beneficiaries.

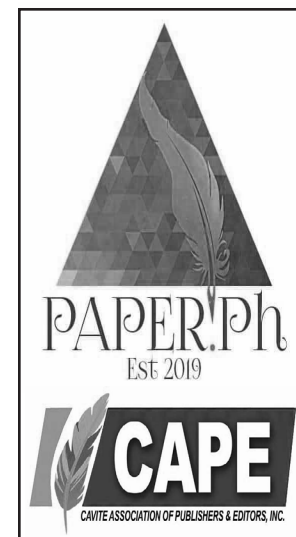

# EDSA Road Rehab Gagamit ang Japanese Technology, Sisimulan sa Disyembre 24

Japanese technology er. gagamitin para mas mabilis, matibay ang kalsada. Sisimulan na ng Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) ang pagsasaayos ng EDSA sa Disyembre 24 gamit ang bagong teknolohiya na mas mabilis at matibay para sa rehabilitasyon ng highway.

Kasunod ito ng direktiba ni Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr. na maghanap ng mas mabilis at mas murang solusyon para ayusin ang EDSA nang hindi nakakaabala sa mga motorista at komiyut-

Sinabi ni Public Works Secretary Vince Dizon na mas mabilis na ang pagre-rehabilitate ng EDSA dahil gagamit ng Japanese technology para matiyak na mas matibay at tatagal ang kalsada.

## DFA Strengthens Consular Services Commitment During 2025 Consultation Meeting

The Department of Foreign Affairs’ Office of Consular Affairs (OCA) successfully conducted the 2025 Consular Offices Consultation Meeting (COCM) on 27-28 November 2025 at the Golden Phoenix Hotel, Pasay City. Spearheaded by OCA’s Consular Offices’ Coordinating Division (COCD), the two-day meeting gathered the Heads and representatives of the 42 Consular Offices (COs) nationwide to provide updates and discuss ways to further improve the deliv-

ery of services by the COs. In her virtual message to the participants, OCA Assistant Secretary Anne Jalando-on Louis highlighted the importance of the COCM as a venue for learning, sharing of best practices, and building stronger management capabilities and standards of service.

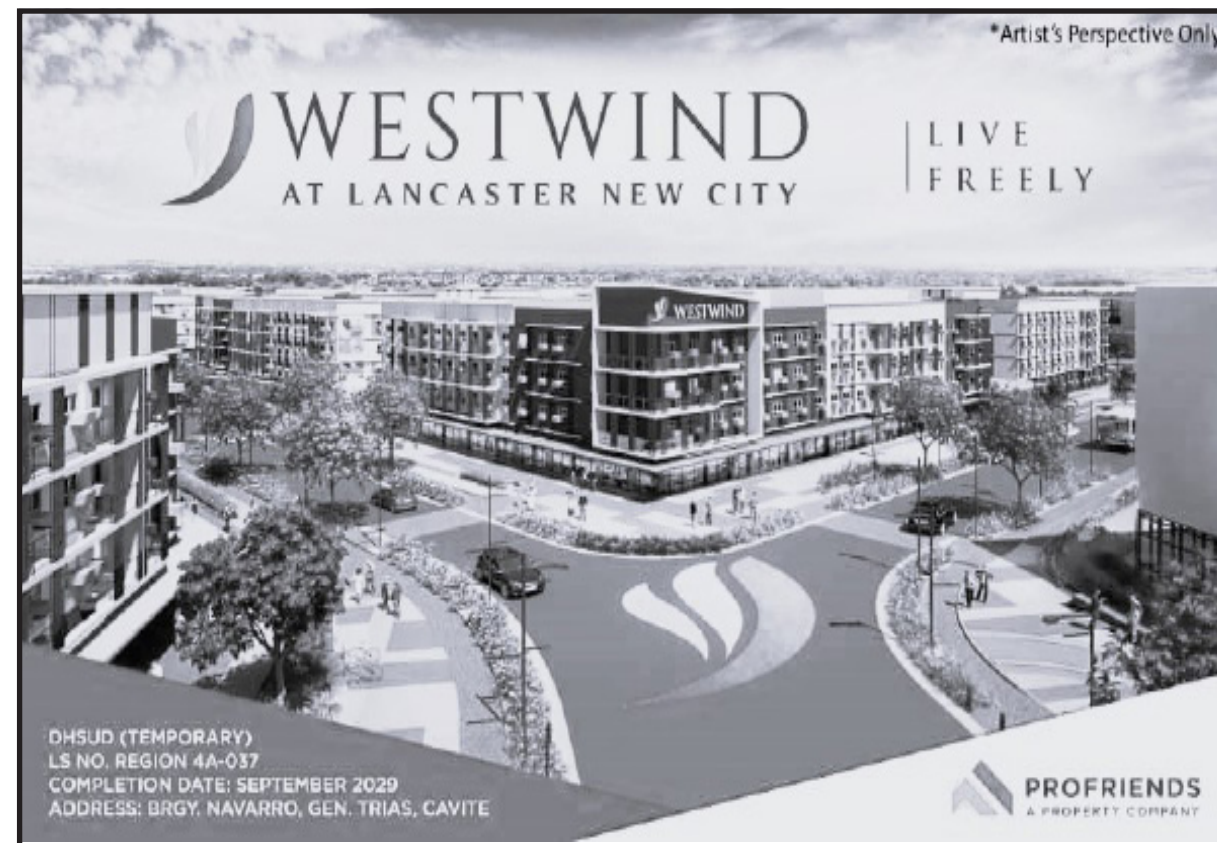
The first day of the COCM focused on strengthening administrative and management functions, with presentations by representatives from the various DFA offices cover-

ing finance, procurement, human resources management, asset management, migration affairs, and security services.

The sessions on the second day centered on the review and updates on consular services including authentication, passports, visas, civil registry, and consular offices coordination.

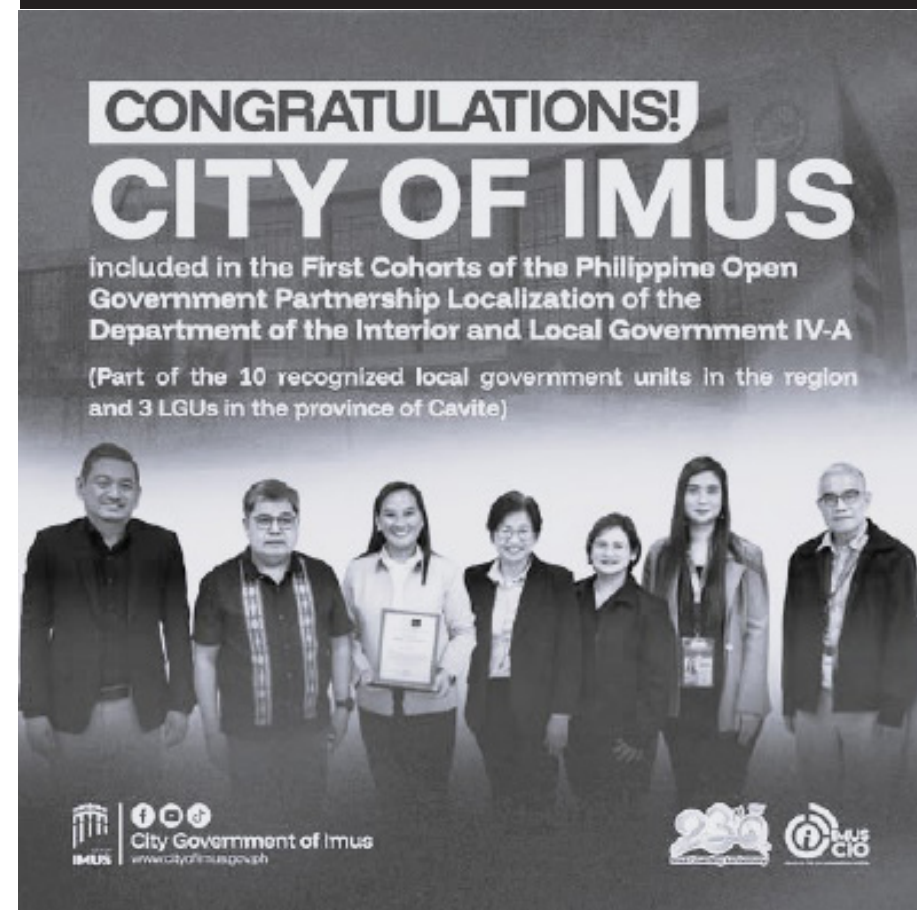
# ERDB Marks Digital Leap with Launch of AI Knowledge Hub

"Today, we celebrate a milestone that reflects the ingenuity of our team and the unwavering support

of our leaders," she said. "The ERDB AI-Powered Knowledge Hub integrates advanced technology into our research and information systems, transforming how we manage and share knowledge for environmental protection and sustainable resource management."

The system was developed by Information Systems Analyst III Alvin F. Olvida and the Management Information System staff, with strong support from DENR Undersecretary for Integrated Environment Science and Supervising Undersecretary for ERDB Dr. Carlos Primo C. David. The project was implemented under the guidance of PICTD Chief For. Marie Abbie Gail L. Dela Cueva and

Team Leader For. Eduviges T. Gibas. Their collective efforts resulted in an AI-powered platform that significantly enhances access to ERDB's published knowledge products and research outputs.

The ERDB Knowledge Hub allows users to search and interact with the Bureau's technical and semi-technical publications using natural language, making environmental research faster, more intuitive, and more accessible than ever.

This initiative underscores ERDB's commitment to leveraging technology to bridge science, innovation, and sustainability and empowering researchers, policymakers, and the public to make informed decisions for the environment. Source: DENR

May 29,017 naman ang aakyat ng isa o dalawang salary grade habang patuloy na nililinis ng DepEd ang regional backlogs at pinapabilis ang mobility sa hanay ng mga guro. Sa mga three-step advancements, 3,171 ang umangat mula Teacher I to Teacher IV, 3,374 mula Teacher II to Teacher V, at 11,462 mula Teacher III to Teacher VI. Mayroon ding 16,883 Teacher I na mapo-promote sa Teacher III.

Para masigurong tuloy-tuloy ang reporma,

palalawakin ng National Educators Academy of the Philippines ang training at leadership preparation programs. Bibigyan din ng prayoridad ang mga Teacher I na malapit nang magretiro para sa reclassification o promotion.

Kinikilala rin ng DepEd, mula Schools Division Offices hanggang Regional Offices, ang mahalagang kontribusyon ng Human Resource Management Officers, Teachers Credential Evaluators, at Human Resource Merit Promotion and Selection Board members na naging susi sa maayos na implementasyon ng ECP system.
