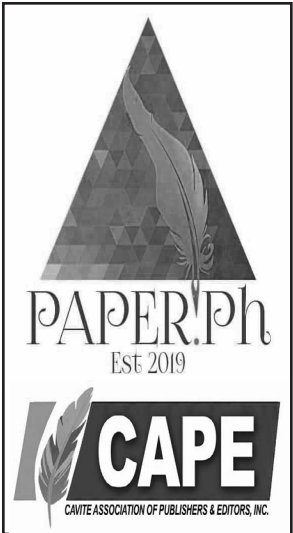

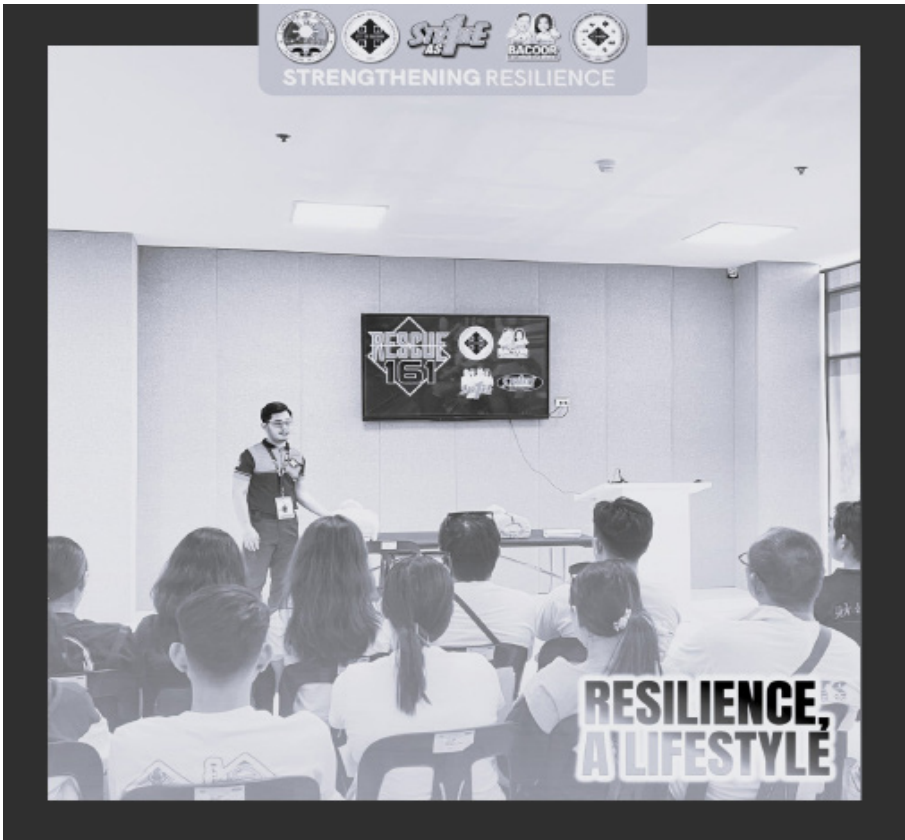

Sonny Angara said. Lastly, DepEd will conduct the 2025 Learning Camp, a four-week intervention piloted in 10 select schools across the MATATAG Pilot Regions: Regions I, II, VII, XII, National Capital Region, Cordillera Administrative Region, and CARAGA.

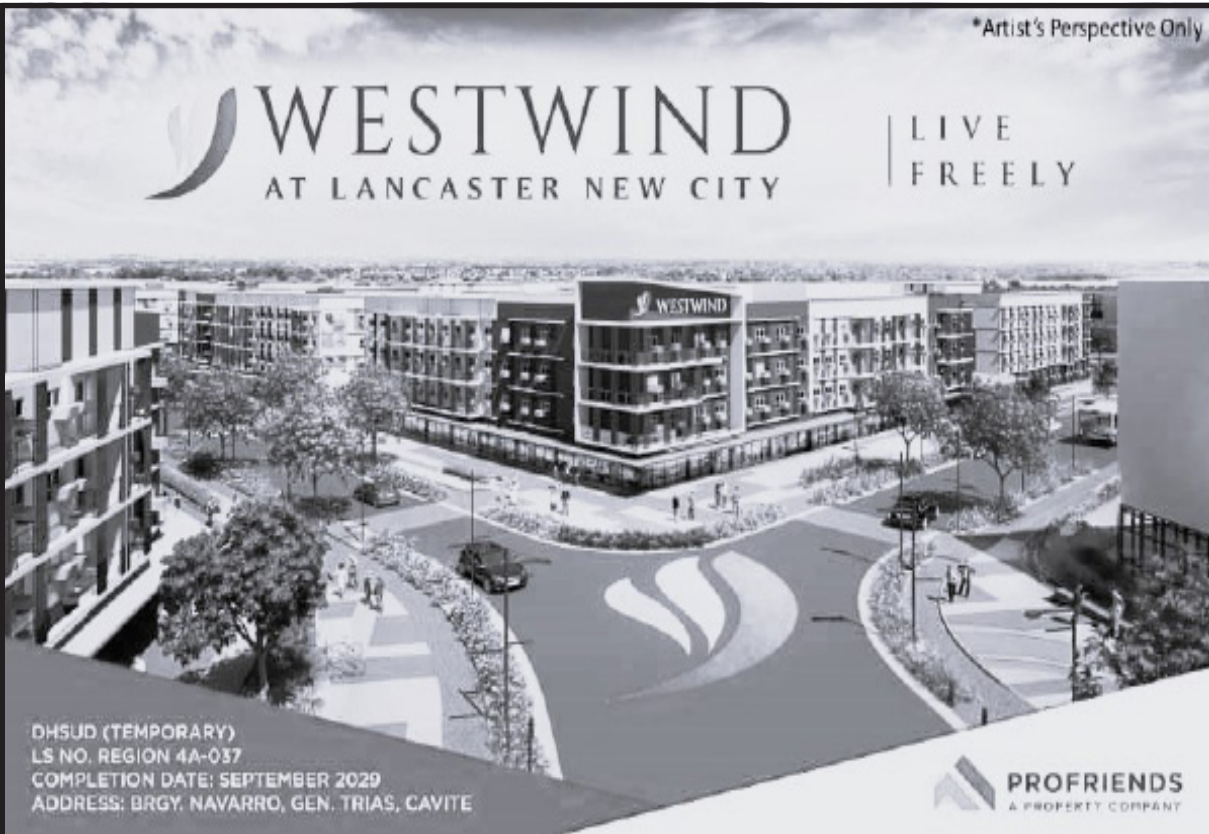
The camp builds on insights from the National Learning Camp and aims to enhance teacher capacity. Learners who are identified as needing targeted support require mandatory attendance to the specific Summer Programs.

To support educators, DepEd will provide incentives for teachers involved in the summer sessions, including vacation service credits and professional recognition in their contribution. The authorized grant of vacation service credit for teachers attending Summer Programs is exclusive of the 30 days maximum service credits.

"We recognize that our teachers are at the heart of learning recovery. These incentives are a way to value their dedication and expertise, particularly during the summer break," Angara said.

Data generated from the Summer Programs will be used to improve the implementation of Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning Program.

This integration will allow for better identification of persistent learning gaps, enabling the department to refine its intervention strategies for foundational skills and academic recovery. Source: DepEd

Aimed at addressing gaps in reading and mathematics through a combination of interactive tutorials and targeted interventions, the Summer Programs will focus on phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension in reading; and number sense, basic operations, and problem-solving in mathematics.

(From page 1) statement follows recent reports of campaign activities where members of vulnerable sectors were subjected to insensitive jokes and used to discredit political rivals.

In his statement, Secretary Gatchalian condemned the use of marginalized groups including solo parents, senior citizens, and persons with disabilities, as campaign props or subjects of jokes during barangay-based caucuses and election sorties.

"Kaya huwag na nating subukan kung plano pa nating gawin. Ang mga mahihirap, may kapananan, mga matatanda, the poor, vulnerable, and mar-

ginalized, hindi sila props para sa kampanya, hindi sila punchline ng mga biro sa kampanya. Let us not go there anymore. So banta to or warning to sa mga nagbabalak," Secretary Gatchalian told TV 5.

The DSWD chief earlier said in a news forum that the DSWD will continue to be a watchdog to protect the poor, marginalized and vulnerable sectors against any forms of abuse and exploitation.

The DSWD will also provide necessary assistance such as financial aid, psychosocial and emotional interventions, and legal assistance to the affected individuals, according to Secretary Gatchalian. (YADP). Source: DSWD
