individuals received P245,000.00 each from the PRC.

Meanwhile, 84 out of the 135 victims of the Sulu bombing incident also received financial assistance from PRC. Families of the slain individuals received P350,000.00 each while the wounded victims received P245,000.00 each. Aside from the cash aid given by PRC, an additional P15,600 each for the families of those who perished, and P11,000 each for the wounded victims were extended by the Government of Hungary. The rest of the victims are currently being validated and located by DSWD Field Office IX.

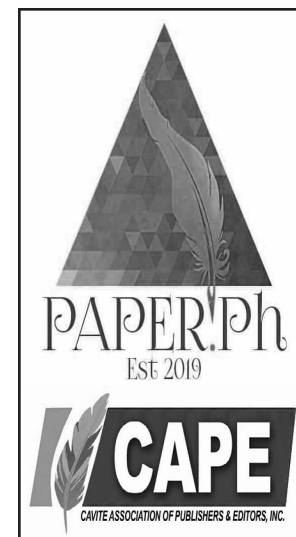
