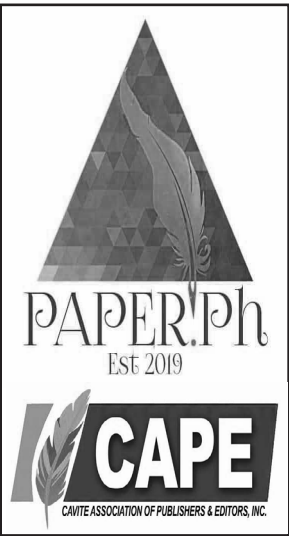

ter Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) report as of June 18 at 6:00 AM noted that the Department has already extended Php40.265 million worth of cash aid through the Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS) program to all affected families and individuals in General Santos City.

The DSWD has reiterated that financial assistance has been adequately provided to all affected residents amid recent reports circulating that no funding or assistance has been distributed, particularly in General Santos City.

Asst. Secretary Irene Dumlao of the DSWD's Disaster Response Management Group (DRMG) assured the public that the Department and its concerned Field Offices in Mindanao remain committed to assisting all eligible families affected by the June temblor.

"Patuloy po ang paghahatid ng kinakailangang tulong ng DSWD sa mga pamilyang naapektuhan ng lindol, partikular na po sa General Santos City at iba pang bahagi ng SOCCSKSARGEN. 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ating Quick Response Teams," Asst. Secretary Dumlao said on Thursday (June 18).

Asst. Secretary Dumlao, also the DSWD spokesperson, emphasized that all validated families affected by the earthquake who are deemed qualified have been provided with financial aid through AICS.

"Sinisiguro po natin ang mga pamilyang naapektuhan at sumailalim sa kinakailangang assessment at validation ay nabigyan na ng ahensya ng kaukulang assistance sa pamamagitan ng AICS upang makatulong sa kanilang agarang pangangailangan habang sila ay nagsisimulang makabangon mula sa epekto ng lindol," Asst. Secretary Dumlao said.

Aside from the AICS cash aid, the DSWD, through its Field Office (FO) SOCCSKSARGEN, distributed 191,974 family food packs (FFPs), 1,524

non-food items, and 706 ready-to-eat-food (RTEF) boxes for the quake affected families in General Santos City as per the 6:00 a.m July 18 DROMIC report.

The DSWD is also preparing the distribution of the Emergency Cash Transfer (ECT) by Tuesday next week as part of the government's continuing efforts to help the affected families recover from the effects of the earthquake.

"Inihahanda na rin po ng ahensya ang ECT funds para mabigyan ng karagdagang suporta ang mga pamilyang lubhang naapektuhan ng lindol," Asst. Secretary Dumlao said.

ECT funds worth Php426.980 million have been projected for SOCCSKSARGEN by next week as part of the DSWD's continuing assistance to quake-affected families.

The DSWD spokesperson said these continu-

ing response efforts are in line with the directive of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr. to ensure that affected families receive immediate and adequate government assistance.

"Alinsunod sa direktiba ni Pangulong Ferdinand Marcos Jr., patuloy po na nakaantabay ang DSWD upang matiyak na walang pamilyang naapektuhan ng kalamidad ang mapag-iwanan ng tulong. Makakaasa po ang ating mga kababayan na patuloy po ang ating ahensya sa mabilis, maayos, at maagap na paghahatid ng tulong sa lahat ng mga nangangailangan," Asst. Secretary Dumlao said.

The DSWD spokesperson also clarified that the Department's programs and services are provided to all quake-affected individuals and families in accordance with existing disaster response protocols and guidelines. (CC) Source: DSWD

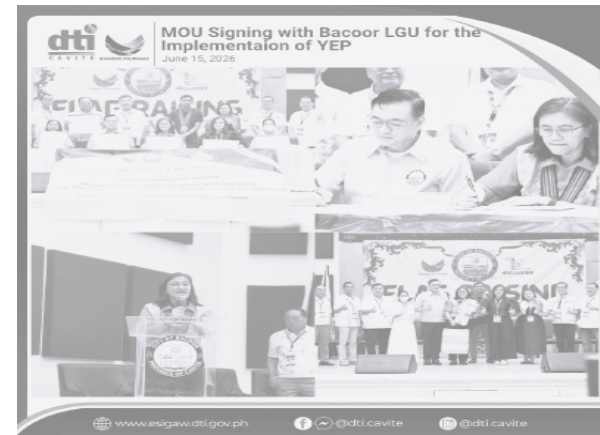
