Spearheaded by the Provincial Government of Cavite through the Office of the Provincial Tourism

Officer and MPT South—the concessionaire behind the Cavite-Laguna Expressway (CALAX) and Manila-Cavite Expressway (CAVITEX), which serve as the province’s gateway from NCR and Laguna—the Cavite Tourism Passport is back for another year, now with more exciting mechanics to level up your local adventures.

In partnership with the Department of Tourism (DOT) CALABARZON and the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), this year’s edition features over 100 DOT-accredited establishments across

Cavite, categorized into Staycation, Adventure, Food, and Heritage destinations.

So, what’s new? A point-based system that gamifies the journey. Instead of simply collecting stamps, travelers will now earn points as they visit each accredited spot.

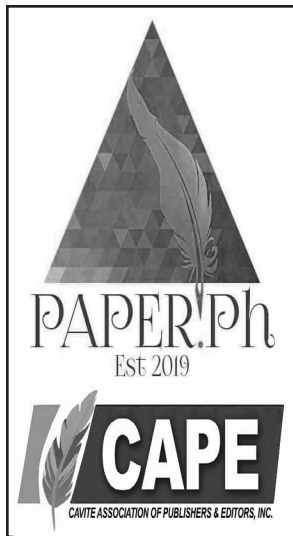
The event was led by Mayor Strike B. Revilla, Congressman Bryan

**One of the marching orders of President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr. to the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) is to ensure that household-beneficiaries of the Pantawid Family-ang Pilipino Program (4Ps) will only exit the program if their living condition has indeed improved towards self-sufficiency.**

“Noong SONA pan ng ating mga benepis-yaryo,” DSWD Secretary Rex Gatchalian said in his inspirational message, delivered by Undersecretary Adonis Sulit of the Policy and Planning Group (PPG), during the 4Ps program’s 17th anniversary celebration.

Secretary Gatchalian said the 4Ps’ enhancements are being made to amend Republic Act No. 11310, the law that institutionalized the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program to make it more adaptive and responsive to the needs of

# Dagdag-Subsidiya, Alay ng DepEd sa mga Guro ng Pribadong Paaralan

Inaprubahan ng Department of Education (DepEd) ang makabuluhang pagtaas sa taunang Teachers' Salary Subsidy (TSS) para sa mga kwalipikadong guro sa pribadong paaralan sa ilalim ng Government Assistance to Students and Teachers in Private Education (GASTPE) Program.

Mula sa kasalukuyang ₱18,000, itataas ang subsidiya sa ₱24,000 bawat guro kada taon simula sa School Year 2025–2026, matapos ang referendum na pag-apruba ng State Assistance Council (SAC), ang policy-making

body na nangangasiwa sa GASTPE. Layunin ng hakbang na ito na kilalanin at suportahan ang mahalagang papel ng mga guro sa pribadong sektor sa sistema ng edukasyon sa bansa.

Sa ginanap na ceremonial signing nitong Huwebes, binigyang-diin ni Education Secretary Sonny Angara ang kahalagahan ng mga guro sa pribadong sektor bilang bahagi ng mas malawak na misyon para sa pambansang kaunlaran.

“Sa mga tumutok sa ika-apat na State of the Nation Address ni Pangulong Ferdinand ‘Bongbong’



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Marcos, Jr., malinaw na nakita natin—nasa rurok ng kanyang mga prayoridad ang edukasyon,” ani Angara. “At mula’t sapul, pinaninindigan natin na ang edukasyon ay isang kolektibong misyon.”

Binigyang-diin din ni Angara ang pangangailangang tugunan ang agwat sa pagitan ng mga guro sa pampubliko at pribadong sektor, lalo na pagdating sa usapin ng sahod.

“Malaki pa rin ang agwat ng kalagayan ng ating mga guro sa pribadong edukasyon kasama ang pampublikong paaralan.

Ngunit ngayon, nagsasagawa tayo ng isang kongkretong hakbang upang paliitin ang agwat na iyon at itaguyod ang pribadong edukasyon kasama ang pampubliko,” aniya.

Nagkaroon ng GASTPE Program sa bisa ng Republic Act No. 8545 o ang “Expanded Government Assistance to Students and Teachers in Private Education Act” upang

magbigay ng pinansyal na tulong sa mga mag-aaral at guro sa mga pribadong institusyon ng edukasyon. Layunin ng Teachers' Salary Subsidy na dagdagan ang kita ng mga guro sa mga paaralang kalahok sa Education Service Contracting (ESC) scheme.

Upang maging kwalipikado para sa TSS, kailangang licensyado ang guro, full-time na empleyado ng isang kalahok na pribadong paaralan, at nagtuturo sa mga ESC grantees nang hindi bababa sa tatlong oras kada linggo.

Ang mga minimum na kuwalipikasyong ito ay sinisiguro na ang subsidiya ay napupunta sa mga gurong tuwirang nag-aambag sa akademikong tagumpay ng mga estudyanteng nasa ilalim ng programa ng pamahalaan.

Binigyang-diin din ni Angara ang kahalagahan ng patuloy na pakikipagtulungan sa mga local government unit, development partners, at mga tag-

apagtaguyod ng pribadong edukasyon upang maisakatuparan ang layunin ng DepEd na maghatid ng dekalidad at abot-kayang edukasyon.

“Katuwang natin dito ang national government, mga LGU, development partners, at ang private education institutions,” dagdag pa niya. “Kaya’t taus-puso ang ating pasasalamat kay PBBM sa kanyang tunay at taos-pusong malasakit sa edukasyon at sa bawat Pilipinong guro.”

Ang pagtaas sa subsidiya ay isang kongkretong hakbang sa pagpapatupad ng mas malawak na reporma sa edukasyon sa ilalim ng administrasyong Marcos, gaya ng binigyang-diin sa SONA. Kabilang dito ang pagpapabuti ng kapakanan ng mga guro, pagbibigay ng digital tools para sa pagtuturo, at pagbabawas ng labis na administratibong gawain.

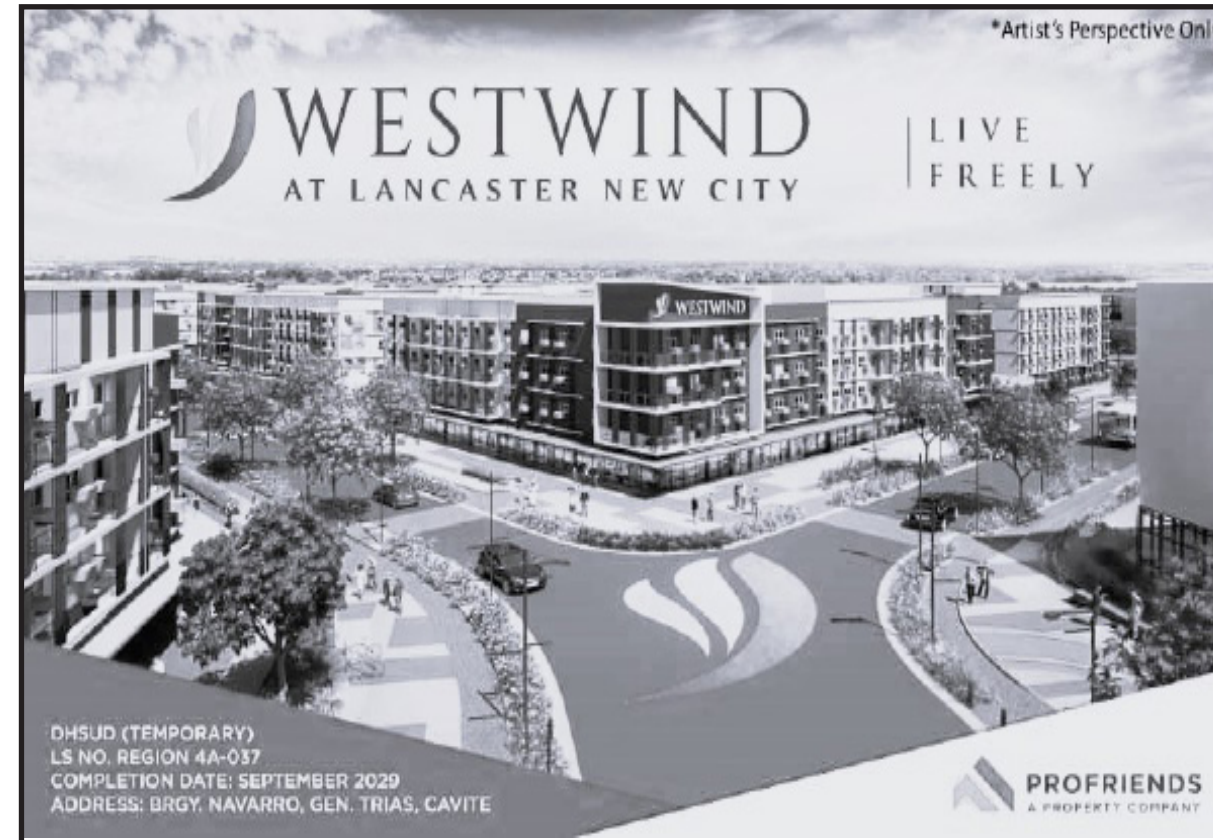
