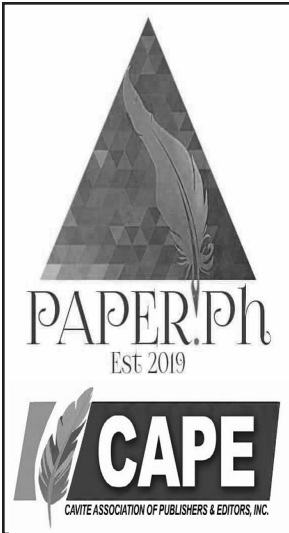

DENR Chief Lotilla Urges Strategic Role in Defending West Philippine Sea

Environment Secretary Raphael Lotilla recently called on the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) officials to take a

bolder, more strategic role in defending the Philippines’ maritime rights in the West Philippine Sea (WPS). Underscoring the

agency’s critical role in reinforcing the victory through scientific data, environmental reports, and legal-environmental strategies.

DENR Chief Lotilla Urges Strategic Role in Defending West Philippine Sea

(From page 1) emphasized, “This landmark legal victory must not be taken for granted — the work is far from over.” At a symposium hosted by Secretary Lotilla for DENR officials, Senior Supreme Court Justice Antonio Carpio, one of the most respected voices on the issue, presented historical and legal evidence affirming Philippine ownership of key islands and reefs in the WPS. He urged the country to develop a unified narrative to counter disinformation and challenge China before the international community, backed by legal and environmental evidence that the DENR can help provide.



Atty. Fretti Ganchoon, Senior State Counsel at the Department of Justice and an expert in maritime and environmental law, emphasized that the Philippine Maritime Zones Act and the Archipelagic Sea Lanes Act align domestic law with UNCLOS, clearly defining the country’s maritime zones and strengthening the legal basis for exercising jurisdiction over Philippine waters.

Atty. Ganchoon added that these measures integrate the 2016 arbitral ruling into Philippine law, giving the country firmer authority to protect marine resources, regulate activities, and assert sovereignty. They also institutionalize the term “West Philippine Sea,” further strengthening the country’s position in both law enforcement and diplomatic engagement.

Dr. Fernando P. Siringan, marine geologist and former Director of the UP Marine Science Institute, on the other hand, stressed that scientific research is vital to upholding the Philippines’ maritime rights, and called for greater investment in coordinated research, habitat mapping, and ecological monitoring to generate data that can reinforce the 2016 arbitral ruling and support long-term marine protection.

Secretary Lotilla vowed to mobilize the DENR’s environmental, legal, and scientific capabilities in support of national sovereignty. Among his directives: strengthen inter-agency coordination, publish marine environmental reports, and launch grassroots awareness campaigns. “The DENR is not just a steward of forests and rivers,” Lotilla said. “We are frontliners in protecting what is ours — from ridge to reef, and across our rightful seas.” Source: DENR

Once completed, the project will feature amenities such as a road network, sidewalks, outdoor covered court, open activity area, statue, monument plaza, decorative walls, plant boxes, benches, and the remaining lighting works.

“The Ramon Revilla Sr. Sports Arena Project is not just a facility—it’s an investment in the future of the community’s health,

well-being, and unity,” said DPWH Region 4A Director Jovel G. Mendoza.

The groundbreaking event was attended by key public figures, including Cavite 2nd District Representative Lani Mercado Revilla and City Mayor Strike B. Revilla.

Implemented by the DPWH Regional Office 4A, the Phase 1 of the new Bacoar City sports arena project is expected to finish on December 2025.

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Cayetano renews EDCOM III proposal to align DepEd, CHED, TESDA goals

der a single coordinating commission.

Designed as a parliamentary-style body, EDCOM III will not dilute the independence of the three agencies.

Instead, it will allow their heads to work closely with lawmakers, local governments, and education stakeholders to ensure better alignment, from policy design down to implementation.

The Commission will be co-chaired by four lawmakers, namely the chairs of the Senate and House committees on Basic Education, Arts, and Culture, and on Higher, Technical, and Vocational Education. It will also include an Advisory Support Council (ASC) composed of representatives from the academe, business sector, parents’ associations, LGUs, and civil society groups.

Among EDCOM III’s key priorities are tackling the learning crisis, reducing dropout rates, improving digital infrastructure, and addressing persistent issues such as stunting and workforce mismatch.

The bill also proposes using tools like artificial intelligence to modernize education and make it more responsive to industry needs.

Complementary to Cabinet Cluster for Education

EDCOM III is designed to work alongside another major reform:

the Education Cabinet Cluster, also proposed by Cayetano and already approved in principle by the President.

The Cabinet Cluster brings together executive agencies involved in education and labor to improve inter-agency coordination and ensure smoother implementation of programs.

EDCOM III, by contrast, focuses on long-term planning, policy development, and stronger oversight from Congress. It is also meant to be permanent, unlike bodies created through Presidential orders.

Cayetano first filed the bill in the 19th Congress as co-chair of EDCOM II, which had flagged the disjointed implementation of programs across DepEd, CHED, and TESDA as a factor in the country’s education woes.

He emphasized the need for a common vision for education and close coordination between Congress and executive agencies to make it a reality.

“The urgency of this reform cannot be overstated,” he said.

“If we are to produce a globally competitive workforce and make education the true driver of national development, we need decisive, coordinated action,” he continued.

Senate President Francis “Chiz” Escudero, Senator Pia Cayetano,

and Senator Joel Villanueva, who serves as a commissioner of EDCOM II, co-authored the bill.

In his explanatory note, Cayetano also anchored the bill on a biblical principle from Galatians 6:7: “Kung ano ang itanim, siyang aanihin.”

“By laying the groundwork for a truly cohesive and responsive education system, we aim to transform the nation by building the right foundations,” he said.

Cayetano renews EDCOM III proposal to align DepEd, CHED, TESDA goals

Senator Alan Peter Cayetano on Thursday renewed his call to fix what he described as a fragmented education system by reintroducing a bill that would create a Third Congressional Commission on Education or EDCOM III.

The EDCOM III

Act, one of Cayetano's priority bills in the 20th Congress, seeks to bring together the Department of Education (DepEd), Commission on Higher Education (CHED), and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) un-

Bahagi ito ng mahigit 1,500 success stories mula sa mga paaralan sa ilalim ng OK sa DepEd–HLI program na sinimulan noong 2022. Alinsunod ito sa Joint Administrative Order No. 2022-0001 na nilagdaan ng DepEd, DOH, CHED, DILG, DSWD, TESDA, at LEB, bilang pagsunod sa Universal Health Care Act.

Itinatakdang inisayat-iba ang malinaw na pamantayan sa six pillars of school health and well-being, gamit ang self-appraisal system para masukat ang implementasyon. Noong 2024, ipinakilala ang three-tier recognition

system kung saan kinikilala ang mga paaralan bilang ‘Satisfactory,’ ‘Very Satisfactory,’ o ‘Outstanding’ batay sa porsyento ng kanilang pagsunod sa itinakdang pamantayan.

Sa ngayon, mahigit 1,300 Last Mile Schools na ang nakatanggap ng teknikal at pinansyal na suporta mula sa DOH para sa hygiene facilities, mental health training, at iba pa.

Ngayong Hulyo 14–15, itutuloy ng DepEd at DOH ang national onboarding sessions para sa mga school heads at health coordinators. Kasama rito ang pagpapalaganap ng mga tools tulad ng School Self-Appraisal Checklist at “Map of Materials” para sa

health promotion.

Kasabay nito, inatitiyak nating may sapat na kaalaman, kalusugan, opisyal na DepEd Order na mag-iinstitutionalize sa HLI framework. Saklaw nito ang formal na pagpatupad ng 3-star rating system at pagsasama ng HLI standards sa Learner Support Framework ng ahensya.

“Hindi lang dapat ligtas sa sakuna ang paaralan. Dapat ligtas din sa gutom, sa sakit, at sa kawalan ng

suporta. Sa Healthy Learning Institutions program, ang hangad ng DOH: ang mga paaralan ay maging at malasakit sa bawat silid-aralan,” ani Education Secretary Sonny Angara.
