maghatid ng konkretong solusyon sa school level.

Malaking tulong ito sa matagal nang kaku-langan sa oras at espasyo na nararanasan ng mga mag-aaral at guro sa SDO General Trias City, kung saan mabilis ang pagdami ng enrollees na nagdudulot ng siksikan sa mga silid-aralan at hirap sa araw-araw na klase.

“Proven naman po yan, kapag siksikan ang mga silid, hindi makapagturo nang maigi ang teach-

ers. Ayaw na po natin ng shifting as much as possible,” ani Angara, kaugnay ng mas malawak na agenda sa reporma ni Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr.

Ang bagong gusali ay may mga smart TV, armchairs, at mga safety feature tulad ng fire alarms at emergency lights. Malaki ang maitutulong nito sa kapasidad ng Santiago Elementary School na nagsisilbi sa mahigit 2,400 mag-aaral.

Sa tulong ng maay- os na pagtutulungan ng



DepEd at city government at paggamit ng Special Education Fund (SEF) upang pabilisin ang pagtatayo ng mga silid-aralan, mahigit 100 silid-aralan na ang naipatayo o ginagawa sa buong dibisyon sa loob ng wala pang tatlong taon. Dahil dito, nabawasan ang siksikan sa mga paaralan.

Dagdag pa ni Angara, ipinatutupad din ng DepEd sa buong bansa ang iba’t ibang hakbang para mas mapabilis ang pagtatayo ng mga silid-aralan. Kabilang dito ang pagpapahintulot sa mga LGU na magtayo ng school buildings, pagpapalawak ng public-private partnerships para sa malalaking proyekto, at pagpapalakas ng Adopt-A-School Program upang makahikayat ng suporta mula sa pribadong sektor. Layunin ng mga hakbang na ito na umakma sa national funding at maiwasan ang pagkaantala sa mga lugar na may agarang pangangailangan.

“First time in history na gagawin, ibaba na

ang pera sa mga LGUs, through decentralization of power, through decentralization of resources,” dagdag ni Angara.

Mas maraming gurong na-promote sa ilalim ng ECP

Matapos ang turnover ng silid-aralan, pinangunahan ni Angara ang mass oathtaking ng 542 guro mula sa Cavite cluster na na-promote sa ilalim ng Expanded Career Progression (ECP) System. Mahigit kalahati ng mga na-promote ay mula sa SDO General Trias City. Para sa maraming guro, ang promosyon ang nagtapos sa ilang taon o sa ibang kaso, ilang dekada ng paghihintay para sa pag-usad ng kanilang karera.

Isa sa mga kuwentong naantig ang maraming dumalo ay ang kay Carmen R. Zorilla, na ngayon ay Teacher IV ng Tropical Village Elementary School.

“Sa loob ng 28 taon, Teacher I po ako. Kontento na sana ako, dahil ang

sukatan ng tagumpay ko ay ang bawat batang natutong bumasa, umunawa, at mangarap. Hindi ko po inakalang darating ang panahon ito, na mapo-promote ako.”

Nagpasalamat din si Zorilla kina Pangulong Marcos at Sec. Angara sa mga repormang nagbukas ng landas para sa pagangat ng mga guro. “Sa ilalim ng Expanded Career Progression, napatunayan naming ang pagangat ng guro ay posible. Hindi po kami pinabayaang DepEd. Dahil dito, wala nang gurong kailangang magretiro bilang Teacher I.”

Ayon naman kay Angara, makasaysayan ang lawak ng mga promosyon sa ilalim ng ECP. “Ang estimate po natin, before 2026 ends, basta na-release po ‘yong pera, makakapag-promote tayo ng 100,000 teaching positions. First time sa kasaysayan po ng DepEd na ganyang karami ang na-promote, ang nabigyan

through the collection and use of rainwater. Meanwhile, Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Undersecretary Goddess Hope Libiran said the project complements the Plaza

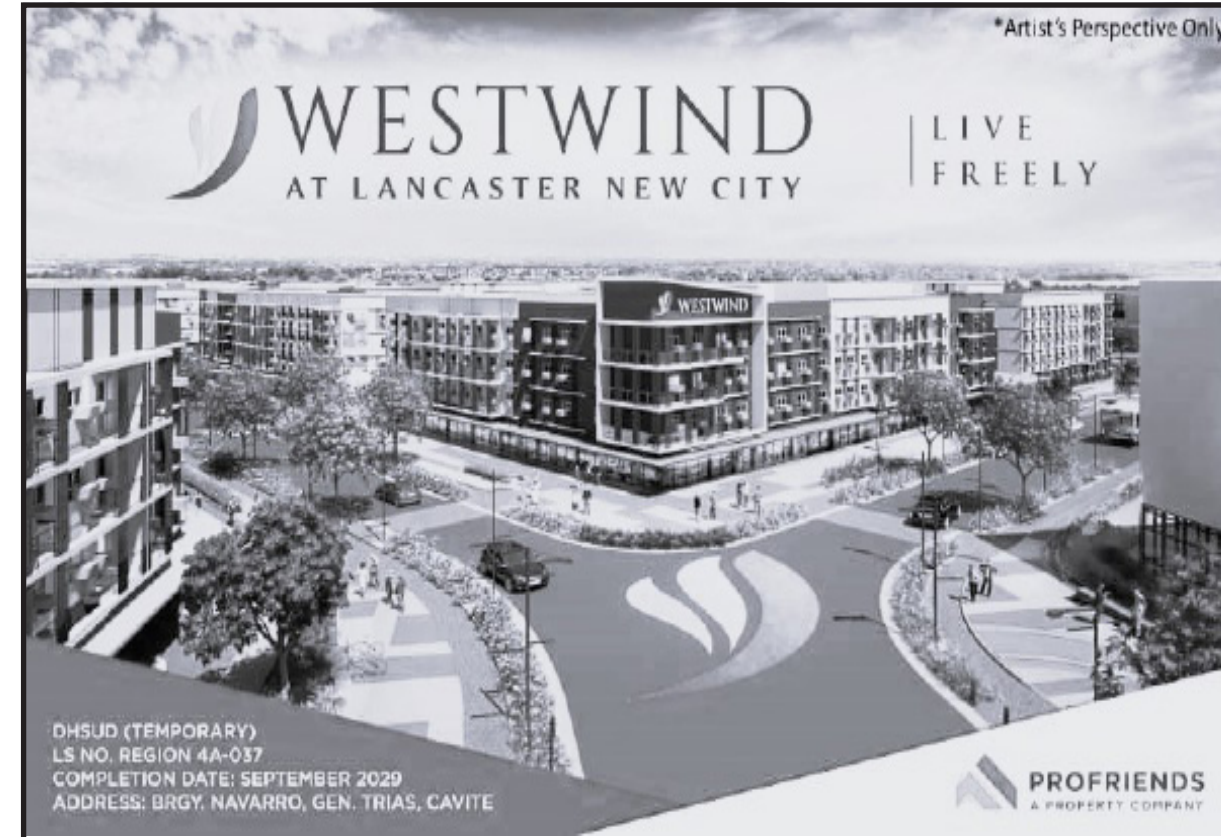
Azul initiative, fostering sustainable development and eco-friendly practices in the community.

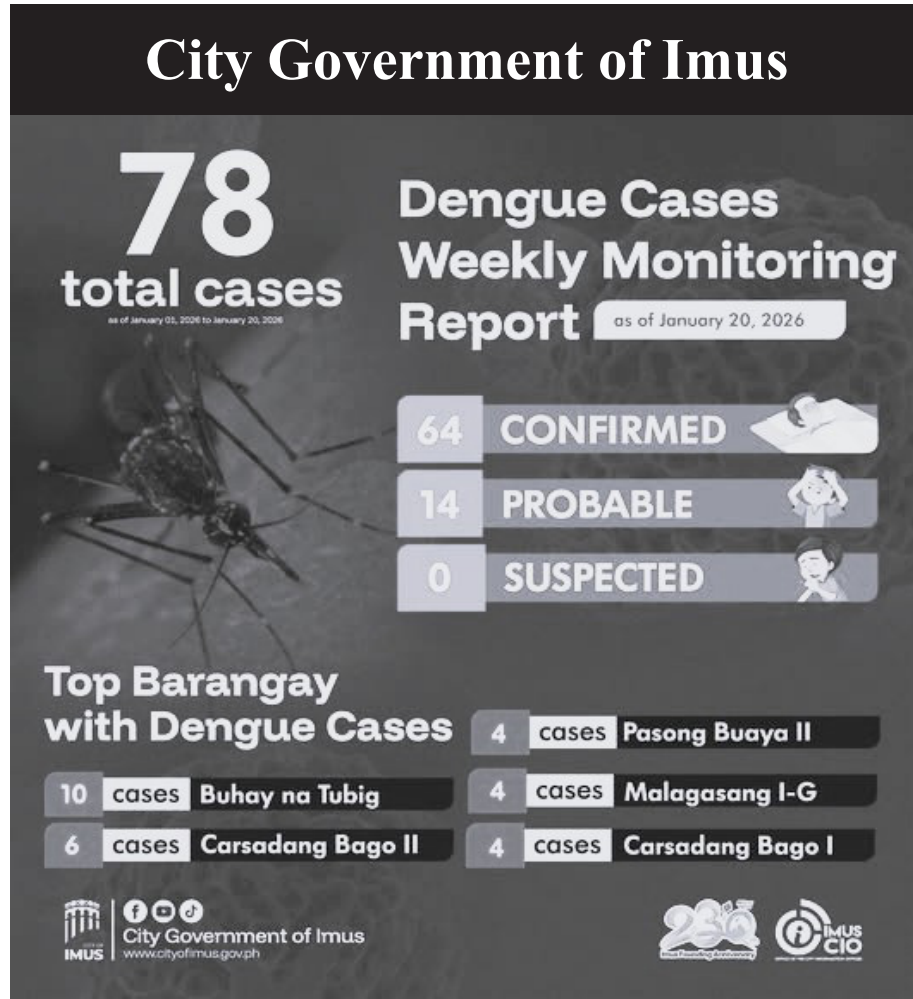

a day to families and in-
dividuals with no access
to food, particularly those
living on the streets.

The Tugon ng Masa
(TNM) OCTA Research
survey from December
3-11, 2025 showed that
self-rated poverty declined
by 17 percent, from 54 per-
cent during the 3rd quarter
of 2025 to only 37 percent
during the 4th quarter of
the same year.

Meanwhile, the lat-
est SWS survey covering
the period November 24-
30, 2025 reflects nearly
a 2-percentage point de-
crease from the 22 percent
hunger rate recorded in the
third quarter of the same
year.

“The latest OCTA
and SWS survey results
showing positive improve-
ments on how Filipinos
perceive their hunger and
poverty situation will serve
as the Department’s inspi-
ration to continue strength-
ening its programs and ser-
vices, especially as DSWD
celebrates its 75 years in
public service,” Asst. Sec-
retary Dumlao said.

Based on OCTA Re-
search’s report, this result
is the “largest single-quer-
ter decline ever recorded
in the OCTA TNM series,
equivalent to about 4.5
million families no longer
considering themselves
poor.”

The same report
also showed a decline in
self-rated food poverty,
from 49 percent to 30 per-
cent in the 4th quarter.

A total of 1,200 adult
respondents nationwide
participated in the SWS
survey. The 20.1 percent
hunger rate consists of

15.6 percent who experi-
enced hunger “only once”
or “a few times” (moderate
hunger) and 4.5 percent
who experienced hunger
“often” or “always” (se-
vere hunger) in the past
three months.

Asst. Secretary
Dumlao said the Depart-
ment vows to continue
strengthening its programs
and services as she at-
tributed the positive results
to the cumulative impact of
sustained social protection
and development programs
of the Marcos administra-
tion.

tained social protection
programs, the DSWD
spokesperson said the
Department also imple-
ments targeted interven-
tions which were designed
based on the unique needs
of the poor and marginal-
ized sectors.
