

# Remulla Orders Deployment of 800 Tourist Police in Top PH Destinations

The Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) will deploy 800 tourist police officers across major tourism areas in the country to strengthen safety and security in key destinations.

Interior and Local Government Secretary Jonvic Remulla said the deployment will begin in April following the approval of President Ferdinand R. Marcos Jr., in coordination with the Department of Tourism (DOT).

"The President has approved my plan that beginning April, we will launch together with the

Department of Tourism the tourist police," Remulla said.

The initiative aims to increase police visibility in high-traffic tourist areas, deter criminal activity, and ensure faster emergency response while creating a safe and welcoming environment for both visitors and local businesses.

Remulla said the 800 tourist police officers will be equipped with motorcycles to allow better mobility in crowded tourist sites and remote scenic areas. The Philippine National Police (PNP) will distribute new motorcycle units dedicated for the deploy-

ment.

Initial rollout sites include Bonifacio Global City (BGC), Poblacion in Makati, Boracay, Siargao, Cebu, Bohol, and Puerto Princesa.

Apart from strengthening security, the tourist police will also help promote the country's central emergency hotline to ensure that visitors can quickly reach authorities during emergencies.

"Every tourist that arrives in the Philippines will be given the calling card of 911. Para alam nila na we have a 3-minute response time kahit nasaan sila sa Pilipinas," Remulla explained.

In 2025, the government's Unified 911 system recorded a 97 percent response efficiency rate for nearly four million calls received nationwide.

The system has also handled incidents in several tourist destinations, in line with the directive of President Marcos to prioritize tourism safety. Remulla said strengthening tourism safety also brings economic benefits, particularly to the country's middle class.

"When you improve tourism, it's the middle class that benefits. They contribute the most and they get the very least benefit. We have to strengthen the middle class and make the country better," he said. Source: DILG

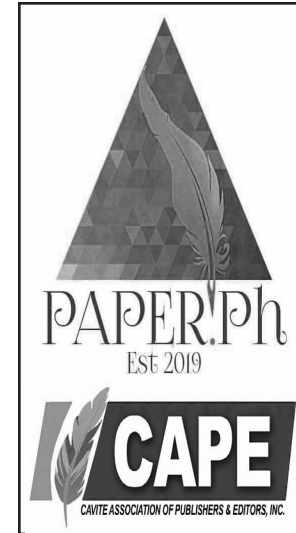
Held at the Moli-

# Local MSMEs See Strong Start to 2026 with ₱129M in Trade Fair Sales

The 2026 DTI-Bagong Pilipinas National Trade Fair (NTF) concluded its five-day run at SM Megamall with P129.68 million in total sales. Held from February 18-22, 2026, the event marked a strong start to the Department of Trade and Industry's (DTI) yearly trade calendar.

This total includes direct cash purchases, booked orders, and ongoing business deals negotiated during the event. A total of 335 micro, small, and medium

enterprises (MSMEs) from across the Philippines joined the fair, which drew 15,103 visitors to the Megatrade Halls.

As the first flagship trade event of the year, the fair gave local sellers a direct way to reach a large number of shoppers and professional buyers, helping them grow their businesses beyond their home regions.

Beyond the retail booths, the event focused on helping local brands become more professional. The program includ-



ed practical workshops on digital tools, shipping for exports, and eco-friendly production.

These sessions, along with "Show & Tell" product demos and fashion showcases, allowed entrepreneurs to get direct feedback from the public and improve their products for a more competitive market.

The high turnout and variety of goods—ranging from home décor to "green" innovations—show a growing interest among consumers for locally-made products.

For many participating MSMEs, the fair served as a vital testing ground for new ideas before they expanded to larger markets.

The Business Connect Lounge also played a key role by hosting meetings between sellers and large corporate buyers.

These talks focused on long-term supply deals that will help small businesses stay active even after the fair ends.

Following this successful kickoff, the DTI's Bureau of Market Development, Promotions, and OTOPI (BMDPO) will move forward with its 2026 calendar of regional and themed fairs.

# Cayetano welcomes Marcos certification of fuel excise tax relief bill as urgent

Senate Minority Leader Alan Peter Cayetano welcomed the move of President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. to certify as urgent House Bill No. 8418, a measure that would allow the temporary suspension or reduction of excise taxes on fuel amid rising global oil prices linked to tensions in the Middle East.

Noting that the House measure addresses the same concern raised in Senate Bill No. 1927 which he filed with Senator Pia Cayetano, the Minority Leader said the certification shows that the government recognizes the need to respond quickly when global events push oil prices higher and affect the lives of Filipinos.

"Let's not miss opportunities. I don't think there's a problem that we expect the worst or prepare for the worst. Pagka inubong ang Middle East, nagkakahika ang buong mundo," the Minority Leader said.

House Bill No. 8418 allows the President to suspend or reduce excise tax on fuel products for a period of six months. Under the proposal, this authority granted to the President may only be exercised until December 31, 2028.

The Senate proposal, for its part, seeks to establish a mechanism that would allow the automatic suspension or reduction of fuel excise taxes once global oil prices reach a critical level. The Senate



bill proposes amendments to Section 148 of the National Internal Revenue Code of 1997, as amended by the Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion (TRAIN) Law.

Under the Senate measure, the President may suspend or reduce excise taxes on fuel through an executive order once the average Dubai crude oil price based on the Mean of Platts Singapore reaches US\$80 dollars per barrel for one month, upon recommendation of the Development Budget Coordination Committee (DBCC). The suspension or reduction would automatically be lifted once global oil prices fall below the threshold.

In their explanatory note, the Cayetanos cited the growing instability in major oil-producing countries in the Middle East such as Saudi Arabia, Iran, Iraq, Kuwait, Qatar, and the United Arab Emirates.

They warned that escalating strikes and retaliatory attacks threaten the stability of one of the world's most critical energy supply hubs.

"These developments demonstrate the need for a responsive mechanism that authorizes the suspension of excise taxes on fuel whenever extraordinary events or ex-

ternal shocks significantly disrupt global oil prices," the Cayetanos said in the bill's explanatory note.

They added that having such a safeguard would allow the government to act faster to mitigate inflation and reduce the burden on consumers without waiting for Congress to pass a new law each time global oil prices surge.
