

# Manufacturers Pledge Price Stability for Basic Goods for 30 Days Amid Middle East Conflict

Amid the ongoing Middle East conflict, manufacturers of basic necessities and prime commodities have confirmed that they can maintain current prices for the next 30 days, with some able to do so for up to 60 days.

This is based in a meeting called by Trade Secretary Ma. Cristina Roque on 16 March 2026 attended by a total 21 manufacturers including Pure White, Tide Bar canned sardines, bread, bottled water, instant noodles, coffee, canned meat, toilet soap, and candles.

Within the next 30 days, prices are expected to remain stable, with no increase anticipated for canned sardines such as Unipak, 555, Ligo, Lucky 7, Fresca, Morjon, Golden Town, and Mega; bread products such as Pinoy Tasty and Pinoy Pandesal; bottled water such as Wilkins and Nature's Spring; toilet and laundry soaps such as Safeguard Pure White, Tide Bar Original Scent, and Green Cross Pure White; condiments such as Datu Puti's soy sauce and vinegar, and

Lorins' Patis; processed canned meat of CDO; and candles from Liwanag. Meanwhile, the prices of brands such as Lucky Me, Ho-Mi, Argentina, Lucky 7, 555, Swift Premium, Wow!, and Shanghai will remain at their prices for 60 days. In addition, some manufacturers of brands such as Kopiko, Nescafe, San Mig coffee 3-in-1, and Export candle, have pledged to maintain current prices with no price increase for the time being.

Since the latest Suggested Retail Price Bulletin released by the DTI last February 2025, it covers a total of 197 Shelf-Keeping Units (SKUs).

"We recognize the financial strain faced by consumers while also acknowledging the cost pressures confronting manufacturers. Our priority remains to ensure fair and reasonable pricing. We thank our manufacturing partners for their commitment and shared concern for Filipino consumers," said Secretary Cristina A. Roque.

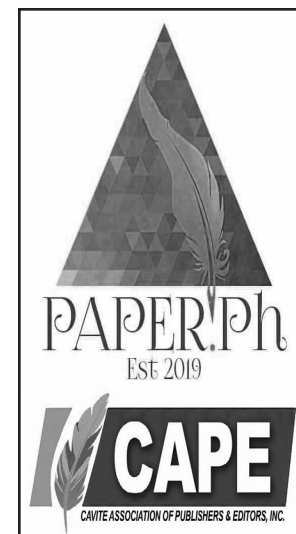
### BACCOOR EYES LOCAL BIR OFFICE TO IMPROVE TAXPAYER SERVICES

development of innovative psychosocial interventions within the social welfare sector.

Through this initiative, the DSWD seeks to generate local proof and best practices on the therapeutic value of human-animal interaction, with the goal of strengthening program models that support

healing, recovery, and resilience among vulnerable populations.

"In the Department, we serve Filipinos who have experienced various kinds of distress and in need of interventions, including therapy," Secretary Rex Gatchalian said during the relaunch of Angel Pets

"Angel pets were born out of a vision to provide comfort, bond, and healing to those who need it most. Our client-residents in residential care facilities face unique struggles, often dealing with abuse, trauma, loss, and mental health concerns. Sometimes, all they need is a friend—a warm presence exuding unconditional care that reassures and generates positivity," Secretary Gatchalian pointed out.

The expansion represents the Department's responsive and innovative social protection programs. Developed by the DSWD's Social Technology Bureau (STB) in partnership with the Philippine Animal Welfare Society (PAWS), the program utilizes the concept of animal-assisted therapy, highlighting the positive outcomes of the bond between humans and trained

# Sec. Lopez Calls for Nationwide Expansion of “Libreng Sakay” to Ease Commuter Burden

Transportation Secretary Banoy Lopez on Tuesday urged lawmakers to expand the Service Contracting Program (SCP) or “Libreng Sakay” of the Department of Transportation (DOTr) to the local government units (LGUs) so more public utility vehicle (PUV) drivers and operators, as well as passengers may benefit.

Following the directive of President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. pushing for the whole-of-government approach in addressing the impact of the ongoing fuel price hikes, the “Libreng Sakay” is viewed as a mitigating measure to help ease the burden of the commuters, drivers and operators.

“If we have Service Contracting or Libreng Sakay, mami-mitigate po natin kasi we are also addressing the commuters. In the same way, we are sustaining the supply of transport kasi we are also paying the operators and drivers,” Secretary Lopez said during the first hearing of Senate’s Proactive Response and Oversight for Timely and Effective Crisis Strategy (PROTECT) Committee to address the economic consequences of the conflict involving the United States, Israel and Iran.

Contracting po sana ay we can expand it to LGUs. Hindi lang po sa national, pati LGUs. If we can empower them, they can have their own Service Contracting or Libreng Sakay,” the transport chief added. Aside from SCP, Secretary Lopez said that the DOTr is also implementing other strategies to address the impact of oil price hikes, including the Fuel Subsidy Program (FSP) for PUV drivers and operators. The transport chief also cited the 50% fare discount for all passengers of MRT-3 and LRT-2, and toll discounts for Class 1, 2, and 3 PUVs. Secretary Lopez added that the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) has also reduced the passenger service charge and navigation fees for CAAP-operated airports, measures that directly benefit both the airlines and the passengers.

(From page 1) priority flood prone areas in their localities.

Intensified declogging of drainage systems, dredging and cleaning waterways, clearing obstructions, and managing wastes will be undertaken before the rainy season.

“In the second round of our operations, we will declog priority local roads. We will send equipment, manpower, and resources to areas identified by the Metro Manila mayors,” said Dizon.

Upon the orders of president, Dizon said non-operating pumping stations should be operational before the rainy season. He also called on mayors to submit their requests for new pumping stations in areas where the facilities are most needed.

MMC President and San Juan City Mayor Francis Zamora expressed gratitude to President Marcos Jr. for the plans and programs aimed at preventing flooding during the rainy season and expedite unfinished infrastructure projects.

On the agency’s preparations for Holy Week, MMDA General Manager Usec. Nicolas

Torre III said the agency will deploy 2,476 personnel on major roads, transportation hubs, and other key areas in the National Capital Region (NCR) to ensure public safety and convenience during the Holy Week observance. “We will enforce a no day-off and no-absent policy for all traffic and field personnel when heavy traffic is expected due to the Holy Week exodus,” said Torre during the press briefing.

Areas of concern include terminals, seaports, airports, and roads leading to churches. He also announced the suspension of the number coding scheme in the NCR on April 1 (Wednesday) at 12 noon. The number coding scheme is lifted automatically on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday (April 2 and 3), which are regular holidays.

Meanwhile, provincial buses will be allowed along EDSA starting 9pm of April 1 until 6am of April 6. Buses from the south should terminate their trips at PITX while buses from the north should end their trips at the Cubao terminal. Source: MMDA
