

Palawan Peacock-Pheasant successfully breede at PWRCC Nature Park

The Palawan Wildlife Rescue and Conservation Center (PWRCC) has reported a successful captive breeding of the Palawan Peacock-Pheasant (Polyplectron napoleonis), a bird species endemic to Palawan and classified as vulnerable due to ongoing habitat loss and declining wild populations.

In early March 2025, the resident pair of Palawan Peacock-Pheasants at the PWRCC Nature Park began displaying courtship behaviors, marking the start of their typical breeding season, which extends from March to July.

To support this period, animal care personnel prepared a secure and suitable nesting site to encourage natural breeding behaviors and provide a safe space for egg-laying.

On April 22, 2025, two eggs were discovered during routine monitoring.

In order to minimize disturbance during the incubation period, the team placed a notice near the enclosure, requesting that visitors maintain a one-meter distance from the nesting site.

After approximately 20 days, on May 12, 2025, the eggs hatched successfully. The two chicks were immediately observed following their mother and displaying healthy behavior. The mother bird has since shown consistent maternal care, a critical factor in the early development of the chicks.

To reduce risks from potential predators, the PWRCC veterinary team, led by Dr. Glenn G. Re-bong, recommended reinforcing the protective measures around the enclosure. In response, a protective net was installed, and enhanced daily monitoring was initiated to ensure the

ongoing safety and health of the hatchlings.

This successful breeding marks a notable milestone in the Center's ex-situ conservation efforts and contributes to the broader objective of species recovery and biodiversity protection in the region. The event also aligns with ongoing efforts to revitalize research activities at the center, not only for the Palawan Peacock-Pheasant and crocodiles but also for other native wildlife, including birds, mammals, and reptiles.

“This achievement underscores the importance of our conservation efforts,” said Felizardo B. Cayatoc, PWRCC Project Manager and concurrent Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Officer (PENRO). “The successful breeding of this species affirms our commitment to biodiversity conservation. We are also working to revitalize our research initiatives, not only for Palawan Peacock-Pheasants and crocodiles, but for other native avian, mammalian, and

reptilian species. The Palawan Peacock-Pheasant is renowned for its iridescent plumage and distinctive courtship display.

The PWRCC en-

courages the public to support conservation initiatives through responsible ecotourism and environmental education. The Nature Park remains open to

visitors, with appropriate safeguards in place to protect sensitive species and support the center's conservation mission.Source: DENR

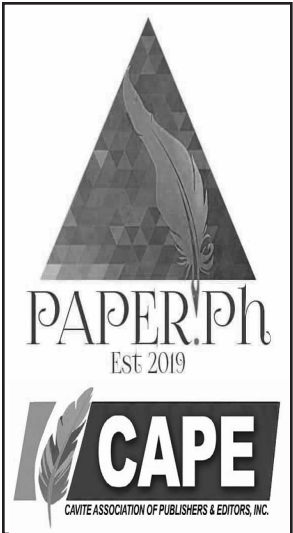
The event was graced by the presence of Congresswoman Lani Mercado Revilla and BM Alde Pagulayan. Key figures from the collaborating

days, Thursdays, and Saturdays.

"With the enforcement of the odd-even scheme, we are expecting a 40% reduction of vehicles along EDSA," said Artes. The number coding scheme shall still be implemented on other thoroughfares in Metro Manila.

Another traffic mitigating measure is the banning of provincial buses and trucks carrying perishable goods, garbage trucks, and aviation fuel delivery trucks along EDSA.

"They are only allowed to traverse EDSA during the 10 pm to 5 am window period. From 5 am to 10 pm, they are prohibited from traversing along EDSA," said Artes.

Concerned agencies have also agreed to remove the bike lane separators along EDSA. Artes said they are planning to meet with stakeholders, including cycling groups, motorcycle groups and motorcycle ride-hailing app firms to discuss possible sharing of bicycle lanes, said Artes.

"We are planning to put up exclusive motorcycle lanes along EDSA as riders will be prohibited from using flyovers and underpasses," he added. Moreover, identified alternate routes will also be cleared of illegally parked vehicles and other obstructions.

Dizon said other

measures to be implemented by DOTr include adding units to the EDSA Bus Carousel system to encourage more people to take public utility buses; adding more trains to MRT 3; and waiving toll fees on certain sections of the Skyway Stage 3, in coordination with the Toll Regulatory Board and San Miguel Corporation.

The two-year EDSA Rebuild, part of President Marcos Jr.'s 'Build Better More', is a major infrastructure project envisioned as a long-term solution to the dilemma of pothole patching and damaged road pavements by using reinforced concrete to strengthen road integrity against high vehicular volume.

Bonoan said the concept of the EDSA rebuild is to change the pavement into a new sturdy one. Preparatory works for the project will begin on June 13. DPWH will employ several contractors all at the same time to hasten the project. Repair and upgrade will be segmentized and will be done per lane with each portion expected to be completed every two months.

The road works will start on the bus lane or innermost lane in both directions until reaching the outer lanes. The stretch of Pasay to Shaw Boulevard (both NB and SB) will be prioritized. Source: MMDA
